Amphitheater Public Schools (“District”) agrees to loan the laptop computer device identified below (“Device”) to the student named below for educational purposes. While the District provides protection from harmful material through the use of filtering software, parents and students who borrow a Device from the District have the ultimate responsibility for using the Device in a responsible matter, to access the internet for educational purposes, according to District guidelines and policy. Additional information regarding permissible technology use in the District can be found in the Student Code of Conduct and Parent Information Book.

1. Parent and student agree that the Device is for student use only and may only be used for education through the District. The Device belongs to the District and remains District property throughout the term of this Agreement.
2. The Device must be returned to the District in working order with all accessories upon the earlier of: (i) withdrawal from the District, (ii) request for return from the school or the District administration, or (iii) the last day of the current school year.
3. Student must use the Device for appropriate educational purposes only and in compliance with Governing Board Policy IJDNB (Use of Technology Resources in Instruction) and its corresponding regulation, the Student Code of Conduct, all copyright and trademark laws and regulations, and this Agreement. Violation of any of these rules may result in a loss of permission to use the Device and further disciplinary action.
4. Student may not use the Device to retrieve, send, or display offensive images or messages, insult, threaten or harass others, post anonymous communication or use the internet or District network resources to engage in cyberbullying, illegal, inappropriate, or obscene purposes.
5. Accessing or downloading VPNs or other proxy-avoiding extensions with the intent of bypassing District security features and filtering is prohibited.
6. Student will properly maintain, care for, and use the Device. Parent understands and agrees that parent is financially responsible for the repair/replacement costs of the Device if the Device is damaged, lost or stolen.
7. The student or parent must report any lost, stolen or damaged Device(s) to the school immediately. If the Device is stolen, the theft must be reported to a law enforcement agency and a copy of the police report must be delivered to the school.
8. If the Device is not returned when required by this agreement, after notice to the parent and student the District may report the loss to a law enforcement agency as willful failure to return loaned property in violation of A.R.S. 13-1802 or seek other legal remedies.
9. The student must not alter the configuration of the Device or accompanying software. Copying or installing software on the Device is prohibited.
