Arizona State University Joaquin Bustoz Math-Science Honors Program

Summer residential opportunity for motivated high school students to study university-level mathematical sciences at the ASU Tempe campus. Eligibility requirements:

- Must have completed sophomore year by summer 2017
- Unweighted cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher
- Minimum grade of “B” or better grades in all math and science classes
- Have completed at least three years of math by the end of spring 2017
- Seniors are eligible to apply but must be enrolled for the fall semester of 2017 at ASU
