As a student in the Amphitheater School District's online program, I understand and agree to abide by the requirements for enrollment listed below.

- Students must be enrolled in the Amphitheater School District and have completed enrollment paperwork with their home school for the 2022-2023 school year.
- The official enrollment start date for online summer school will be May 21, 2022.
- A student who has not completed **20%** of the course by the **7th day from the initial enrollment date** of each semester class taken will be automatically dropped.
- A student who has completed 20% of more of a course and either drops or does not finish the course will receive an "F", regardless of when the 20% was completed. The final course grade will be posted on the student's transcript.
- Students must demonstrate academic integrity at all times. A student who is determined to have violated Amphitheater School District's policy on academic dishonesty will be exited from the program immediately.
- Students will be given the opportunity to earn up to 1.0 transferable credit or two semesters of coursework. (Each completed semester earns 0.5 credit.)
 - Note: All coursework, including the final exam, **must be completed** by the final deadline of **July 15**, **2022**. There will be no extensions given.
 - If a student wishes to complete two semesters of coursework, the second semester must be started no later than June 20, 2022.
 - Students may only take one semester course at a time.
- Online teachers grade and provide feedback within an average time of 24 hours. Plan accordingly. All online coursework must be submitted and graded before approval is given to complete the final exam.
- Recommended pacing for a semester-long course is approximately six to eight hours per day; five days per week.

- To be eligible for grade replacement, any course taken to replace a grade from a previously taken course, must be the same course.
 - o Example: AP World History \rightarrow AP World History (On level World History would not qualify for grade replacement.)
- All MDLP courses require a **proctored final exam at the home school**. Proctoring dates and times are Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 10:00 a.m. 2:00 p.m. Students should contact Ms. Terri Amonson at tamonson@amphi.com or 520-696-4011 to schedule a time to take their final exam.
- Students are to return this completed form to their counselor no later than May 16,
 2022.
- Cost: There is no charge for current Amphitheater School District students.
