You may call ahead ONLY for EMERGENCIES.

School Dress Code Policy

The purpose of the student dress code is to encourage students to "dress for success" and to come to school properly prepared for participating in the educational process. See the "Student Code of Conduct" booklet or online, for more information.

CROP TOPS or ANY TOP that shows a STUDENT'S MIDSECTION are NOT ACCEPTABLE and SHOULD NOT BE WORN AT SCHOOL.

If a student's attire does not follow the dress code, a staff member will ask the student to change into a P.E. uniform. If the student refuses, the parent or guard-ian may be notified and asked to bring appropriate attire.

Disciplinary action will only occur after the opportunity to comply with the student dress code has been provided to the student, with the exception of incidents involving indecent exposure, in which case disciplinary action will occur immediately.
