#### Hello Keeling Families!

I can't believe it is already March! The time has just flown by this year. We have so many wonderful things going on at our school. We just completed our first annual Keeling Science Fair! We had over 130 people attend our night time viewing. Several families participated in our "Tower of Power" building activity. I'm so proud to work at a school where we have such great parent involvement. We are taking 10 projects to SARSEF (the Southern Arizona Regional Science and Engineering Fair) at the U of A. Hopefully some of our Keeling students will win a ribbon there also!

We also just received our DIBELS results. DIBELS (Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills) is a reading test that our kindergarten and first grade students take three times per year. I'm pleased to announce that our kindergarten students' scores are higher than our district average! This is amazing news! Way to go, kindergartners!!! We're so proud of you.

My last bit of exciting news is that our first grade students have joined our Math Challenge for the first time ever! Students learn their basic math facts and once per month participate in a challenge to see if they can beat the clock! Numerous first graders passed their first test and will now go on to sit with the second and third graders during the math challenge. We are delighted with their progress and ability to quickly learn math facts. Please ask your child about how they did in the latest Math Challenge.


