





Copper Creek is a PreK – 5th grade school. We have 4 pre-school classrooms and 2 classrooms at each grade level.

Three special education teachers, REACH teacher, and 2 interventionists support our students.







Copper Creek was built in 1988 on donated land on donated land in Oro Valley and was named after the community in which it was built.






Around our campus you will find many beautiful murals that have been painted by members of our Copper Creek community.









PBIS - Positive Behavior Intervention and Support

School-wide positive behavior intervention and support (PBIS) is a system of tools and strategies for defining, teaching, acknowledging appropriate behavior, and correcting inappropriate behavior. It is a framework for creating customized school systems that support student outcomes and academic success. PBIS is for the whole school, it is preventative, and it changes the paradigm of focus from negative behaviors and exchanges to positive expectations and interactions.







Students are not being penalized for inappropriate behaviors; students are being rewarded for appropriate behavior.

WORK TOGETHER


Hawks come together to acheive a shared goal.
