Ask parents first! Take out the spices in the kitchen, clean the cupboard. Arrange the spices in alphabetical order.	Write an original fairytale. Include beginning, middle, end with a conflict and resolution. Begin with "Once upon a time". End with "...and they lived happily ever after"	Make a puppet show with your stuffed animals. Include sound effects and a song. Make invitations to your family to watch your show.
Read a book, then write (or tell) a different ending. Draw a picture that goes with your new ending.	<i>Teach Someone</i> (brother, sister, parent, stuffed animals). Prepare and teach a lesson in reading, math or art.	Play music and make up a dance routine.
<u>Experiment:</u> Will an ice cube melt faster in 1 cup of water or in a bowl by itself?	Learn how to juggle 3 socks.	Learn to write your name in calligraphy.
Do an extra chore at home and surprise your parents. Write them a letter or poem telling them how much you love them.	<i>Creativity: Fluency</i> List as many things as you can think of that are moved around when the wind blows.	<i>Creativity: Originality</i> What does a HEXABIRD look like? Draw a picture and describe why its name is fitting.
<i>Creativity: Flexibility</i> What are 10 (or more) other uses for an umbrella?	<i>Creativity: Elaboration</i> Draw 3 wavy lines somewhere on a paper. Then add onto the lines so they are part of one larger picture. Include color and a creative title.	Math Fun How many feet of earthworms do baby robins eat every day? Clue: If a robin eats earthworms that are 2 inches long, it will eat 84 in a day.
Math Fun How far can a kangaroo jump, in feet? Clue: A kangaroo can jump 8 yards, 72 inches.	Math Fun How many muscles do you use to frown? Clue: You use 17 muscles to smile. It takes 26 more muscles to frown than to smile.	Math Fun What percentage of its life does an armadillo spend sleeping? Clue: An armadillo will sleep for 24 out of 30 days.
