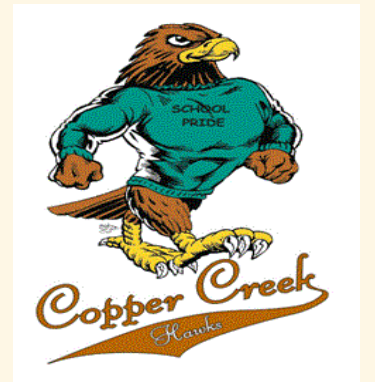


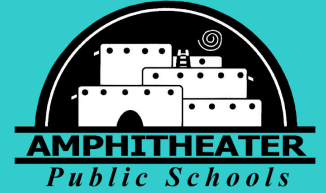

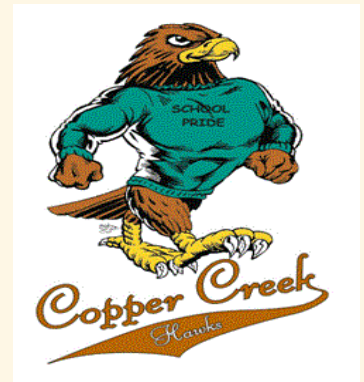




Why choose Copper Creek Elementary School?

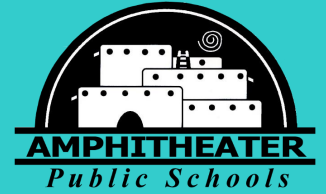

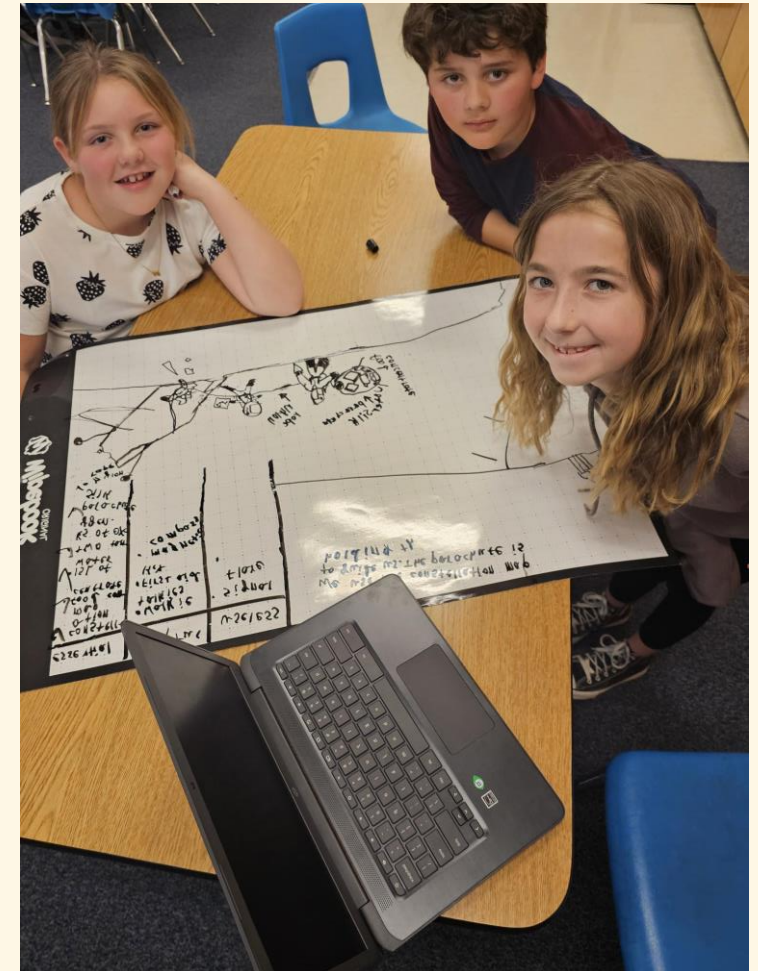
Why choose Copper Creek Elementary School?



Copper Creek is a PreK – 5th grade school. We have 4 pre-school classrooms and 2 classrooms at each grade level.

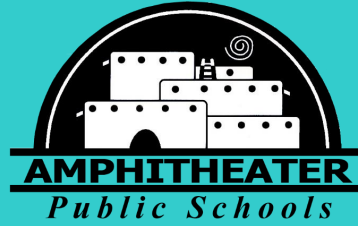
Our physical education, art, and music teachers are all certified teachers.

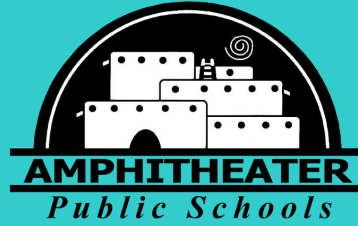

Children are expected to develop respect for themselves, property and other people.

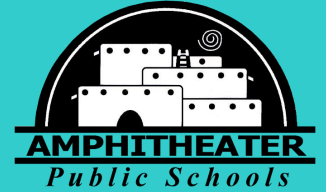
Children deserve to learn in a safe and positive environment where love and care are demonstrated.

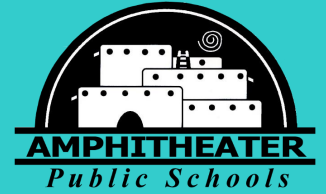


Copper Creek classrooms are equipped with 21st Century equipment with each student being assigned their own Chromebook and each classroom having an interactive TV installed.

Our History

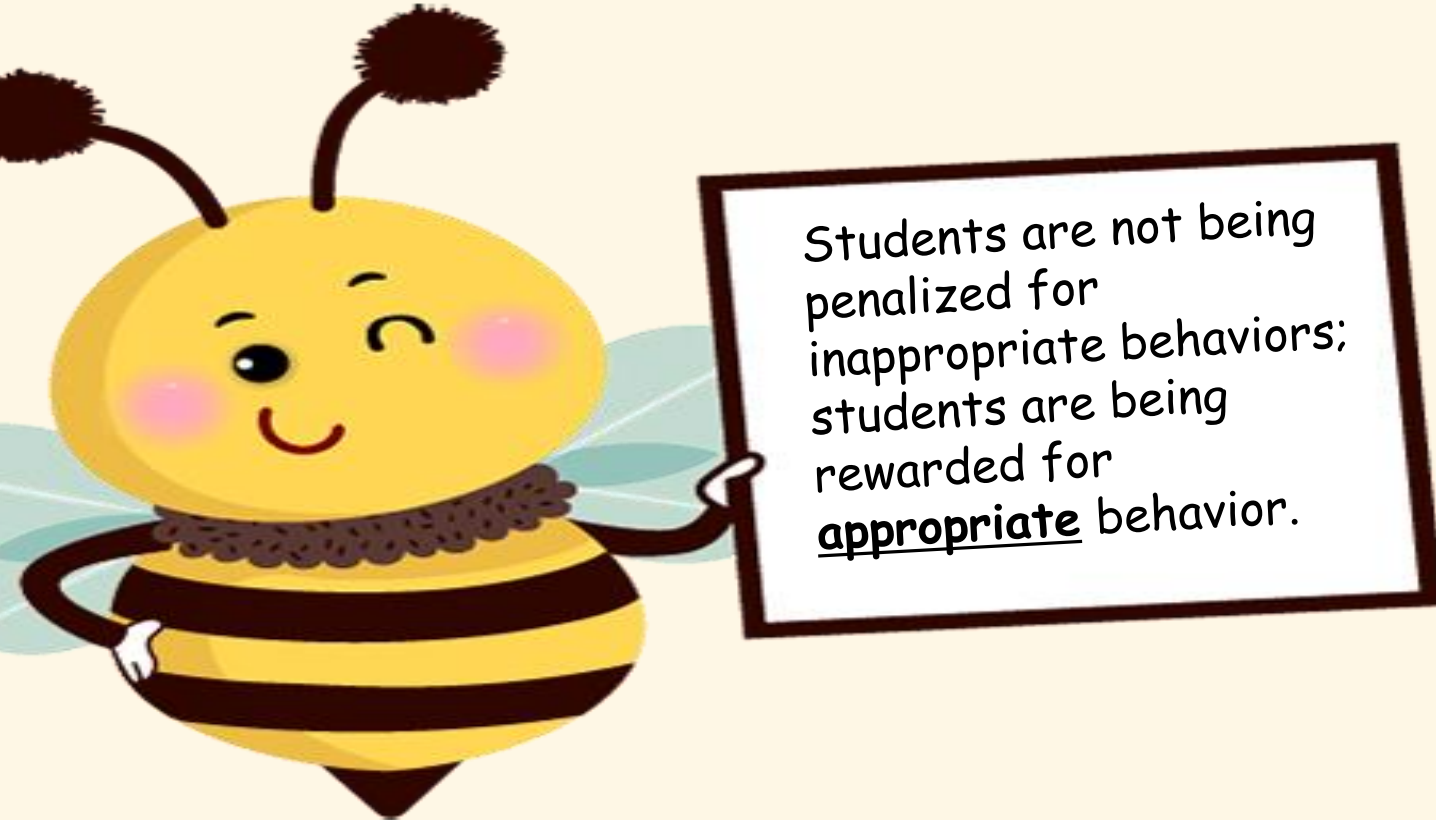
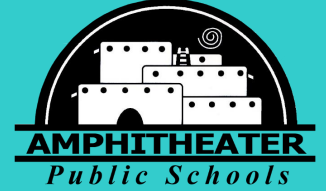
Copper Creek was built in 1988 on donated land on donated land in Oro Valley and was named after the community in which it was built.

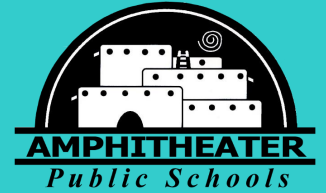


PBIS – Positive Behavior Intervention and Support

School-wide positive behavior intervention and support (PBIS) is a system of tools and strategies for defining, teaching, acknowledging appropriate behavior, and correcting inappropriate behavior. It is a framework for creating customized school systems that support student outcomes and academic success. PBIS is for the whole school, it is preventative, and it changes the paradigm of focus from negative behaviors and exchanges to positive expectations and interactions.

WORK TOGETHER

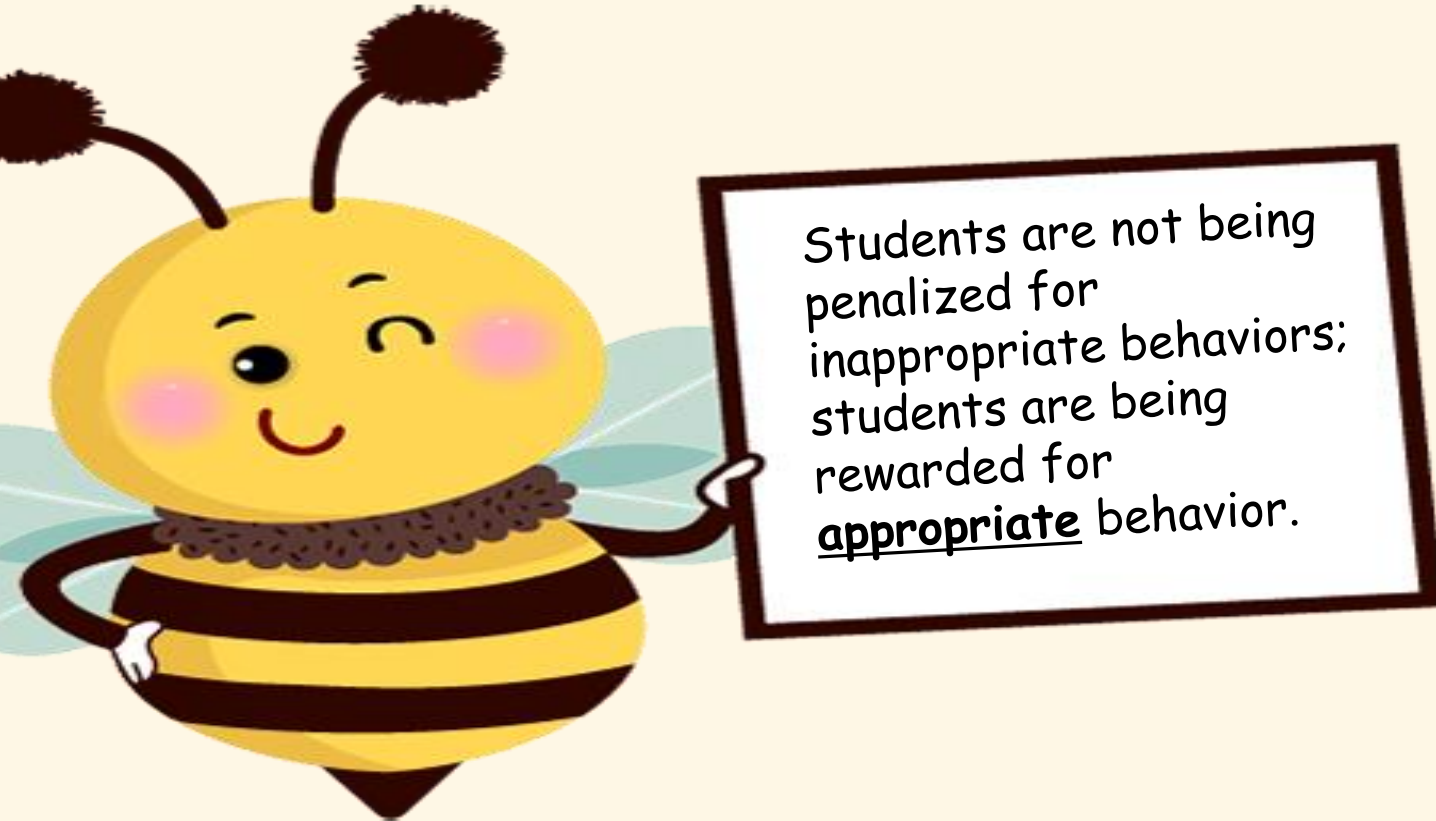
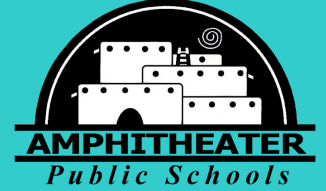
Hawks come together to achieve a shared goal.

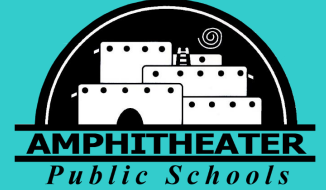

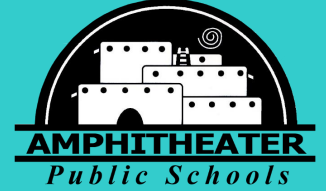

It provides a safe way for district administrators, school principals, teachers, staff, and parents to:

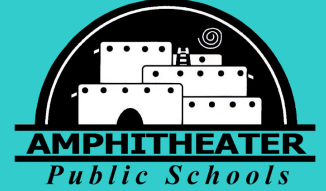
