Admission into Canyon del Oro's IB Diploma Programme is based upon completion of the IB DP Admissions Application, the student's academic record (student must have at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA weighted or unweighted), teacher recommendations, a full-day shadowing experience, and an interview.

Once your application is submitted, an interview will be scheduled for you and your parents/guardians with the IB Counselor and IB Coordinator.
