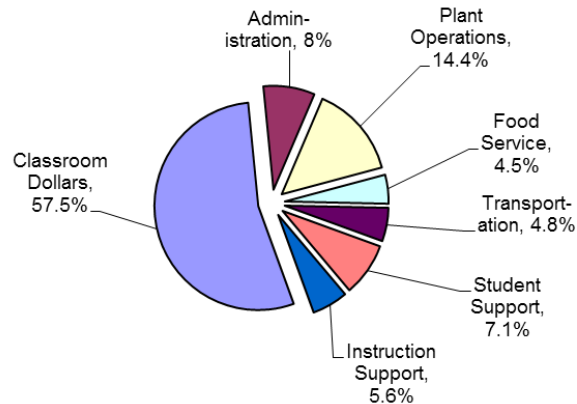

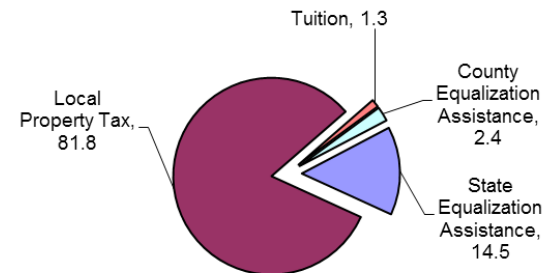
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District Spending by Function (2012-13)

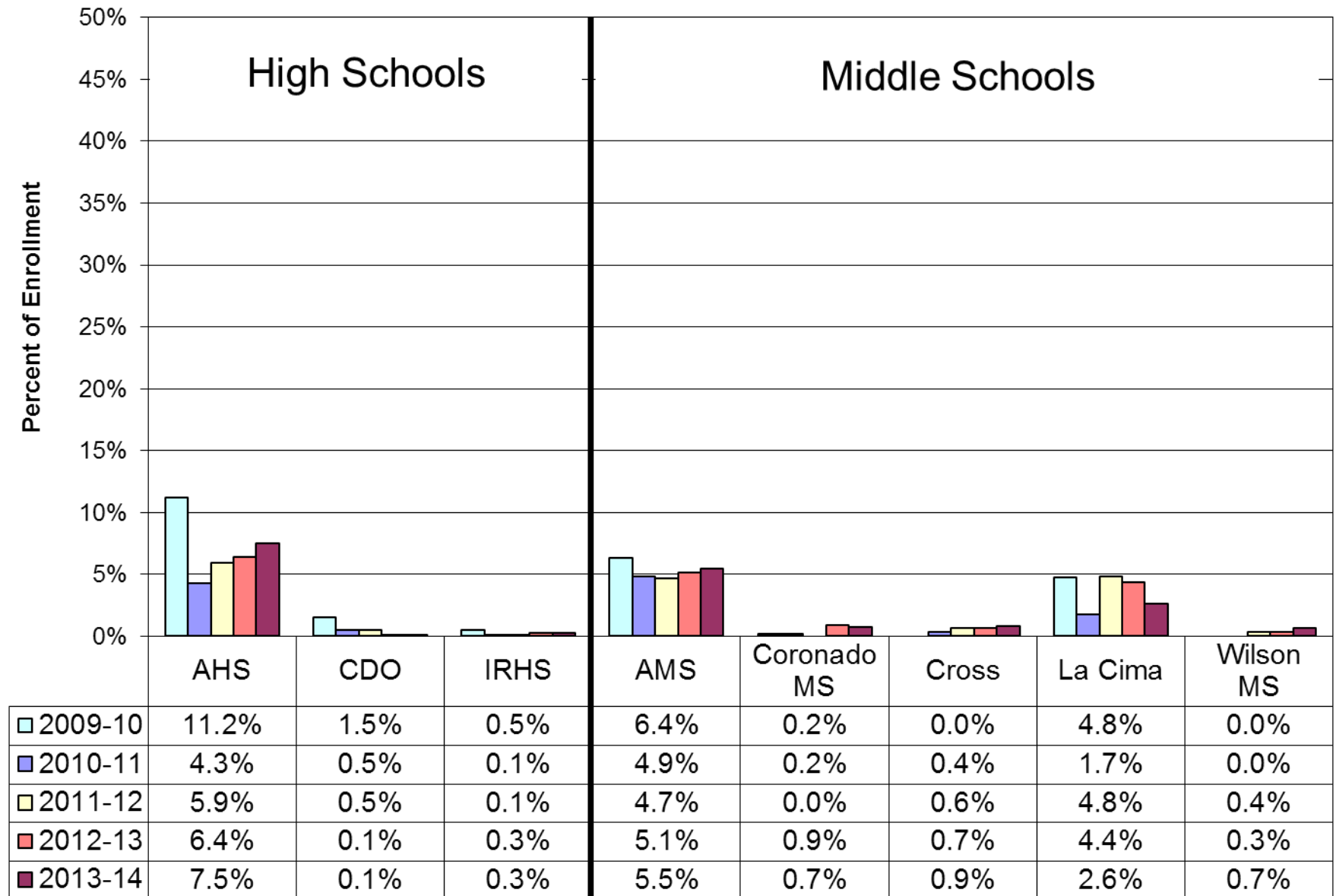

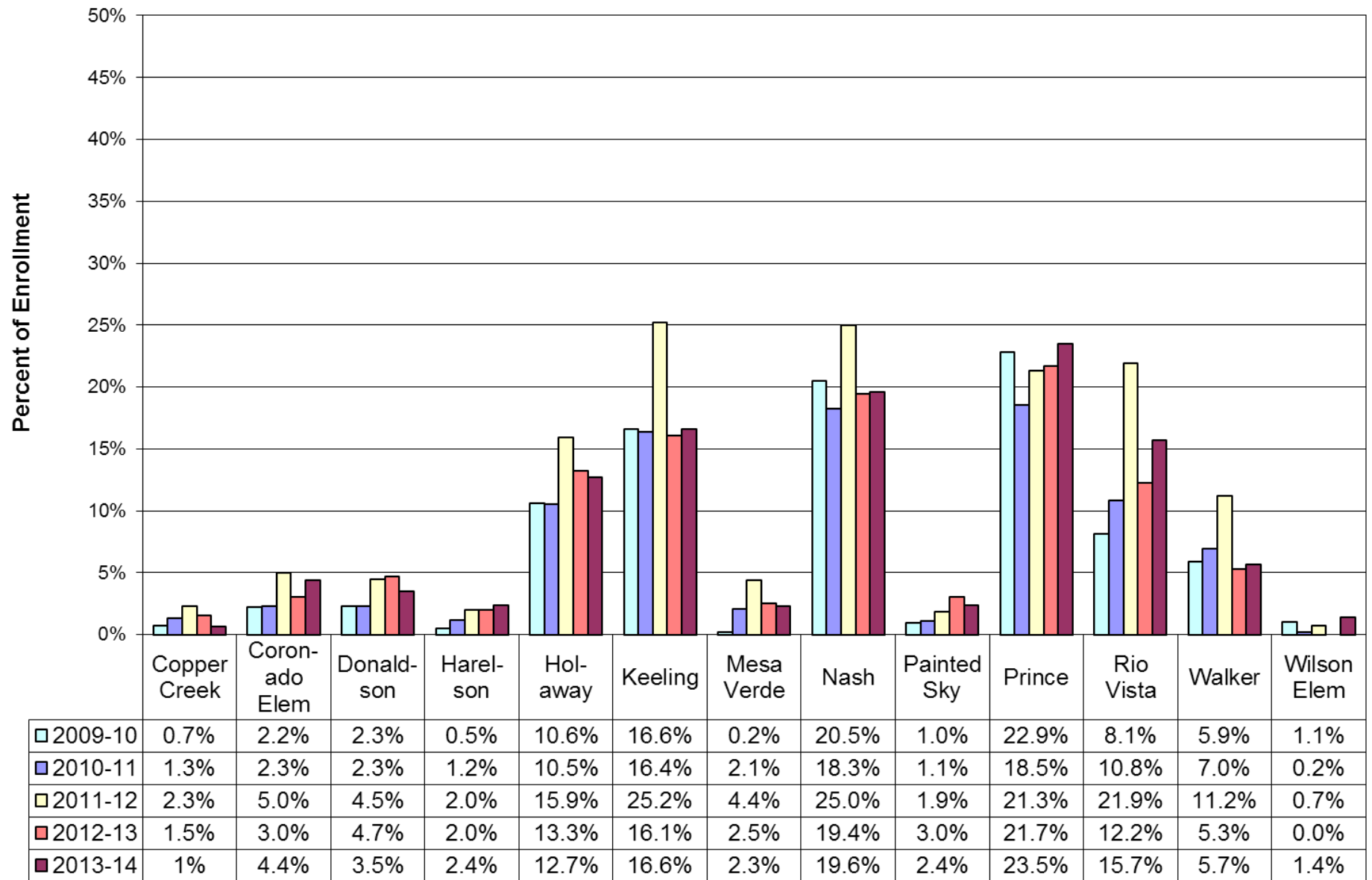

Distribution of English Language Learners



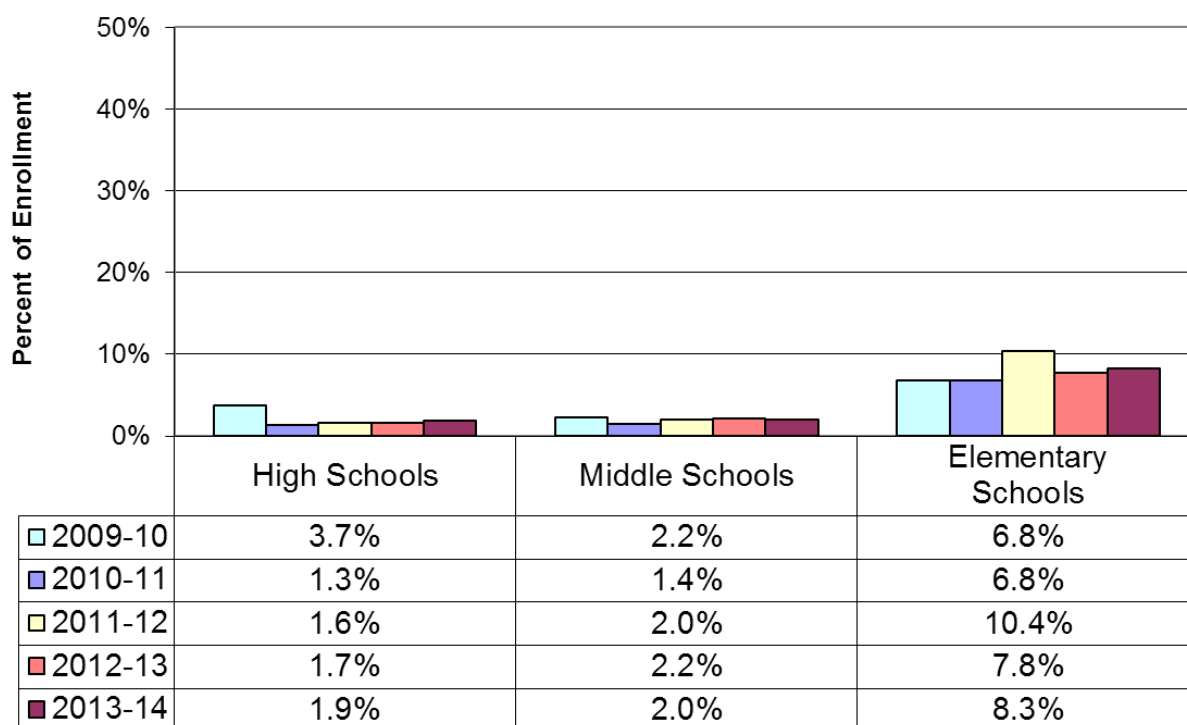

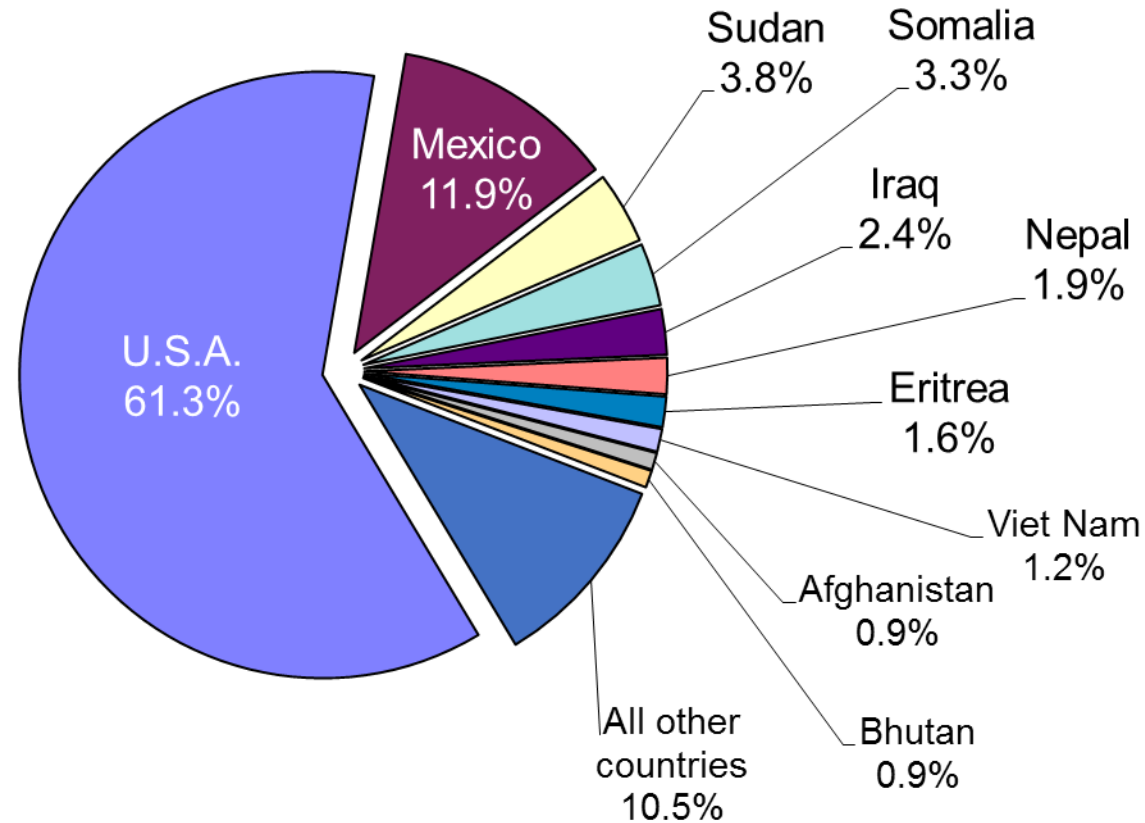
Distribution of English Language Learners: District

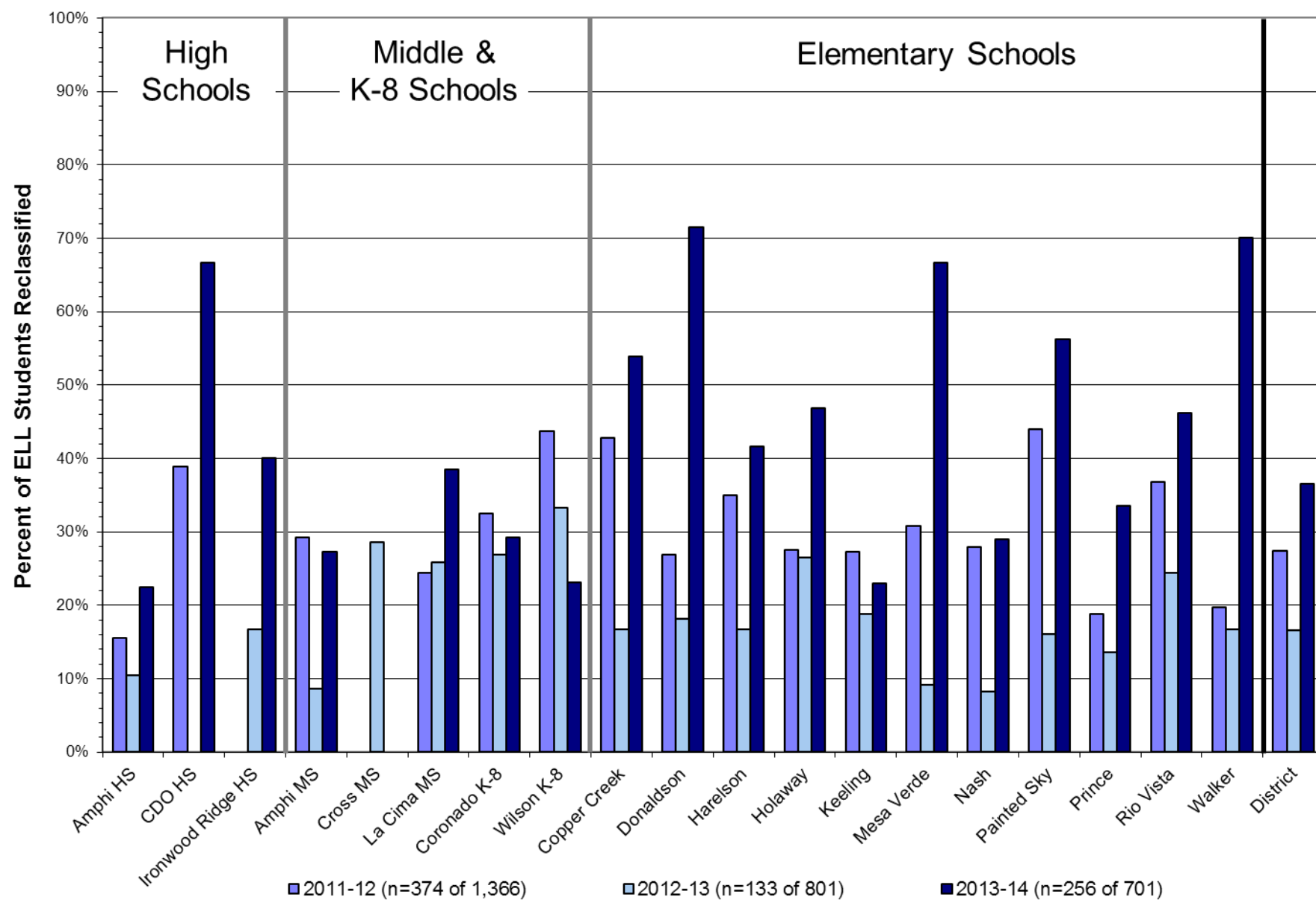
Country of Birth for ELL Students

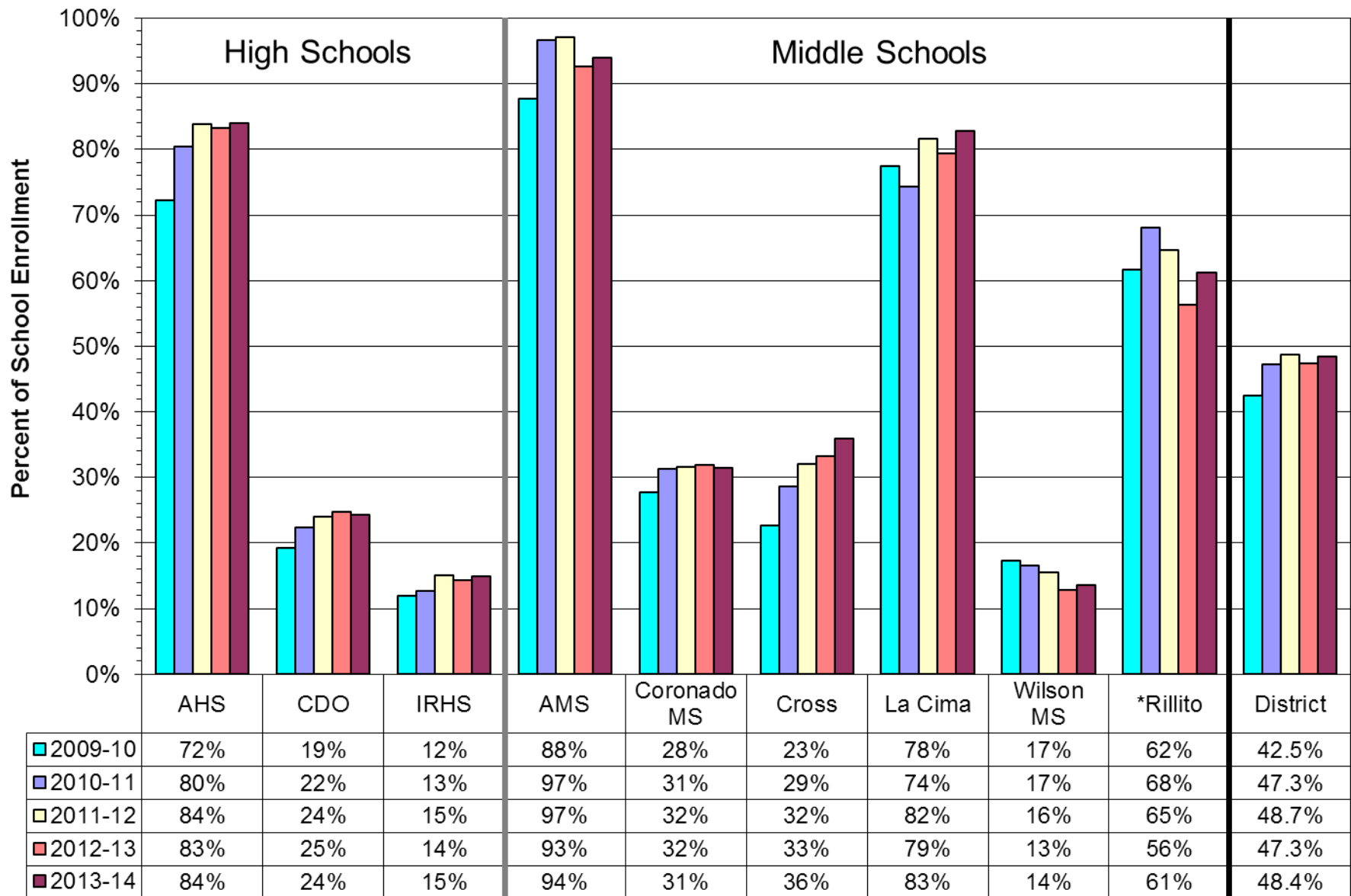
Distribution of Reclassified English Language Learners



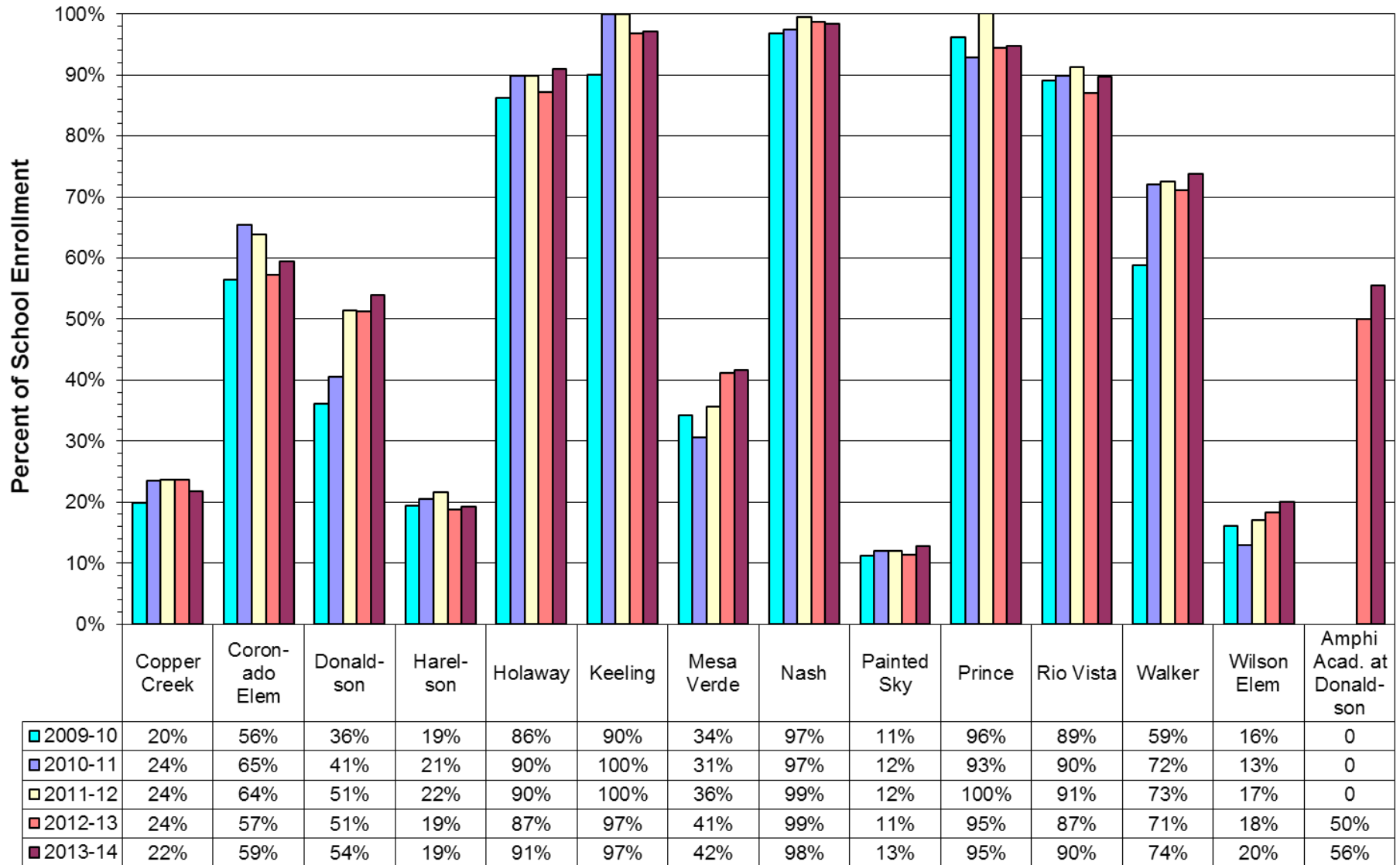

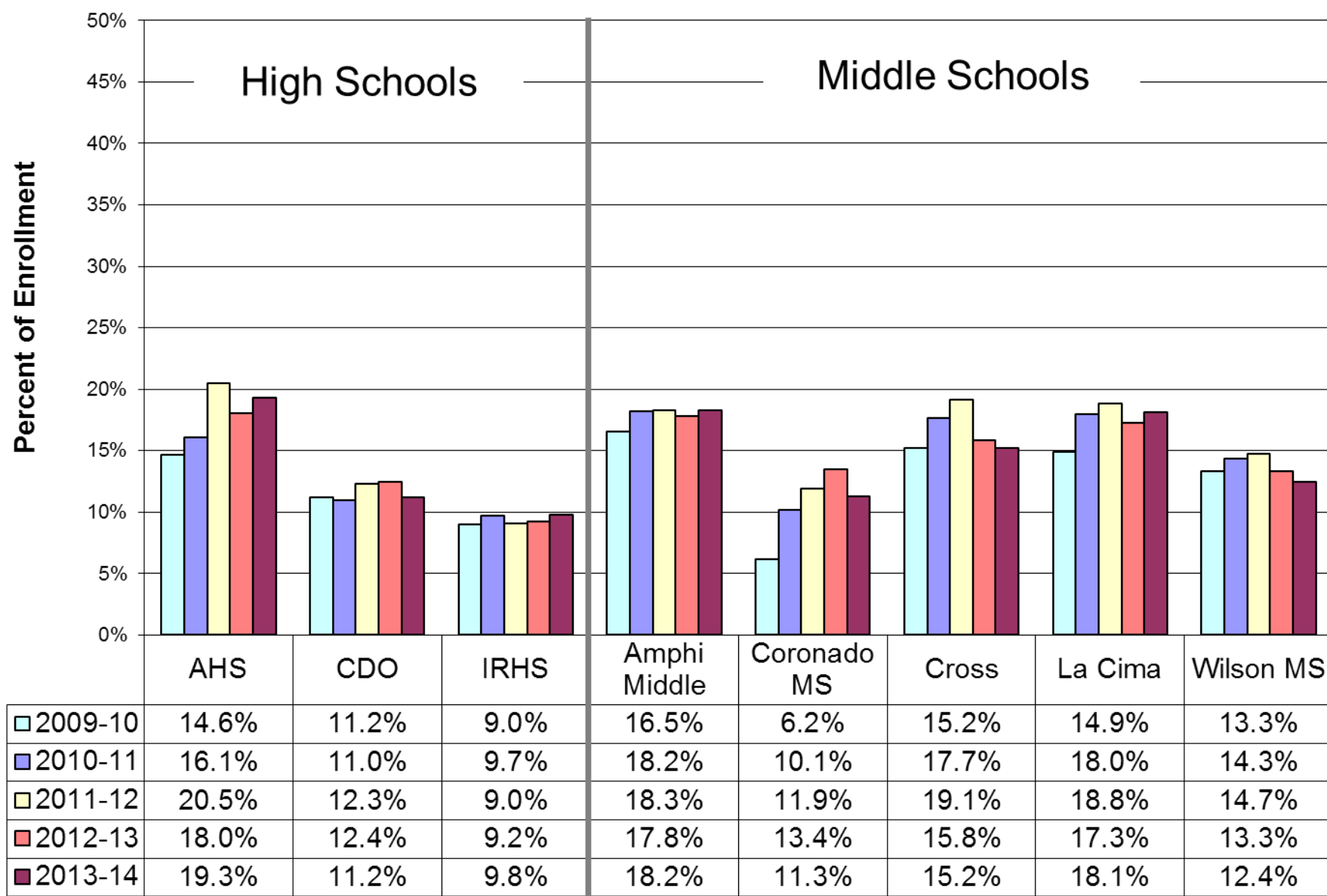

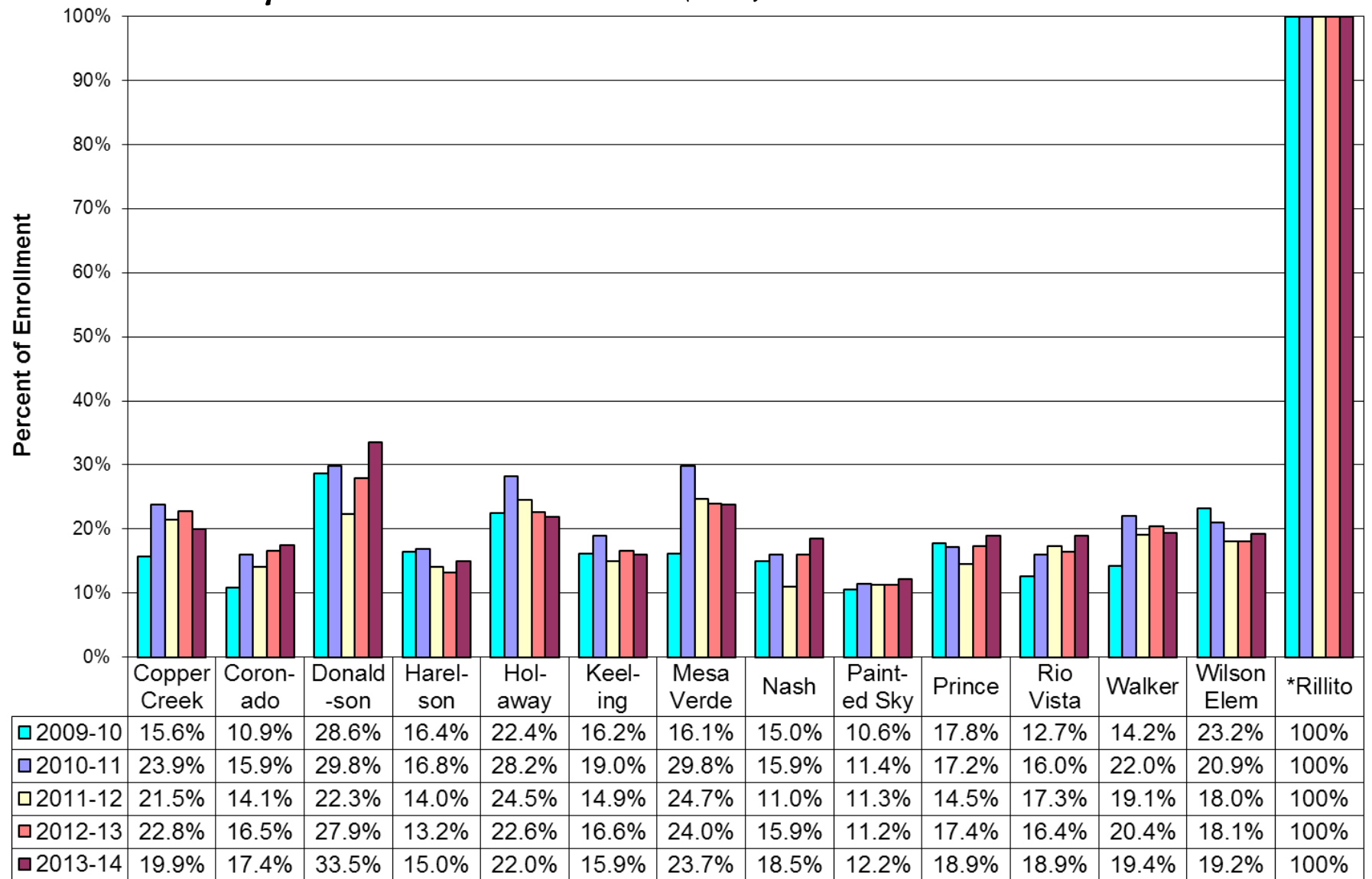

Distribution of Special Education Students

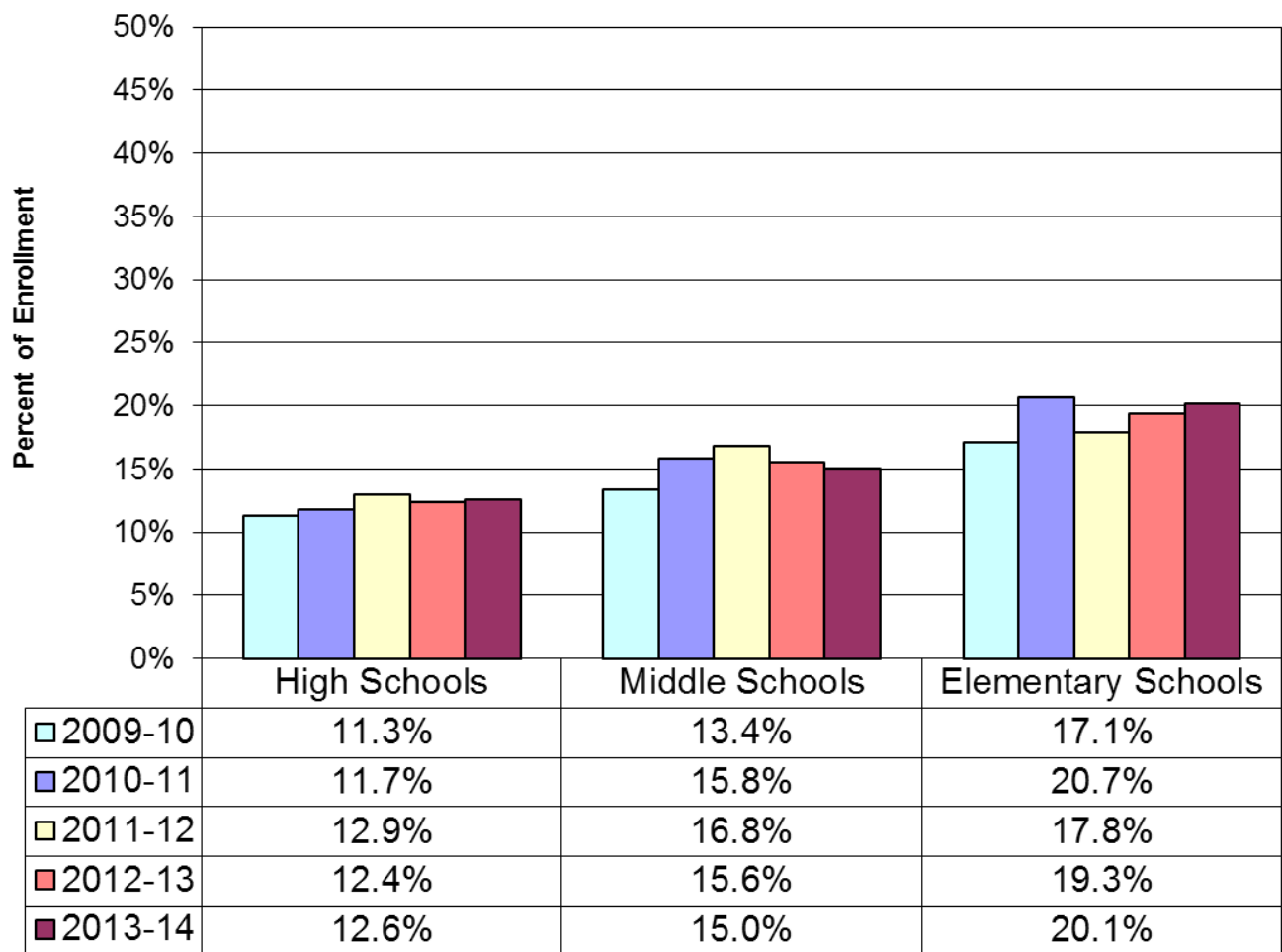

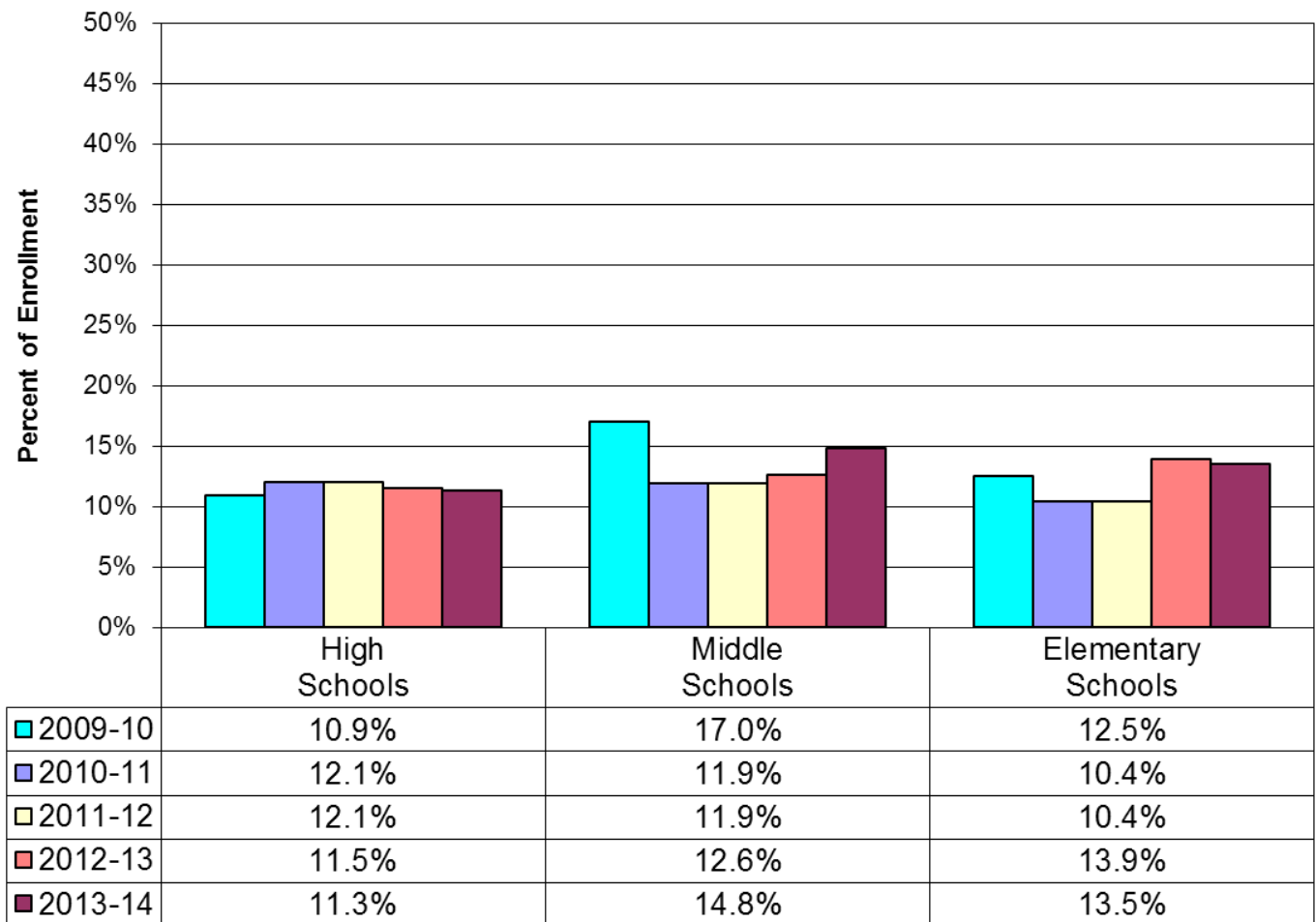
Distribution of REACH Students

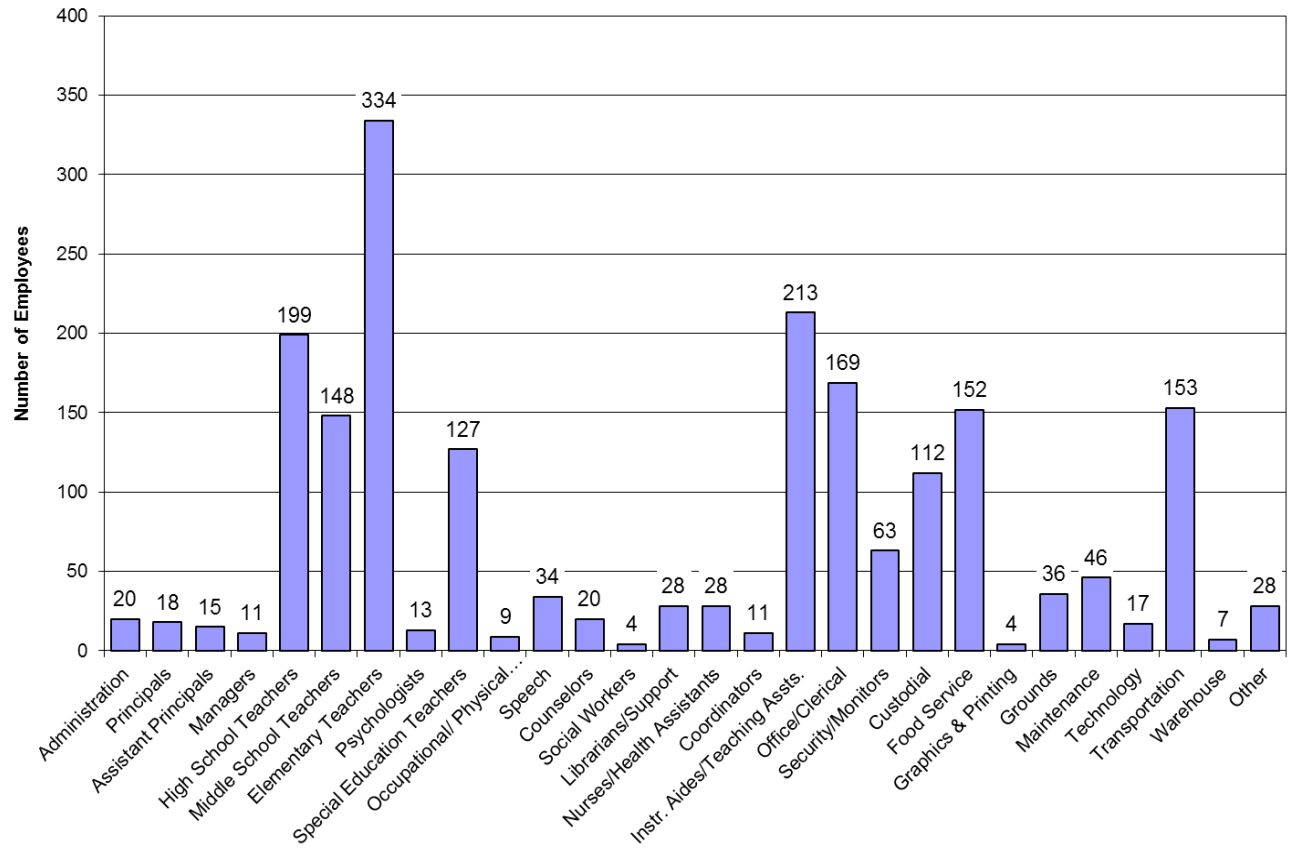

Teacher Turnover Rate & Reason Given for Leaving



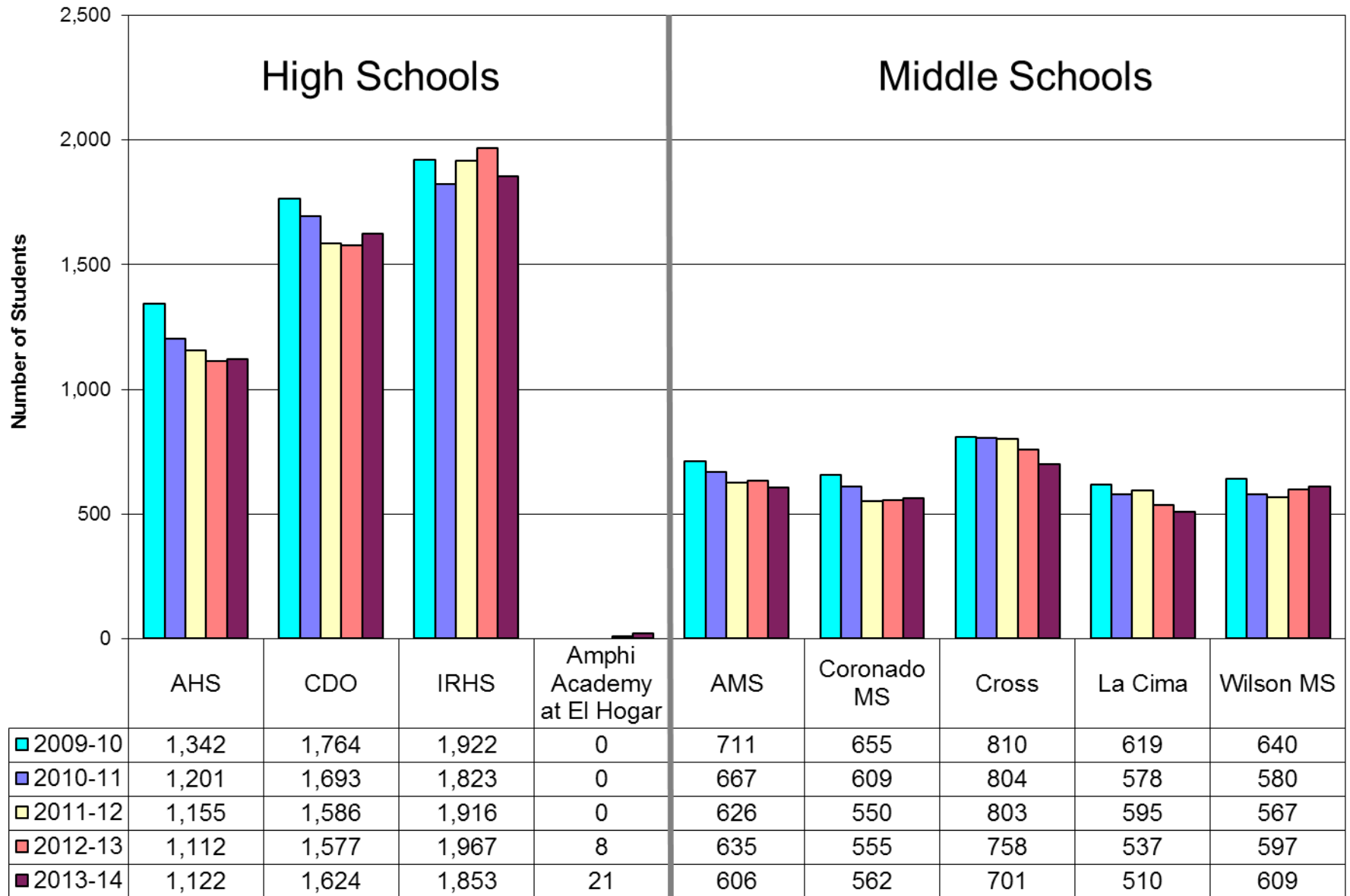

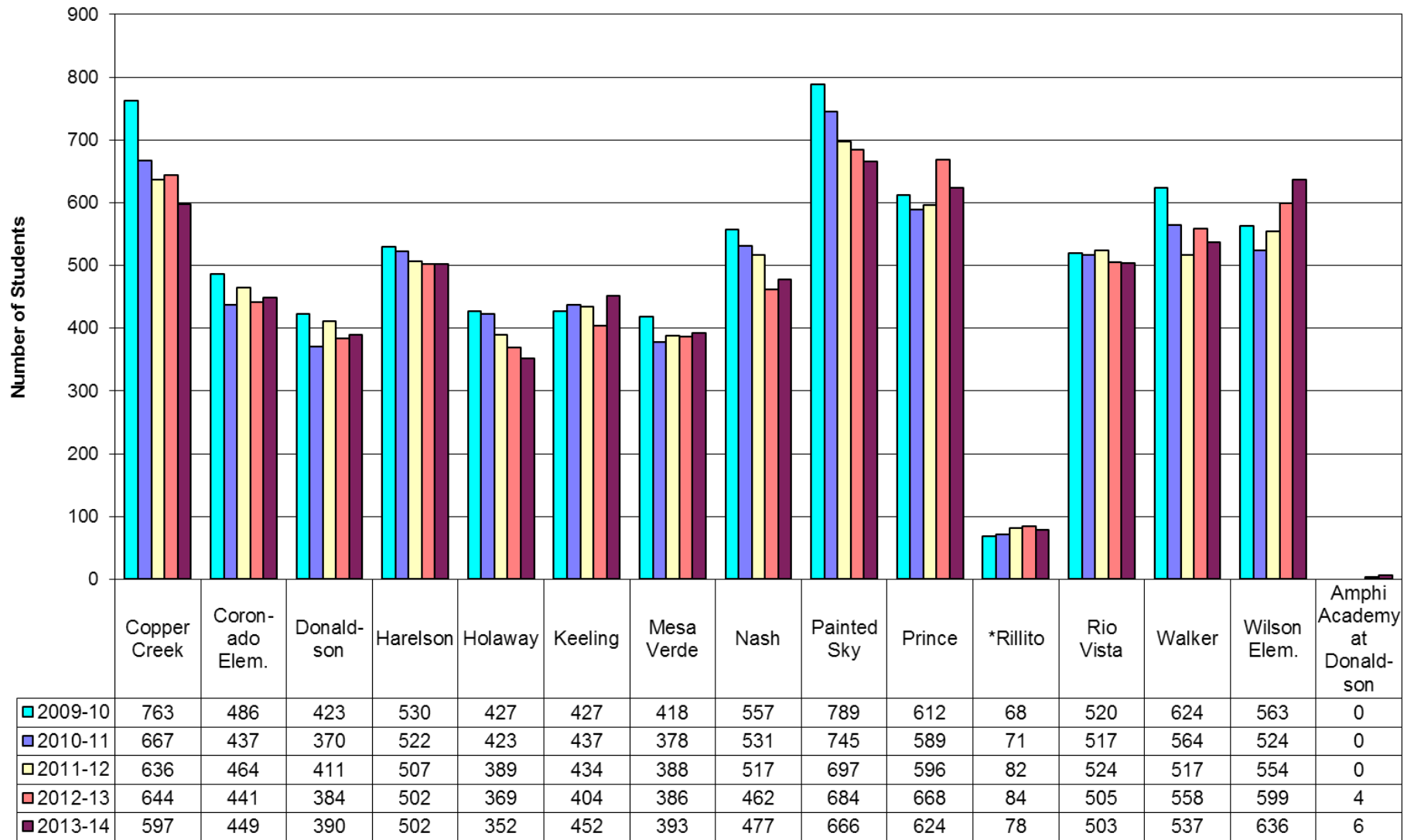
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Enrollment on the 100th Day

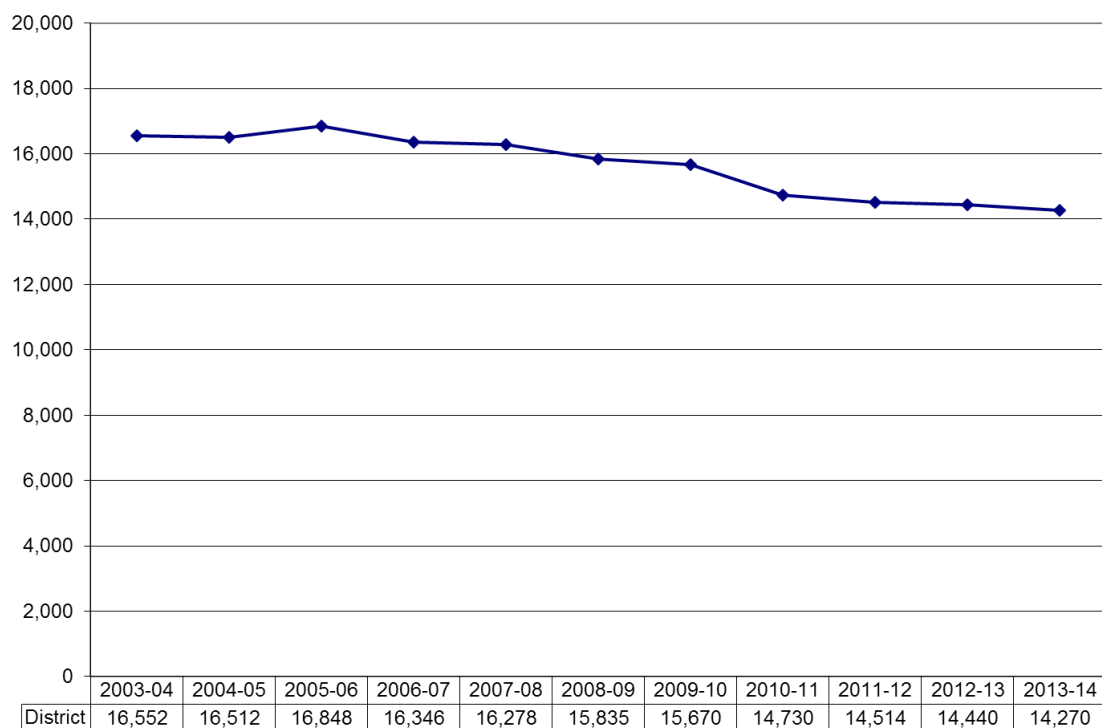
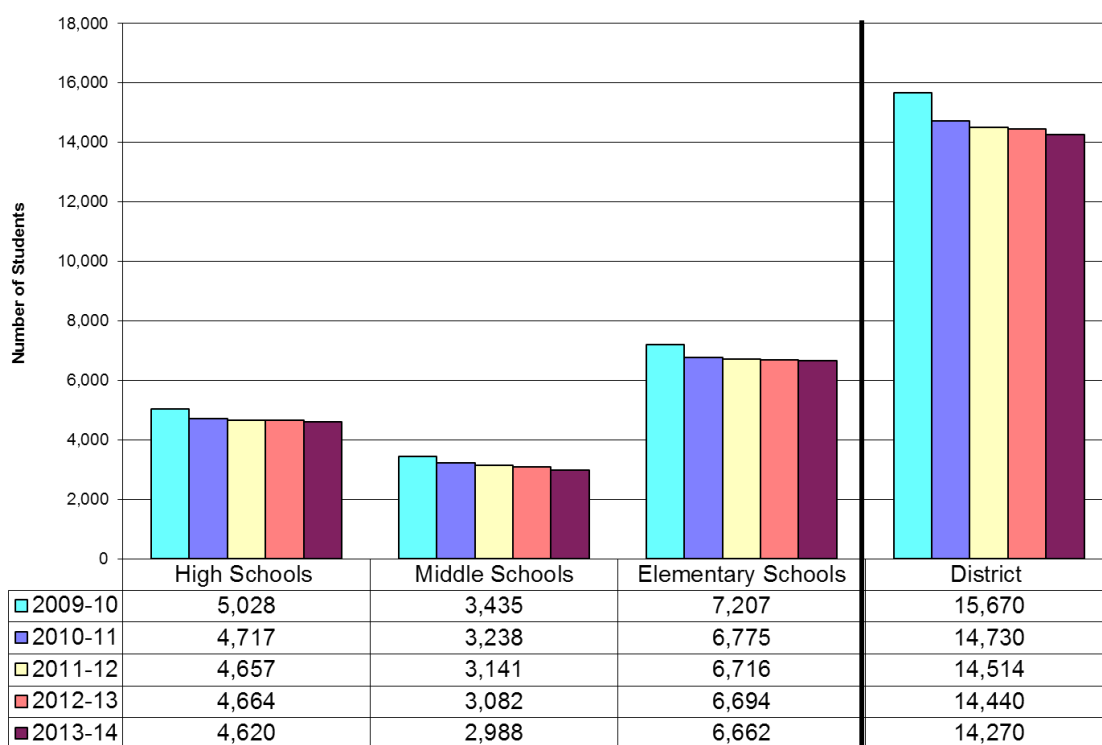

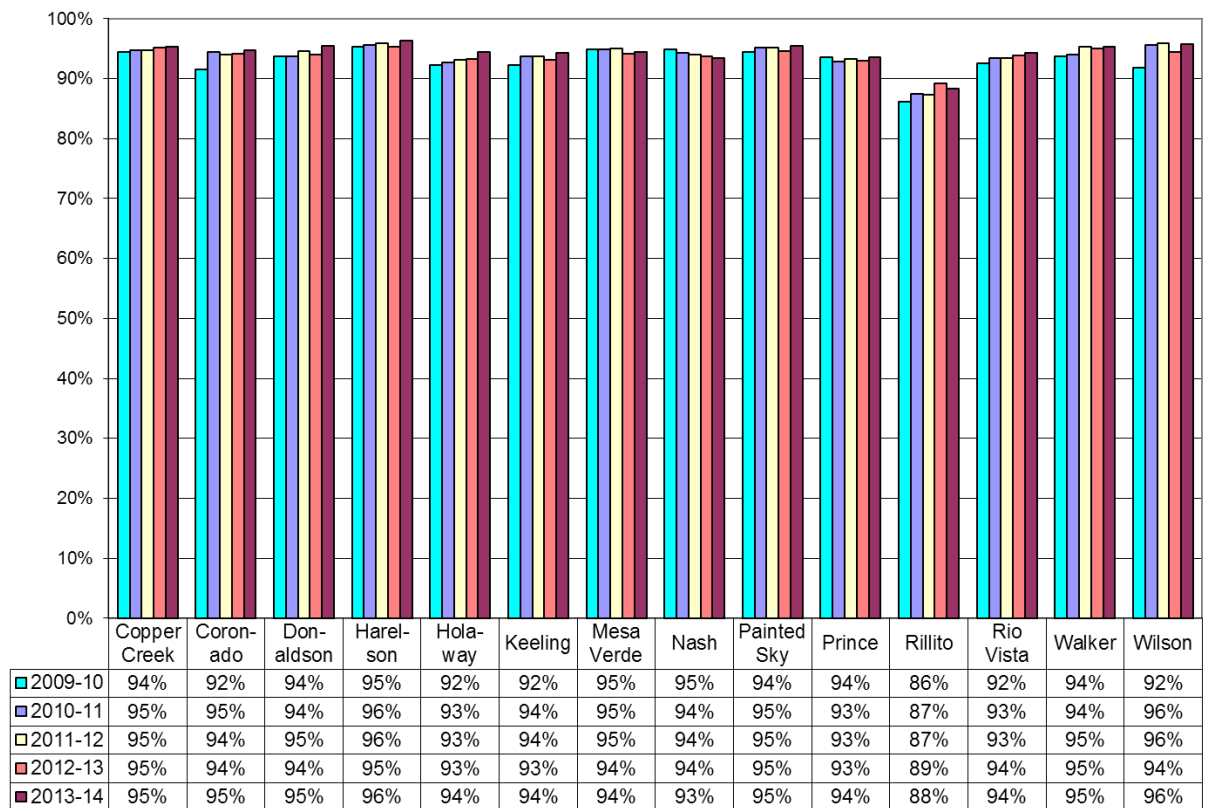
Enrollment on 100th Day & Historical Trend

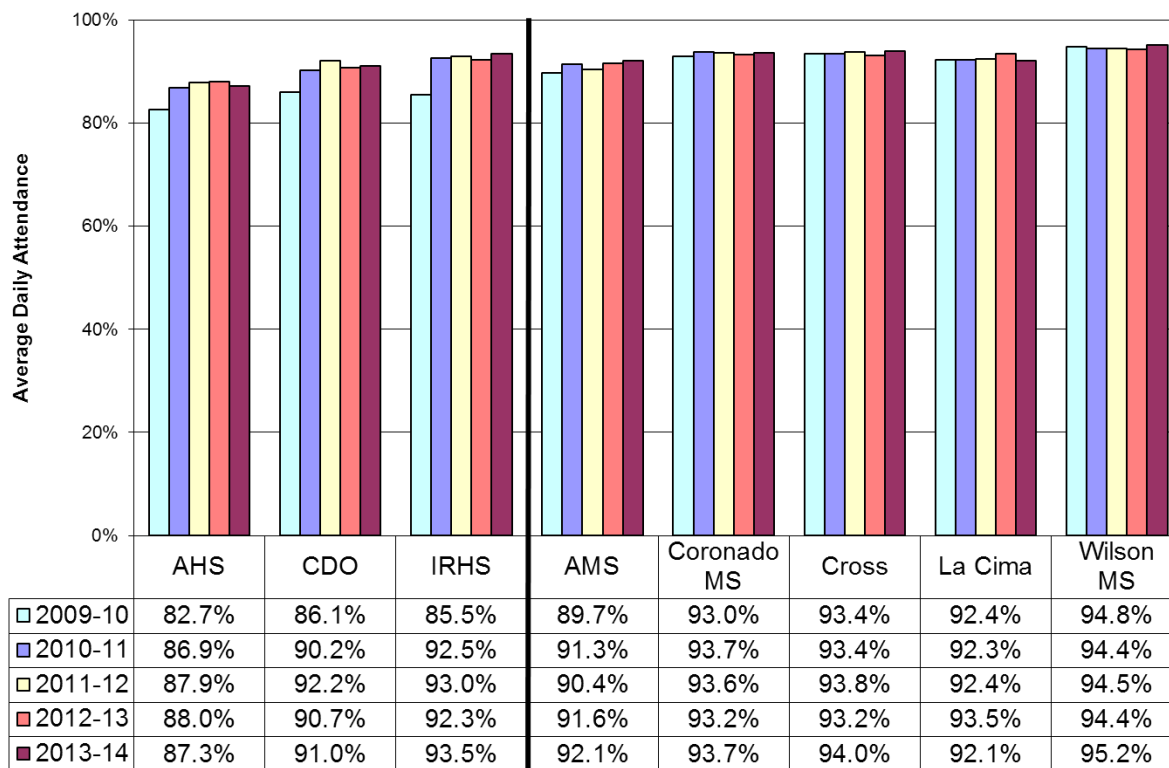
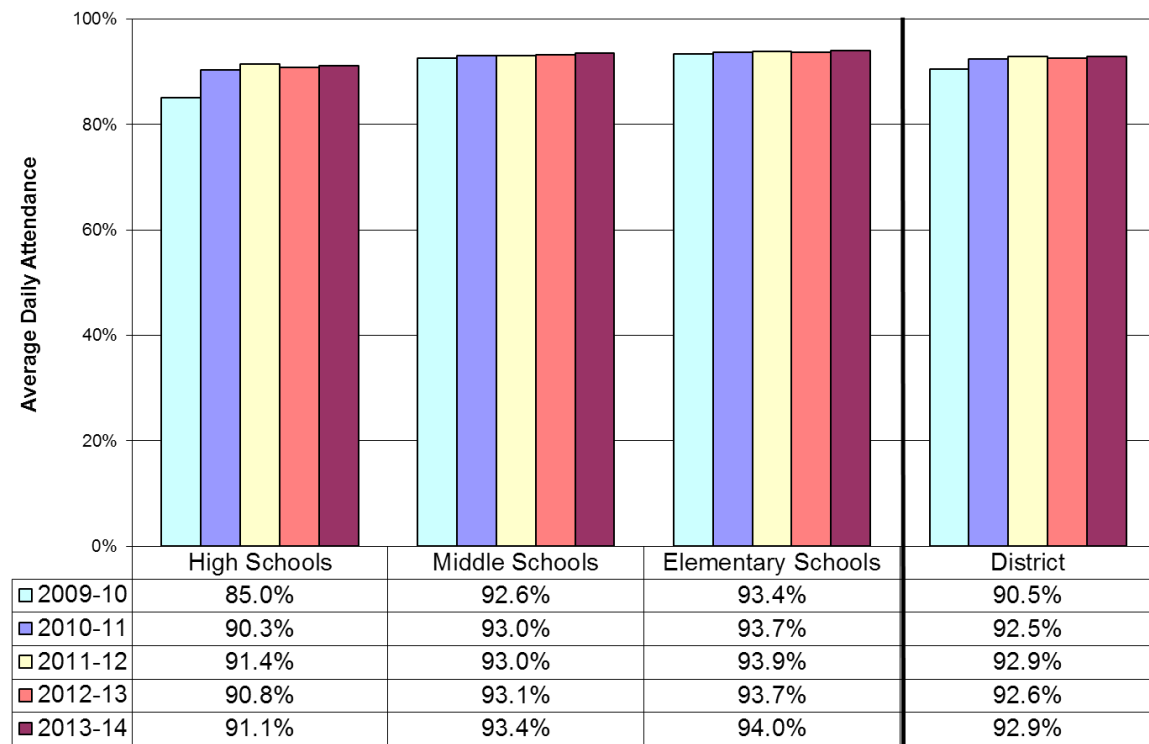

Average Daily Attendance – 1st through 100th Day



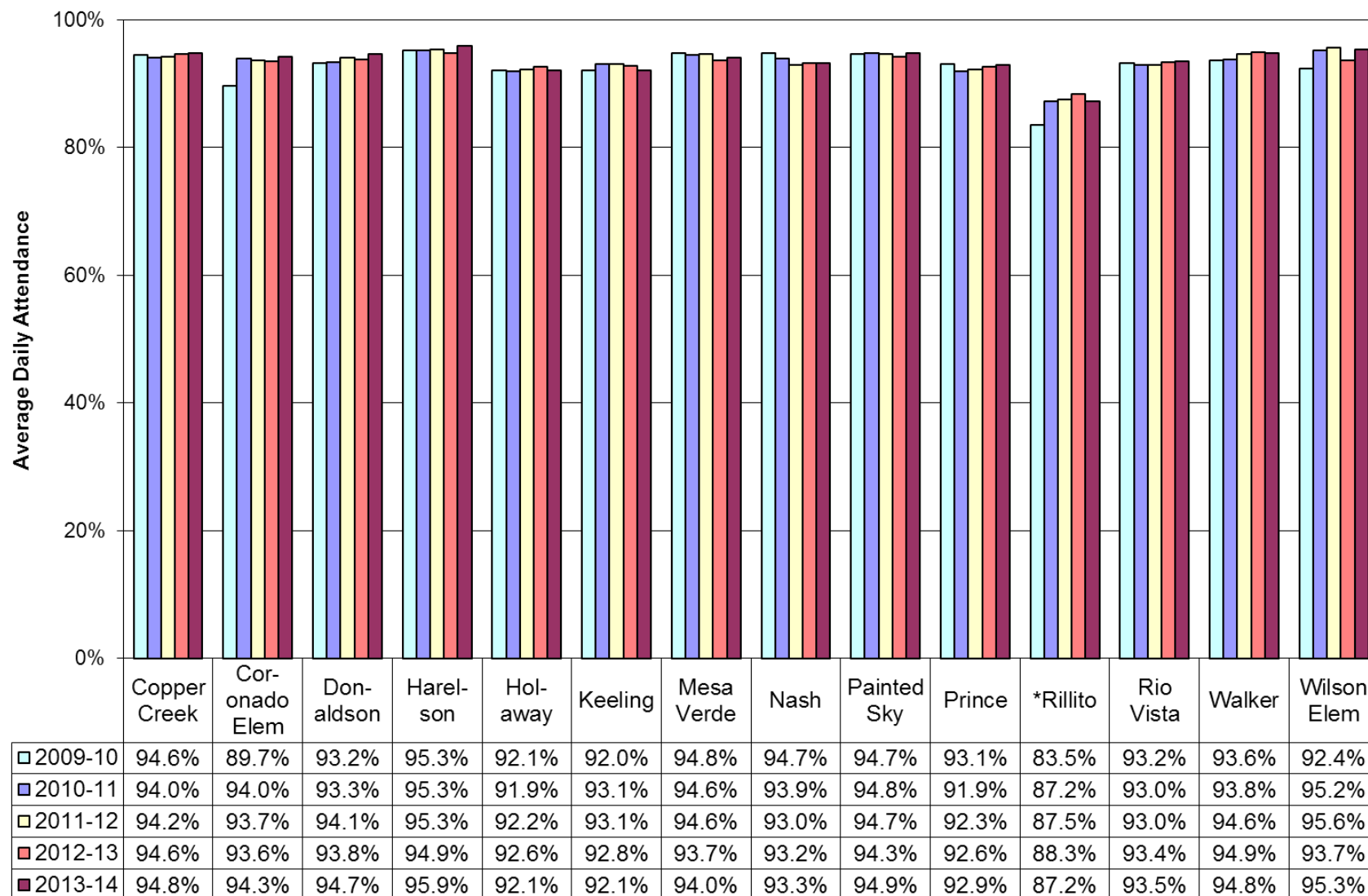

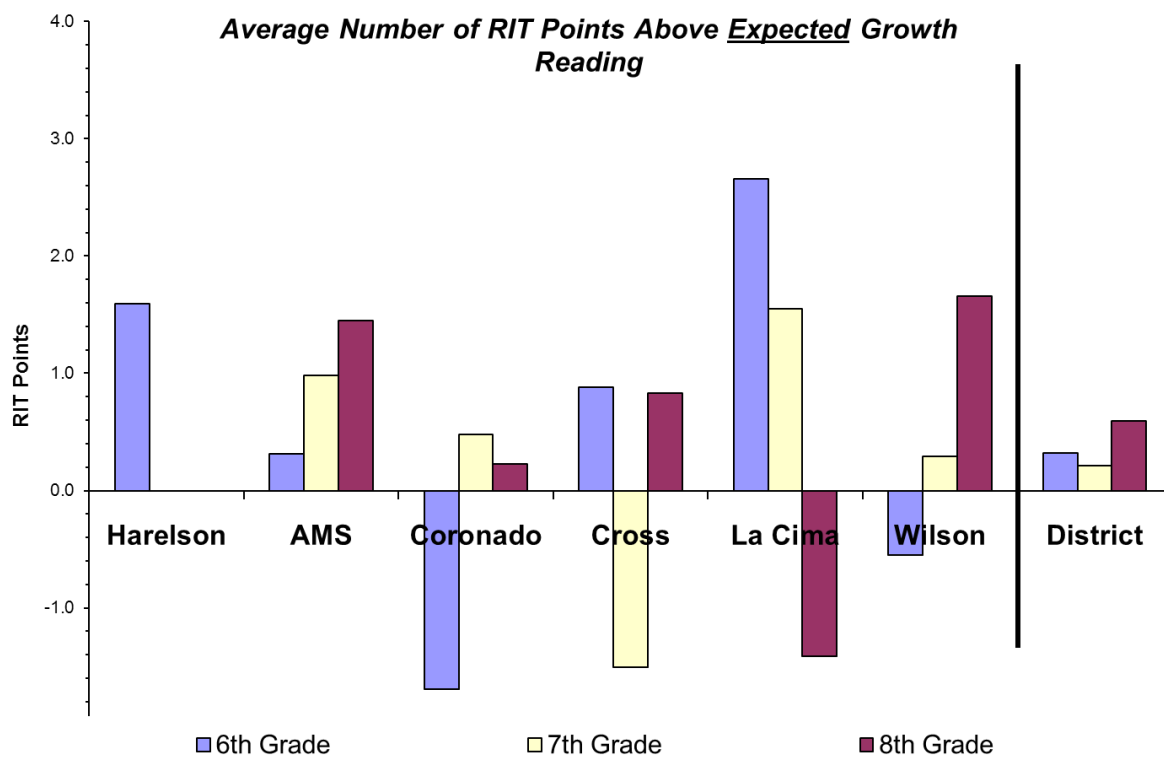
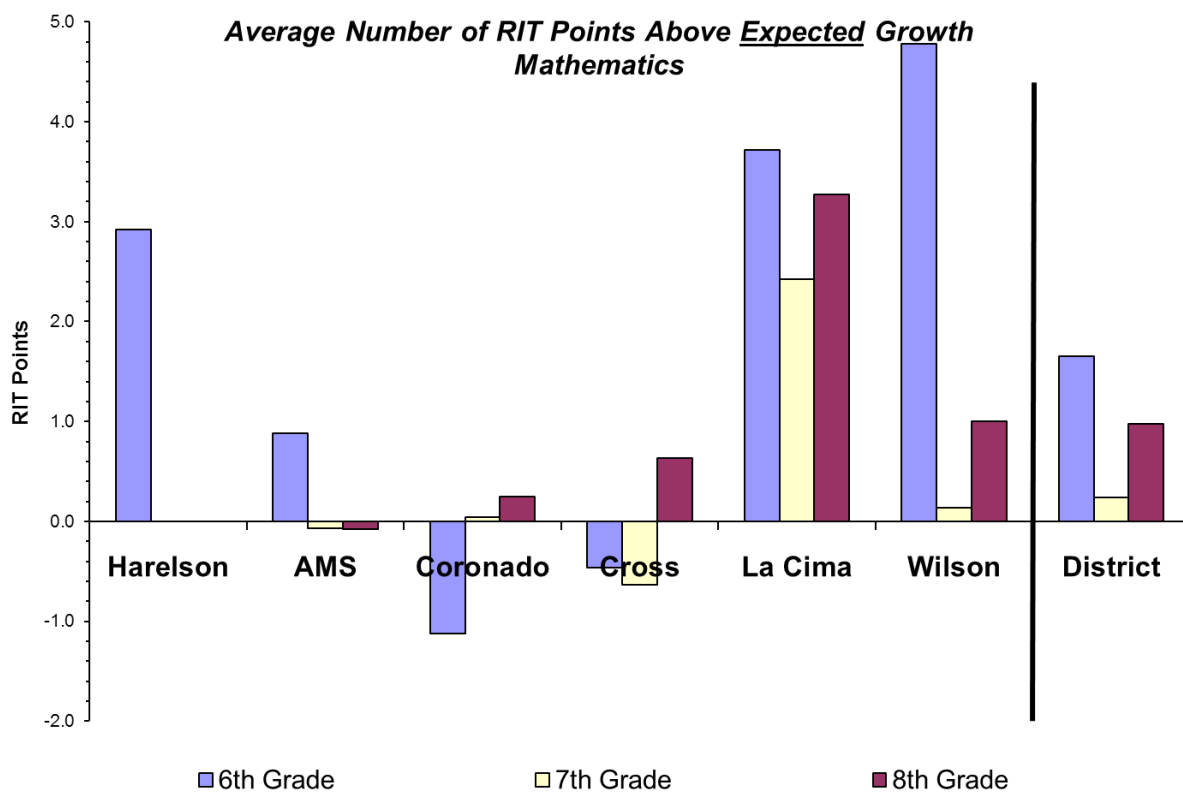
MAP Fall to Spring (2013-14) Growth: Elementary School

Average Number of RIT Points Above Expected Growth Mathematics





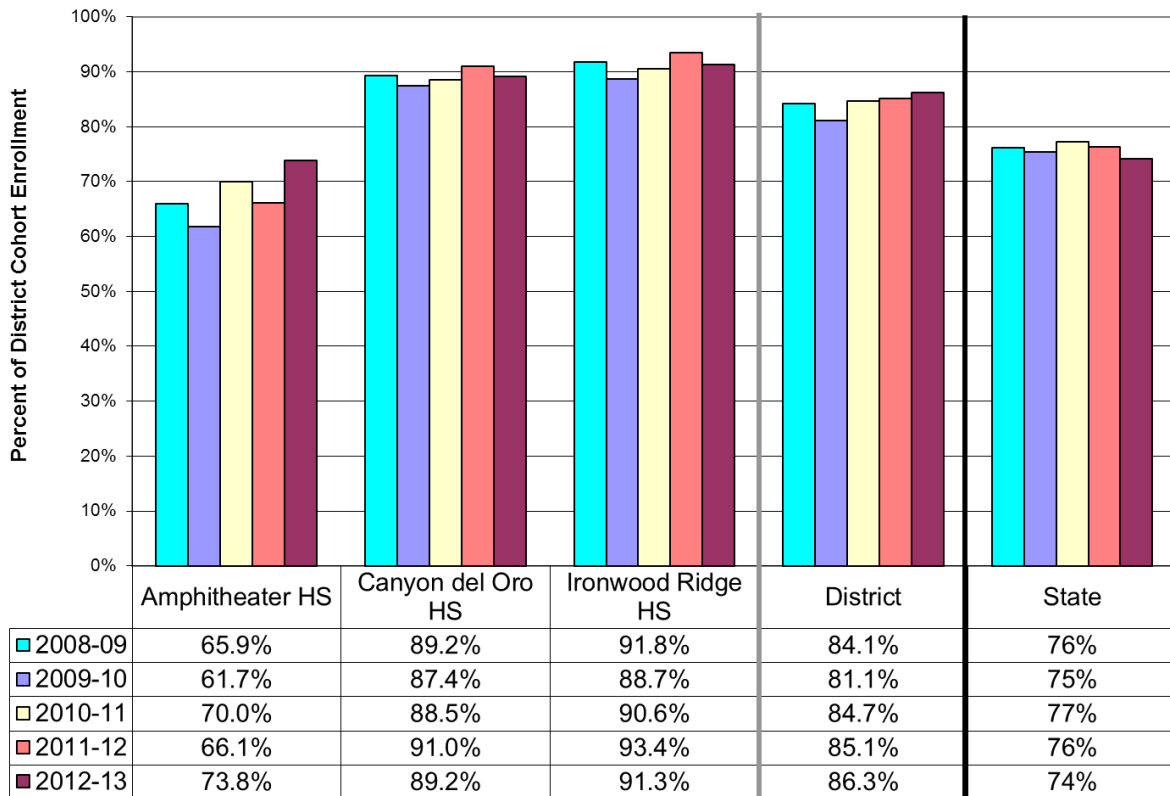

Graduation and Job Placement Rates for CTE Program Concentrators

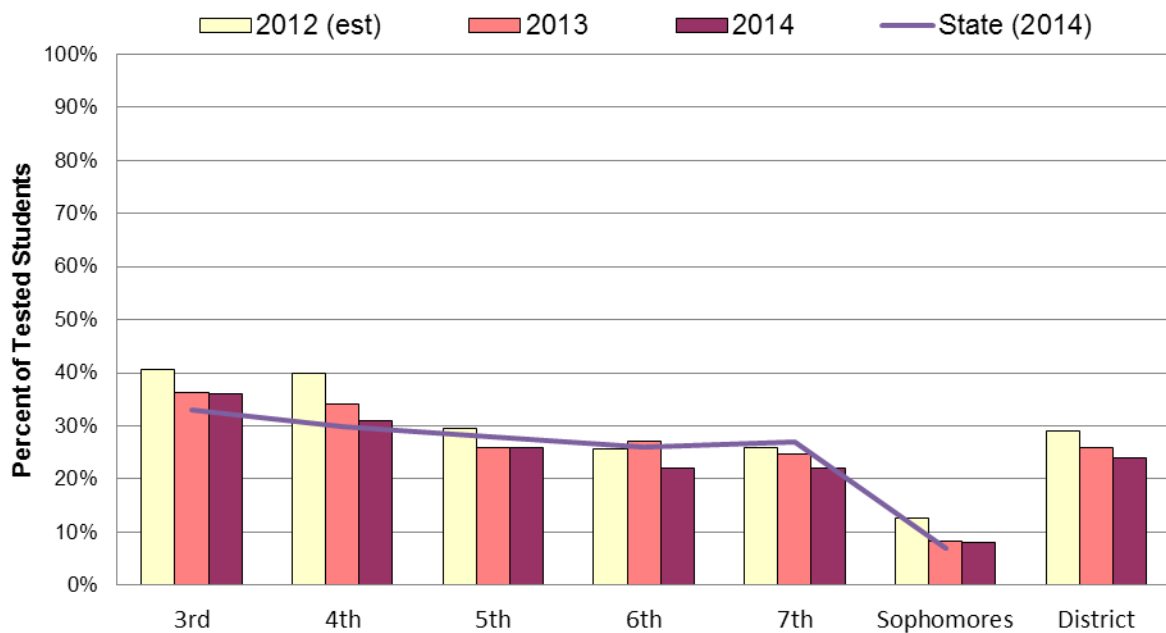
