The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme provides two years of rigorous preparation across six subject groups for students seeking **personal** as well as **academic** growth. The IB Diploma Programme is recognized by leading universities throughout the world. Admission into Canyon del Oro’s IB Diploma Programme is based upon completion of the IB DP Admissions Application, the student’s academic record (student must have at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA weighted or unweighted), teacher recommendations, a full-day shadowing experience, and an interview.

Application Timeline:

- The IB Diploma Programme Admission Application should be submitted to Ms. Bomke, CDO’s IB Coordinator, in A121 or through email beginning in January of a student’s sophomore year. Admission applications are accepted throughout the spring semester but early admission is appreciated for staffing and scheduling purposes.
- Student shadowing experiences and interviews are scheduled beginning in February after DP Application submission.
- Upon acceptance into the DP, students are able to select IB courses.
