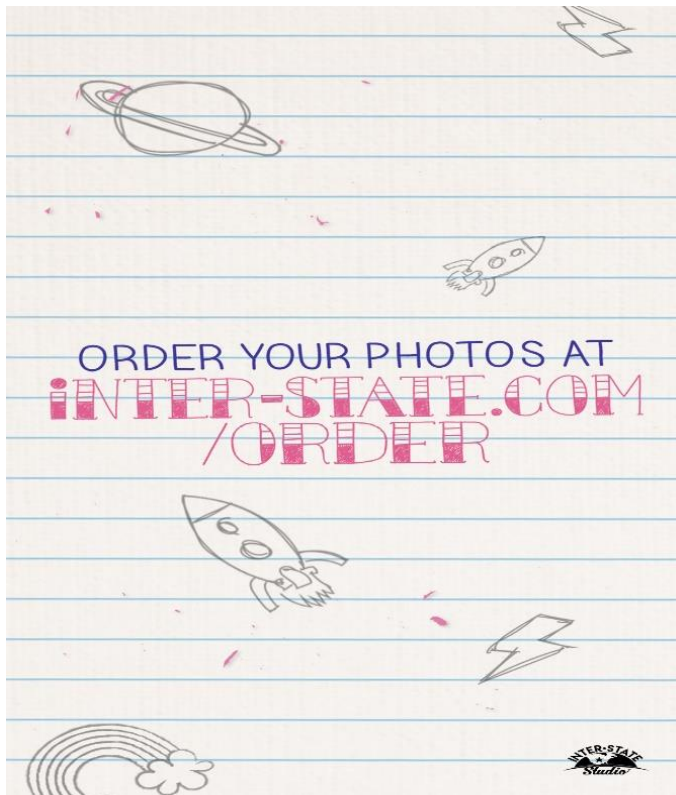

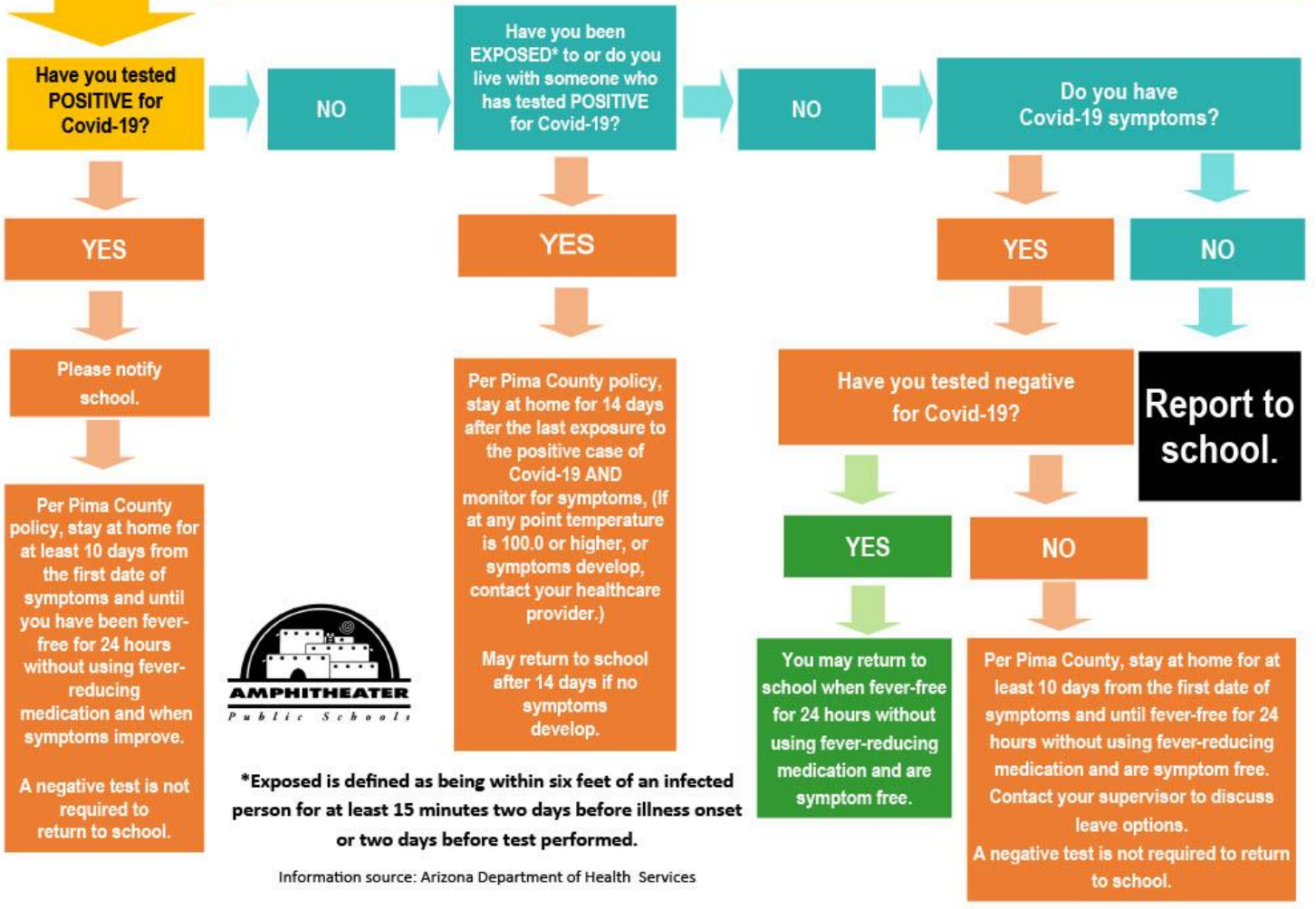
Dismissal Procedures
