❖ SPORTS REMINDERS/INFORMATION FOR PARENTS FROM THE CROSS ATHLETIC DIRECTOR:

ACTIVITY BUS – The activity bus runs every day and will drop students at the bus stop where they were picked up at in the morning. Activity busses usually leave campus around 4:50 pm. Because there are only 2 activity busses running at this hour it may take up to 30 minutes for some athletes to be delivered to their home bus stop. Athletes need to be at the bus loop by 4:35 pm to avoid missing the activity bus.

ATHLETE PICK-UP – All athletes are to be picked up at the bus loop. Coaches will be reminding athletes not to walk to the front of the administration building for parent pick up after practice. The coach who has bus duty will only be responsible to supervise the bus loop area. There is no supervision in front of the administration building after practice. Parents are also reminded that all athletes must be picked up by 5:00 pm daily. Any athlete who cannot arrange to be picked up by 5:00 pm may be removed from their team. Please remember that coaches on bus duty are not permitted to leave campus until the last athlete is picked up. We appreciate it when parents are on time.
