

CAREER ADVICE

How to answer job interview questions:

For any question, think about utilizing a PAR (Problem-Action-Result) response. This is where you explain a Problem you faced, the Action that you did to address the problem and the Result of your actions.

When using a PAR response, you are sharing more information about yourself and how you handle various situations which allows your potential employer to learn more about you and your fit with their company.

Sample Interview Question & Response:

Q: Tell me about a time when you took a leadership role.

P - One day in history class, we were doing group work and nobody knew what we were doing. Everyone was too embarrassed to ask the teacher for

A - I didn't want to do poorly on the assignment, so I went in front of the class and asked the teacher to share the instructions again.

R - More than one of the groups were equally as lost as we were. I learned that by stepping out of my comfort zone to take the initiative for my group, I can help others along with myself in confusing situations
