Student Aide - Semester

Student Aide gives the opportunity to become familiar with different aspects of school life. We use student aides in every area of the school. If you are interested in being a student aide please read each short description and number the priority of interest (1 is the highest). This class requires teacher and administration recommendation. _____ **Elementary PE Aide** - Students will work with the elementary PE teacher to support PE instruction. This includes setting up/breaking down PE activities and working with elementary PE students during class activities.

_____ **Classroom Reading Aide** – This student aide receives specific instruction on how to help elementary students who are struggling in reading. They will receive tutor training and will be partnered with a class whose teacher has requested additional support.

_____ **Classroom Math Aide** - This student aide receives specific instruction on how to help elementary students who are struggling in math. They will receive tutor training and will be partnered with a class whose teacher has requested additional support.

_____ **Library Aide** - Working in the library introduces the many functions of the library. Students are taught how the computers work; they show other students how to find books or look up research materials, etc.

_____ **Office Aide** – By helping in the office, students learn the fundamentals of how to deal with the public (both in person and on the phone), filing, accounting, attendance, and general office work.
