

The deadline to apply is Wednesday, Oct. 18. In scope and value, the Flinn Scholarship is unlike almost any other undergraduate merit-based scholarship in the United States. The scholarship –valued at more than \$130,000 –covers tuition, fees, housing, and meals at one of Arizona's three public universities, plus study abroad, for about 20 high-achieving students each year.
