

In AP Psychology, students learn about themselves and others through topics such as human behavior, neuroscience, social psychology, emotions, disorders and abnormal behavior. The class consists of interactive demonstrations, experiments, and lively discussions and debates regarding psychological research. Various projects on the brain, dreams and sleep study, motivation and developmental psychology are also included. Students have a chance to earn college credit in psychology by taking the AP exam. The class is open to Juniors and Seniors (Sophomores accepted with special permission). There is no pre-requisite for this course.
