

# *Roald Dahl Interview*



Individually -

- On the official Roald Dahl website ([www.roalddahl.com](http://www.roalddahl.com)), enter the Glass Elevator and select the option for Interview with Roald Dahl.
- Put on your headphones and adjust the volume appropriately.
- Read and listen to the responses that Mr. Dahl gives in the interview.
- As you read and listen, use the second page of this worksheet (*My Roald Dahl Facts*) to take notes. You need to record a minimum of five facts about Roald Dahl and his writing. If you need more room, you may record additional facts on a sheet of lined paper.
- After you have recorded your notes, view the photographs taken throughout Dahl's life in the Roald Dahl photo gallery

With Your Partner -

- Brainstorm which of Dahl's answers you would like to include in your PowerPoint slide show from the five facts that each of you recorded.
- Choose at least one important fact or piece of information to summarize about Roald Dahl for five of your six slides. Your first slide needs to introduce your presentation and include your names. Lay out the design of your information on the *Roald Dahl PowerPoint Slide Organization* worksheet.
- Open PowerPoint and begin to work on your presentation.
- As you work on your slides, return to the Roald Dahl website ([www.roalddahl.com](http://www.roalddahl.com)) and choose at least one appropriate picture to include in your presentation. Download the picture and insert it.
- Include transitions between each of your six slides. You may choose to include sounds and additional graphics.
- Review the Roald Dahl PowerPoint Rubric to be sure you have met the requirements.
- Practice your slide show so the two of you will be ready to present it to your classmates.
