Greetings Harelson Parents:

**Volunteers:** We have a lot of support from parents at Harelson in the area of volunteering in classrooms and getting involved in many of the functions. We are looking at training five parents on the copy machine to become copy parents. These people would come in once a week for a couple of hours to make copies on the Xerox machine for the teachers. If you are interested please let me know.

I am looking forward to another very rewarding school year. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to give me a call. Thank you for your help in preparing your children for the new school year. We have the very best educators at Harelson and we will continue to have high expectations to help all students reach their full potential in the areas of academic achievement and social behaviors. ## Library News

We are very excited about being back from summer break and starting a new school year. It is sure to be a productive though challenging year. Due to our state budget problems, we currently have no money to purchase books. We hope this will change, but there is no guarantee. On our web site we have posted a

**Wish List** of books we *wish* we could buy for the library. Donations of new or used books are always welcome.

We also lost our library clerk over the summer due to funding. It will be just the two of us handling all library duties this year. We've gotten very organized, and are doing everything we can to limit the impact of these changes on our students and teachers.

That said, let's go over some basic information about the library.

| Grade              | Number of Books | Check-out schedule |
|--------------------|-----------------|--------------------|
| Kindergarten       | 1 Book          | 1 Week             |
| First Grade        | 2 Books         | 1 Week             |
| Second Grade       | 3 Books         | 2 Weeks            |
| Third Grade and Up | 4 Books         | 2 Weeks            |

If a book is not returned on time, the student will receive an overdue notice. This notice lists the cost of the book if it had to be replaced (for instance, if it was permanently lost or damaged beyond repair). We do not charge late fees. Students with overdue books are not allowed to check out another book until the overdue book is returned. Students who cannot check out books, are encouraged to spend their library time looking at books or magazines.

The library maintains a **webpage** ([www.amphi.com/~chlic](http://www.amphi.com/~chlic)) that contains lots of useful information and links for students, as well as, parents. There is a page for **What's New**, where you can look for upcoming events or programs in the library. There is an extensive page of **Internet Links** for helping students in all grades with research projects or for looking up information on the web. Other useful links include **Accelerated Reader Quiz List** where parents and students can customize a search for reading level appropriate AR books for students. There is a page of information and links for **Parents**. There is also a link to the **math and science textbook publishers' websites** where you can find **on-line study guides** and **practice quizzes**, and more.

This may be a challenging year, but we are up to that challenge. And we look forward to sharing our love of reading with your children. 
