







Distribution of English Language Learners






Distribution of English Language Learners: District





Distribution of Special Education Students






Distribution of REACH Students

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





How Have Our Attendance Patterns Changed?


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Enrollment on the 100th Day








Average Daily Attendance (1st through 100th Day)


Average Daily Attendance (Year-End)







MAP Fall to Spring (2012-13) Growth: Elementary School










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Graduation Rate: By School and Special Program Membership


