


IF A STUDENT APPEARS TO BE SICK



* Fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, muscle aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea

**Close contacts are defined as being within six feet of an infected person for a total 15 minutes over 24 hours. This applies two days before illness onset or two days before test was performed.

*** Quarantine period can be shortened if: 1. Individual does not live in a congregate setting; 2. They have no symptoms; 3. They monitor their symptoms through Day 14; and 4. They adhere to safety measures (masking, physical distancing, etc.) through Day 14. If conditions 1-4 are met, quarantine can end on Day 11 without testing if no symptoms have developed. Quarantine can end on Day 8 if the individual has no symptoms and provides school or department with proof of a negative test no earlier than Day 5.
