
Typical Senior Year Schedule


- If you have passed all classes and earned enough credits (18),

 - Digital Learning, Honors Capstone, Honors Seminar, and Marching Band DO NOT count towards your 4


How to Choose Next Year Classes

- Parents must also log in to the parent portal and click the box to approve your plan


