A Note from our Principal

Hello Keeling Families,

As you may already know, our 3rd, 4th and 5th grade students are about to begin the AzMERIT test. You play an important part in helping students give their best performance on this important test. We have been busy preparing and reinforcing the skills necessary for students to demonstrate their learning. Even though this assessment is a snapshot one single perspective – it is important that our students have every advantage to do their very best. We don't want to cause test anxiety, rather we want our students to be as prepared as possible. There are many ways in which you can help your child put his/her best foot forward. The following guidelines can help set our students up for success:

The night before the test:

1. Make sure your child goes to bed on time so he or she is well-rested.

2. Keep your routine as normal as possible. Upsetting natural routines may make children feel insecure.

3. Be positive and confident in the fact that you know your child will do his/her best.

4. Plan ahead to avoid conflicts on the morning of the test.

The morning of the test:

1. Get up a few minutes early to avoid rushing and make sure your child arrives at school on time.

2. Have your child dress comfortably.

3. Be positive and communicate that this is your child's chance to show what he/she knows. The most important thing you can do right before the test is to build confidence about doing his/her very best.

I know our students will do well and I wish them all the best of luck on this important test!
