







<p>Amphitheater High School Parent Involvement Policy</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Parents are expected to monitor student learning using the Parent Portal via Infinite Campus. ○ Parents are asked to attend on-campus student activities and all scheduled conferences. ○ Ensure your learner attends school every day and arrives on time. ○ Stay connected by reading and responding to notices from school/school district.
<p>Annual Meeting</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Parents and the community are invited each year to meet and review Title I academic services and to ask questions to promote two way communication and talk about ideas for improving student learning. ○ Curriculum and Assessment tools are discussed. ○ Proficiency Levels are explained.
<p>Annual Title I Assessment</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Each year parents and staff review the effectiveness of this policy as it aligns to the Integrated Action Plan. ○ Parents are encouraged to give input regarding the Title I Integrated Action Plan.

<p>Flexible Meetings</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Families can engage with the school during meetings of the Parent Teacher Organization and Site Council. ○ Staff members work with families to ensure meetings are scheduled when all can attend. If in-person meetings are not possible, provide online/remote meeting options.
<p>Language Accessibility</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Interpretation services will be provided in different languages when advance notice is given to the school. ○ School will utilize ParentSquare in communicating with families (built in interpretation capabilities).
<p>Family Engagement Tips</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Use ongoing communication with your learner's teacher to monitor academic success. ○ Help your learner by monitoring homework for completeness and check with your learner to be sure it's returned to class on time. ○ Ensure your learner attends school every day and arrives on time. ○ Participate as a volunteer in your learner's class, school, or on a district committee or parent group. ○ Be an advocate and ask questions to help your learner be successful in school and in handling difficult situations.
