

School Supports Pilot

Free saliva-based COVID-19 testing has been made available to all **Amphitheater School District employees*** in partnership with Arizona State University and Arizona Department of Health Services. Priority registration will be available to a sample (roughly 20%) of district employees each week.

***Note:** employee's family members, students, and other community members may also take advantage of free testing, but must follow [normal test registration procedures](#).

How to Get Tested:

1. Visit asusalivatest.site to access your priority registration. Use the "agency code" listed above.
 - a. **Note:** If you have already done a saliva test at one of ASU's public testing sites, please fill out this [electronic form](#) before registering to avoid any issues the day-of.
2. Once you are registered, you will receive detailed instructions for how to get tested along with a QR code.
 - a. **Note:** You can print this out to bring with you, or pull it up on your smartphone when you arrive.
3. Visit the testing location listed above on the day and time of your appointment.
4. Within 48 hours, you will receive a text message indicating your results are ready to view.
 - a. **Note:** Your individual test results will not be shared with your district; however you are encouraged to communicate both positive and negative test results to your district to expedite contact tracing and enable schools to minimize additional exposures.
