Principal's Report: Ms. Burnett

- 2nd quarter grades posted this week.
- Monday, Oct. 30 marks the beginning of winter sports.
- "Hawk Talk" had their first meeting.
 - Once a quarter, parents are invited to meet with Ms. Burnett to discuss anything they have concerns over/want to bring to her attention.
- Parents are now able to subscribe to receive an email for IRHS daily announcements.
- Both parents and students brought up concerns about the inappropriate dancing at this year's homecoming.
 - Ms. Burnett is going to bring these concerns up with STUGO and try to find a way to solve the issue.
 - o IRHS has about \$420,000 coming in each year for the next 9 years due to the bond
 - o Building beach volleyball courts this year. Should be finished by February.
 - Plans to upgrade exterior weatherization this year.
 - o Cafeteria kitchen upgrade and football field electrical repair planned for next year.
- Teachers have expressed concern about mold in the classrooms.
 - A third-party agency came in and inspected for mold over fall break.
 - Areas of concern were found. Some classrooms were repaired during fall break, but there are still areas to be finished off.
- IRHS ranked a "C School" this year.
 - Need to improve AZ Merit performance to receive a better ranking.
 - o IRHS is proud to have a 93% graduation rate, the best in the district.

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STUGO Report:

- Make a Wish drive was a success.
- Food drive is starting up this week in every English classroom.
- STUGO Regional conference to be held at IRHS this June.

Tax Credit Budget: Ms. Burnett
