I, _____, understand that by being in an orchestra, I am making a huge commitment. I understand this commitment goes until our last concert of the year. I will come to orchestra practice, not missing more than four practices in a semester (less if possible). I will practice my orchestra music at least one hour a week outside of orchestra time (more is even better. I encourage parents to keep a practice log to track practice at home.) I will also take care of my instrument, and when it's broken, I will not try to fix it, but to bring it to Mr. Tagawa.

My behavior is also an important part of our contract. I know that at any time, Mr. Tagawa has the right to ask me to leave for the rest of the orchestra rehearsal, or even the rest of the year. I understand I am still on the school campus while in Orchestra. This is a school class and the same rules apply to orchestra as in any other class at Harelson Elementary School.

If something unforeseeable happens and I need to change my contract with Mr. Tagawa, I will make an appointment with him and my parents to discuss the change.
