Standing Reports:

Principal's Report – Tara Bulleigh

- Current enrollment:
 - 1411, down from last month
 - Lost ~5 students per class when we returned to hybrid
- Senior events
 - “great ideas” are being discussed and in the works
 - Lunch for seniors being provided next week (Mar. 1 and 2)
- ACT testing for juniors next week (Mar. 2 and 4)
 - Must have 95% of juniors test (will be added to parent newsletter)
 - Results factor into CDO's CCI (College & Career Index) for state grade
- R.I.S.E. – after school and weekend credit recovery program
 - Mar. 3 – May 1 on Wednesdays and Saturdays
 - Participation requires attendance both days
- Good News/Accolades:
 - Academic Decathlon won 20th consecutive regional title
 - 20 CDO students chosen to participate in South Central Regional Honor Band, Choir and Orchestra
 - 4 CDO students placed in FBLA competitions
 - 3 Dorado National Merit Finalists: John Hartman, Carter Hollings, Aaron Trinh
- Facilities/Seniors update
 - Smelly roofing work continues on east campus for another six months minimum (west campus roofing is complete)
- Curriculum & Instruction
 - Pre-registration and course selection is in progress and going well
 - ACT testing (juniors) and Civics make-up (seniors) next week
 - ~120 students took the PSAT
 - Summer school: T. Bulleigh and A. Magelli are on a committee to revamp summer school – details will be forthcoming
