#### Principal's Report: Mr. Munger

- Learning Model Report
  - First Quarter Remote learning by necessity
  - Second Quarter Hybrid Learning Model expected to remain in effect through 1<sup>st</sup> semester
- Student Enrollment
  - Student enrollment is currently 1430; Significant decline since beginning of school year
  - Holding steady since transition to hybrid learning model
  - Vast majority of withdrawals from IRHS transferred to Amphi Academy Online
- Budget
  - Student attendance is important to capture funding for this school year and next
- Dual Enrollment
  - Program is doing well
  - Program has helped to keep students enrolled at IRHS
  - More classes will be added in SY 21-22
- Master Schedule
  - Will offer paper or online registration depending on Tyler capabilities
  - SY 21-22 Course Catalog should be available December 1st or 2<sup>nd</sup>
  - Registration process to be completed by end of January
- Faculty Projects
  - Roof
    - o Re-roofing entire school
    - Crews working nightly from 4 pm to 1 am

- Academic Bldg is finished; Fine Arts Complex needs cool coat; moving over to work on Cafeteria/Bookstore; will start PE Complex in late spring
- Weatherproofing buildings
  - Painting and resealing building to prevent water damage
- Graduation 2021
  - o It is expected that graduation will occur as previously experienced in past years

- Will utilize aspects of 2020 graduation
