Tdap Guidance for Schools

This flyer was created to help schools determine if/when to refer a student for required vaccinations.

Student Age 10	 Do not refer for Tdap (unless needed as part of catch-up schedule) Refer student at age 11 for Tdap vaccine (ACIP & AZ school requirement Students who are 10 years of age and have not yet received their Tdap and Men ACWY are not to be excluded from school
Student Age 11	 Refer students at 11 years of age for a Tdap and MenACWY Did student receive Tdap or Td @ 7-10 years of age? If yes, next dose of Tdap is due in 5 years, per ADHS rules Note: student may receive another Tdap at age 11 from their healthcare provider following CDC/ACIP recommendations
Catch-up Ages 7-10	 If a student did not complete the 4-5 dose childhood series of tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis containing vaccines (DTaP/DTP/DT), refer to provider for completion of the series

For the purpose of insurance reimbursement, Tdap and MenACWY (MCV4) vaccines are usually administered at/after age 11. Please do not refer students to their provider at age 10 for the 11 year-old school requirements.
