You are eligible to register as long as you are a US Citizen, resident of Arizona, will be 18 years old by 11/5/2024, and don't have a felony or treason conviction. Make sure to bring at least one of the following forms of identification: Drivers license or permit, AZ State ID card, last four digits of your social security numbers, tribal ID number, citizen certificate number. We'll have stickers and pins for all who register, can't wait to see you there!

The Dorrance Scholarship is a need-based award that aims to instill college-going traditions in future generations of Arizona families, to provide financial access and academic support for recipients, and to enhance college persistence through unique enrichment experiences.



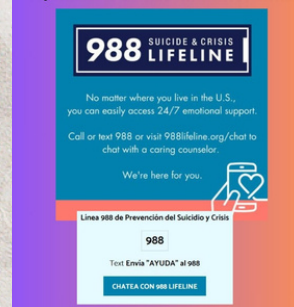
You may be eligible if you:

- Are an Arizona resident
- Are a current graduating senior attending a public, private, charter, or home school
- Will be a first-generation college student (neither parent, stepparent, or legal guardian holds a four-year degree from any country)
- Have a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA (weighted or unweighted)
- Have a minimum test score of 1110 SAT, 22 ACT, or 72 CLT
- Demonstrate financial need by completing the FAFSA
- Plan to attend ASU-Tempe, NAU-Flagstaff, UA-Tucson
- Agree to live in on-campus housing during freshman and sophomore year

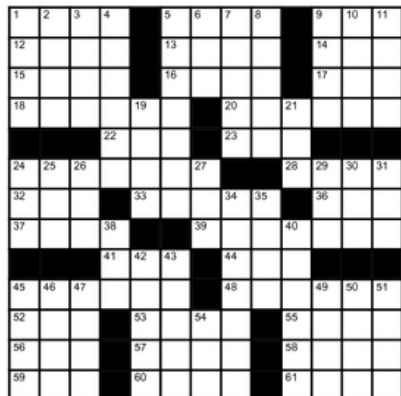
