Amphitheater Public Schools Celebrate Switch to Solar Power Earth Day Event Planned to Mark Milestone

In December 2015, Amphitheater Public Schools kicked off a solar construction project to install solar panels across all 24 school sites and support facilities by the end of September 2016. Construction is now complete at the first few schools and they have started to generate their own solar electricity. Once all construction is complete, the District expects to become one of the top 5 "greenest" school districts in the nation based on the Environmental Protection Agency ratings of alternative energy projects nationwide.

To celebrate this "switch" to solar power, Amphitheater Public Schools is hosting an event on Friday, April 22 (Earth Day) at La Cima Middle School — the first Amphi school site to install solar panels back in 2008.
