

## U.S & World Map Activity

**Note = All RA (Reference Atlas) maps can be found by clicking on Atlas at the top of the textbook homepage. Go to Ch 2/Place and Time for the map on pages 26-27.**

*Directions = Use RA4 (North America Political) & RA5 (North America Physical) for #1-5. Use RA2/RA3 (World Political) & the map on pages 26-27 for #6. All labeling is to be done neatly in pen & all coloring/line patterns/symbols are to be done in colored pencil. The key for Step #2 should be done in both pen & colored pencil.*

1. Label all 50 states. Write out each state's complete name (no abbreviations & use your pre-test to help you) with each state. You may connect the name of a small state with a line if needed. Color in each half of the U.S. lightly with 2 different colored pencils (Alaska & Hawaii are part of the western half)
2. Using 5 different symbols or line patterns fill in the Great Lakes. Create a key at the top of your map that identifies each lake.
3. Label the following rivers directly on the map: Mississippi, Missouri, Ohio, Rio Grande, & Colorado.
4. Label the following two mountain ranges directly on the map & highlight them: Rockies and Appalachians.
5. Label the Gulf of Mexico, Atlantic Ocean, & Pacific Ocean.
6. World map = label all 7 continents and the 4 major oceans. Fill in each continent with a different line pattern, symbol, or color. You may use one color more than once.
