Amphitheater Public Schools Announces a Common Early Dismissal Day for 2017-18!

The Early Dismissal Day for Harelson School is changing for the 2017-18 school year. All Amphitheater Public Schools will dismiss students early on **TUESDAY**. This will be a change for our school, our parents, our local child care providers, and our community.

We wanted to let you know of this change as early as possible as we know it may impact family arrangements for transportation and after school child care.

Why the change?


