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Dear Senior Students, Parents, and Guardians:

On behalf of the entire faculty and staff of Canyon del Oro High School, I would like to congratulate you on how far you have come! The Class of 2025 Graduation Ceremony is scheduled for May 19<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. in Dorado Stadium. We hope to see every member of the Senior Class of 2025 for an evening you will long remember. We also hope that each graduating senior will join us at the Project Graduation event following the ceremony.

We are currently making preparations for the Graduation Ceremony and would like to request your support in maintaining the tradition of making the graduation program a memorable ceremony. We understand how hard all of the students have worked to reach this milestone in their lives and our desire is for the CDO community to honor the significance of this moment together. As such, I would ask for your cooperation with the following requests:

- **Guests:** In order to minimize congestion and to allow for a more enjoyable evening for all graduates and families, each graduate will be limited to no more than 8 – 10 guests.
- **Handicap Seating and Parking:** Please fill out Senior Exit survey to request handicap seating or parking passes. We have limited capacity in our east parking lot and want to make sure that families are provided with handicap parking access if needed. Handicap seating is limited to the person in need of handicap seating, and one assistant.
- **AIR HORNS, ANY LOUD NOISEMAKERS, ALONG WITH LASERS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN DORADO STADIUM.**
- **Please remain seated throughout the duration of the ceremony.** When family members stand up and begin to walk down after their student's name has been read, it is a distraction during the ceremony, can block the view of other families whose students' names have yet to be read, and it does not honor the entire class, as a whole.
- **Items that block the view:** Large posters, fat heads and balloon bouquets are not permitted as they disrupt the view for other families.
- **The guidelines for student dress** during CDO Scholars Night and the Graduation Ceremony are on the following page. All Seniors should have reviewed these guidelines in their Exit Packets. We ask that graduates follow these guidelines to help honor the significance of their accomplishments.
- **Decorating caps and gowns is not permitted.** Likewise, any additional adornments (leis, sashes, cords) are not permitted unless provided through the school.
- **Gowns** need to be zipped up, with appropriate dress code underneath and no flip flops.
