

Dear Amphitheater Families:

On Tuesday, July 14, the Amphitheater Governing Board approved the District's Reopening Plan. Please find details about the plan, along with links to the board presentation with yet more detail, at [www.amphi.com/reopening](http://www.amphi.com/reopening).

The approved plan offers families the choice of two models of instruction: In-Person Learning (when schools are open and remotely while they are closed) and Online Learning by Request (a fully online experience).

Below is the process for selecting a learning model for your children. Please make your decision by Monday, July 20, 2020 or as soon as possible.

## How to choose your children's learning model

### **In-Person Learning Model (including remote learning until schools can open)**

- If you would like your children to attend school in-person when buildings are permitted to open, please participate in your school's registration process. You don't have to do anything else. Your school(s) will send information registration, schedules, books, etc., in the next week or so.

### **Online Learning by Request Model (full online program)**

- If you would like your children to participate in our Online Learning by Request model, [please click here](#). Your school will contact you about the registration process, including schedules, materials, etc., in the next week or so.

Students who choose one model can switch to another by consulting with their schools or teachers. This consultation will help ensure transitions are as smooth as possible. Students who choose the Online by Request learning model will retain their spots at their brick-and-mortar schools for the 2020-2021 school year in the event they wish to return in person at some point in the year.
