Dear La Cima Families,

I hope you have all had a good week since we last communicated via e-mail and phone dialer last week. We are now a couple days away from ending our first quarter. I want to thank you for your continued support through all of the challenges we have faced these past 6 months. We could not do this without you!

I want to remind you of a couple things and give you some details on a few other items for when we reopen in the hybrid model on October 12.

- Tomorrow, October 1, we are opening up our campus from 3:00 to 5:00 PM for any new students to La Cima to pick up their schedule and look for classes. PLEASE DO NOT DROP YOUR CHILD OFF AND LEAVE. This is a quick informal time for students to find classes and see the campus. There will be no tours, but there will be someone in the downstairs and upstairs foyer to point students and parents in the right direction.
 - We are asking that people come to the bus loop foyer doors to enter campus.
 - We will allow approximately 15 families in at a time, ask them to locate the classrooms and then exit out the same way (different doors).
 - o If there are more than 15 families at a time, we will ask families to wait outside until we can allow the next group in.
 - We are requiring masks on at all times to ensure the safety of everyone on our campus.
 - Teachers will not be available.
 - o If you cannot make it, there are MANY adults on campus the first days of school to help students find their way around, so do not worry if you are unable to come.
- We will be conducting daily temperature checks on students as they enter the main foyer, before they are allowed out onto the campus. All students will still enter the building from the same area. We have marked off the area with 6-foot markers to assist students in ensuring they keep their distance while entering the campus. To assist us in ensuring everyone's safety, please check your child for any symptoms before sending them to school. If their temperature reads 100.0 or above, we will be sending them directly to the nurse to be sent home. Thank you for your help in not sending children to school with any symptoms.

- Locker rooms will be closed for PE. Students will not be dressing out, as this enclosed space does not provide the proper measures to ensure safe procedures. Students will be carrying their backpacks with them, so they can keep deodorant with them. We ask that students wear uniforms in which they can participate easily, for example: no skirts and rubber soled shoes.
- Uniforms are required when students at on campus. Please refer to the dress code policy on page 11 of your child's planner or the email that was sent last week. Masks are required to be worn everywhere on campus. The mask does not have to match the uniform colors, but DOES have to be school appropriate. The same goes for students' lanyards, if they choose to purchase their own. A lanyard will be provided for students to use.

- The hallway lockers will also not be used this year to prevent students from congregating in the hallways. All hallways are marked for one-way traffic and students will be taught how to get from class to class with these changes.
- Students will not be allowed to share supplies. We are providing a basic supply kit for all students on the first day, but ask that they keep them in their backpack and be very responsible in their use, as we are not able to replenish them on a regular basis.
- If students did not check out a Chromebook to use during Remote Learning, as they have a device at home, we are able to provide a Chromebook for them to use during the school day. They will not be able to bring them home, but will have access to them to use while in-person. Please be sure to discuss safe transportation of Chromebooks with your child, as we are asking them to bring our Chromebooks back and forth with them to school. They are responsible for their safety.
