How to Get Tested:

- 1. Visit <u>asusalivatest.site</u> to access your priority registration. Use the "agency code" listed above.
 - a. **Note:** If you have already done a saliva test at one of ASU's public testing sites, please fill out this <u>electronic form</u> before registering to avoid any issues the day-of.
- 2. Once you are registered, you will receive detailed instructions for how to get tested along with a OR code.
 - a. **Note:** You can print this out to bring with you, or pull it up on your smartphone when you arrive.
- 3. Visit the testing location listed above on the day and time of your appointment.
- 4. Within 48 hours, you will receive a text message indicating your results are ready to view.
 - a. **Note:** Your individual test results will not be shared with your district; however you are encouraged to communicate both positive and negative test results to your district to expedite contact tracing and enable schools to minimize additional exposures.
