Dear (PARENT/GUARDIAN),

Amphitheater Public Schools will be returning to in-person instruction on October 12, 2020 using a "hybrid" model. This model will allow us to bring approximately half of the students to campus on Monday and Thursday for Cohort #1 and the other half of the students on Tuesday and Friday for Cohort #2. This will enhance our ability to provide space for social distancing.

Cohort #1 will attend school on the regular school schedule 8:25a.m. – 3:35p.m. in person for the full day on Monday and Thursday. Students with a 1<sup>st</sup> period class will start their school day at 7:15a.m.

There may be instances where a student's cohort assignment is changed to help facilitate class balances or permit siblings with different last names to attend school, in-person, on the days their older sibling is scheduled to attend school. If there is any change to your student's cohort assignment, your student's counselor or an administrator will contact you by phone or email.

Students will have assignments from their teacher(s) on Google Classroom and regular assignments for the remaining three days of the week. Live ZOOM lessons will be provided on Wednesday to connect the class together as a whole group.

## All students and staff will wear masks per State and local requirements.


