## 2014–2015 Arizona School Immunization Requirements, Kdg–12<sup>th</sup> Grade

- Students must have proof of <u>all</u> required immunizations, or a valid exemption, in order to attend school. Arizona law allows exemptions for medical reasons, lab evidence of immunity, and personal beliefs. Exemption forms are available from schools and at <u>http://azdhs.gov/phs/immunization/school-</u> <u>childcare/requirements.htm</u>. Homeless students are allowed a 5-day grace period.
- 2. The immunization record for each vaccine dose must include the date and the doctor or clinic name.
- 3. The statutes and rules governing school immunization requirements are: Arizona Revised Statutes 15-871 - 874; Arizona Administrative Code, R9-6-701 - 708.

Students attending school or preschool in Arizona prior to 9/1/2011 with parental recall of chicken pox disease are allowed to Varicella continue attendance with parental recall of disease. Students enrolling in an Arizona preschool or school for the first time after 9/1/11 are required to present proof of varicella immunization or a valid exemption for medical reasons, laboratory evidence of immunity or personal beliefs.
