State Testing Information for Grades 3-5

Arizona students in grades 3-5 will participate in computer-based state tests that measure students' knowledge of math, reading, writing, oral fluency, and science. The Arizona Department of Education has hired Pearson to host the platform of computerbased testing. The math, reading, writing, and oral reading fluency tests are called the Arizona's Academic Standards Achievement (AASA) tests. The science test, measured in grade 5, is called Arizona's Science Assessment (AzSCI). Information about the assessments can be found on the Arizona Department of Education website at https://www.azed.gov/assessment/aasa and https://www.azed.gov/assessment/sci .

WHO: Grade 3 students will participate in one test unit of oral reading fluency, one test unit of writing, two test units of reading, and two test units of math. Grade 4 students will participate in one test unit of writing, two test units of reading, and two test units of math. Grade 5 students will participate in one test unit of science, one test unit of writing, two test units of reading, and two test units of math.

WHAT: Arizona Department of Education has hired Pearson as the computer-based testing platform. English Language Arts and Math will be assessed within the AASA test. In Grade 5, science will be assessed within AzSCI.



BIG POTENTIAL

WHERE: The majority of students will test in their homeroom unless they have a plan to test in a room with a smaller group of students per their Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or 504.

WHEN: Walker Elementary School will be testing the following dates:

April 4 - Grade 3,4,5 Writing April 5 - Grade 4,5 Math April 6 - Grade 3 Oral Fluency, Grade 5 Science April 7 - Grade 3 Oral Fluency, Grades 4,5 Reading April 8 - Grade 3 Oral Fluency April 12 - Grade 3 Reading April 14 - Grade 3 Math

WHY: The statewide tests are part of a larger state and local assessment system. Locally selected and administered tests measure a student's progress through the year. The statewide assessment, which set high expectations for students, are summative assessments that measure and evaluate students learning at the end of the school year. Please know that the **Third Grade** test is a **High Stake Measure** that determines whether students move on to fourth grade. This based on a student's Move On When Reading score. All schools and students are required by state and federal law to participate in statewide testing. Amphitheater School District's mitigation plan will continue to be in place during the administration of state achievement tests.
