SESSION DESCRIPTIONS

1. Resume 101-20 minute session

Stileda Rose has been a counselor here at AHS for 4 years. She graduated from the UA with a BA/MA in Counseling and earned a 2^{nd} Master's degree in Leadership. She has been a counselor for all grades K-12 over her 18.5 years as a counselor. She is also a former track athlete and has coached track for 15 years. In this session, Resume 101, you will learn how to make a resume that gets the attention of any human resources manager. You'll know the fundamentals of building a resume for any type of job and leave with a sample resume in hand.

2.Mock Interviews- 20-minute session

In this session, students will have a chance to practice answering interview questions asked by business professionals and/or human resource specialists. Students will receive coaching and feedback from their responses. Community leaders from a variety local businesses and career paths, will facilitate this session.

3.Applying for the Job you Want to Get -40-minute session

Allyn Bulzomi is a Native of Tucson. He has been married to his wife Susan for 35 years. He has 3 children and 7 grandchildren. He attended CDO, the UA and the University of Phoenix. He has a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration and a Master's degree in Organizational Management and Human Resources. He was the Chief Budget Officer for Pima County for 7 years, the Budget Director for TUSD for 7 years, the Assistant Superintendent of Human Resources for 17 years, the Director of HR for El Dorado County and is currently the Director of Human Resources for Pima County. He is deeply involved in the Rotary Club, spending the last 17 years as a member, President, Director, Secretary, Treasurer and Sergeant at Arms. He enjoys motorcycles, fishing, hunting and golf. Please welcome Allyn Bulzomi. In this session, students will learn which Documents are expected at the time of application, appropriate contact information, follow up contacts to prospective employers, what to wear to an interview and much more.

4.Financial Aid Know-How -20-minute session

Angel Willis is an Amphi HS counselor who has been in the counseling field for 16 years. She has worked for non-profit organizations such as Our Family and SACASA and most recently the Sunnyside Unified School District. Angel is dedicated to working with teachers, students and their families. In this session, students will receive important information on financial aid options including: federal student aid, scholarships, grants and loans.

5.AZ Earn to Learn and OTHER Scholarship Options- 40-minute session

College advisors from the University of Arizona, Pima Community College and our own Jimena Morales will walk students through the steps to find, assess and apply for a variety of scholarships that will allow students to finance their college dreams. Students will work in a computer lab to submit forms for scholarships as early as today.

6. How to Be a Millionaire Quiz Game- 20-minute session

Mr. Brockton Lange has been an Economics teacher at Amphi High School since January 2013. His class focuses on personal finance, consumer behavior, and the interaction between economics and the society around us (or, according to the class motto, *Cash Rules Everything Around Me*). This session, "How To Be A Millionaire," is a team-based quiz game that explores the habits and choices of many wealthy people in the United States.

7. Creating your FSA ID-40 minute session

Jimena Morales, college advisor at AHS, along with numerous college advisors will walk students through the FIRST STEP of applying for FAFSA. The creation of an FSA ID is the gateway to FREE MONEY provided by the federal government for students to pay for college. With the proper documents in hand, you can complete this step by the end of the session. Students who do not have the documents in hand will know exactly what they need to acquire for a future meeting with Ms. Morales. (NOTE: if you already have your FSA ID, please come to this session to get your attendance card punched)

8. Complete the FAFSA Application-Pay for College-40 minute session.

Counselors and college advisors will be on-hand to assist students with the FAFSA Application. Questions related to the entry of tax return information will be answered and students will have an opportunity to submit the application TODAY! For students who complete the application and submit, they will complete a short SURVEY which will enter them into a drawing for a variety of prizes. Students who begin an application but do not complete one, will be contacted by Ms. Morales in the coming day/weeks.

Mary Beth Santillan is the McKinney Vento liaison for the Amphitheater School District. She specializes in working with students who have been displaced due to homelessness and works to ensure their success at school. She has an extensive background in working with youth in the Tucson community.

Dan Wellborn is a Fiscal Advanced Analyst at Pima College in their Financial Aide Division. He has years of experience and expertise in financial aide application, eligibility and determinations. He is actively involved in working with area high school students.

Jessica Dale began her journey in education with a Bachelor of Arts in Psychology while teaching Child Development to high school students. She later earned a masters of education in the school counseling graduate program at the University of Arizona and continuing her journey a counselor.

9. Acing the Interview- 40-minute session

Christopher Boknevitz currently teaches English here at AHS. This is his 9th year teaching (4 in middle school and the last 5 in high school). He has a bachelor's degree in Psychology, a master's degree in secondary education and is currently attending the University of Arizona for a master's in Education Leadership. He has been hired by every employer he's interviewed with. In this session, you will create a brief professional introduction that can be used in response to "tell me about yourself." Students will be introduced to 5 popular interview questions along with criteria for excellent responses.
