Keeling is very proud of our three SARSEF (Southern Arizona Region Science and Engineering Fair) winners! These winners were chosen out of almost 2,000 projects.

- Ms. Inbody's class won 1st Place Grand Prize in their category of Medicine and Health Sciences. The goal of this project was to determine the connection between an active body and an increase in the brain's memory function.
- 2. Ms. Englert's class won 2<sup>nd</sup> Place Grand Prize in their category of Engineering and Materials Science. Their project involved 16 first graders using the engineering design process to design, create, and test two different prototypes with the goal of protecting a raw egg when dropped from a playground slide. Students chose from a variety of containers and materials and used their data to determine which materials were most successful in keeping egg shells intact.
- 3. Yuritza Velazquez and Stephanie Warnes Martinez received a **Youth in Science** award for their project in the category of Engineering and Materials Science. Their project asked the question "Can different types of material in a barrier hold back the water of a Tsunami?"


