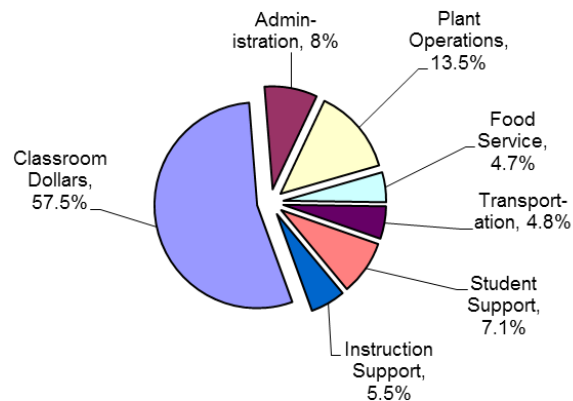

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District Spending by Function (2013-14)



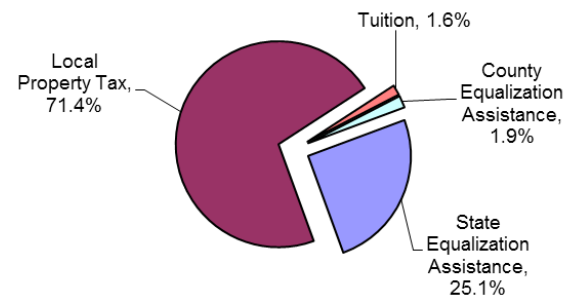

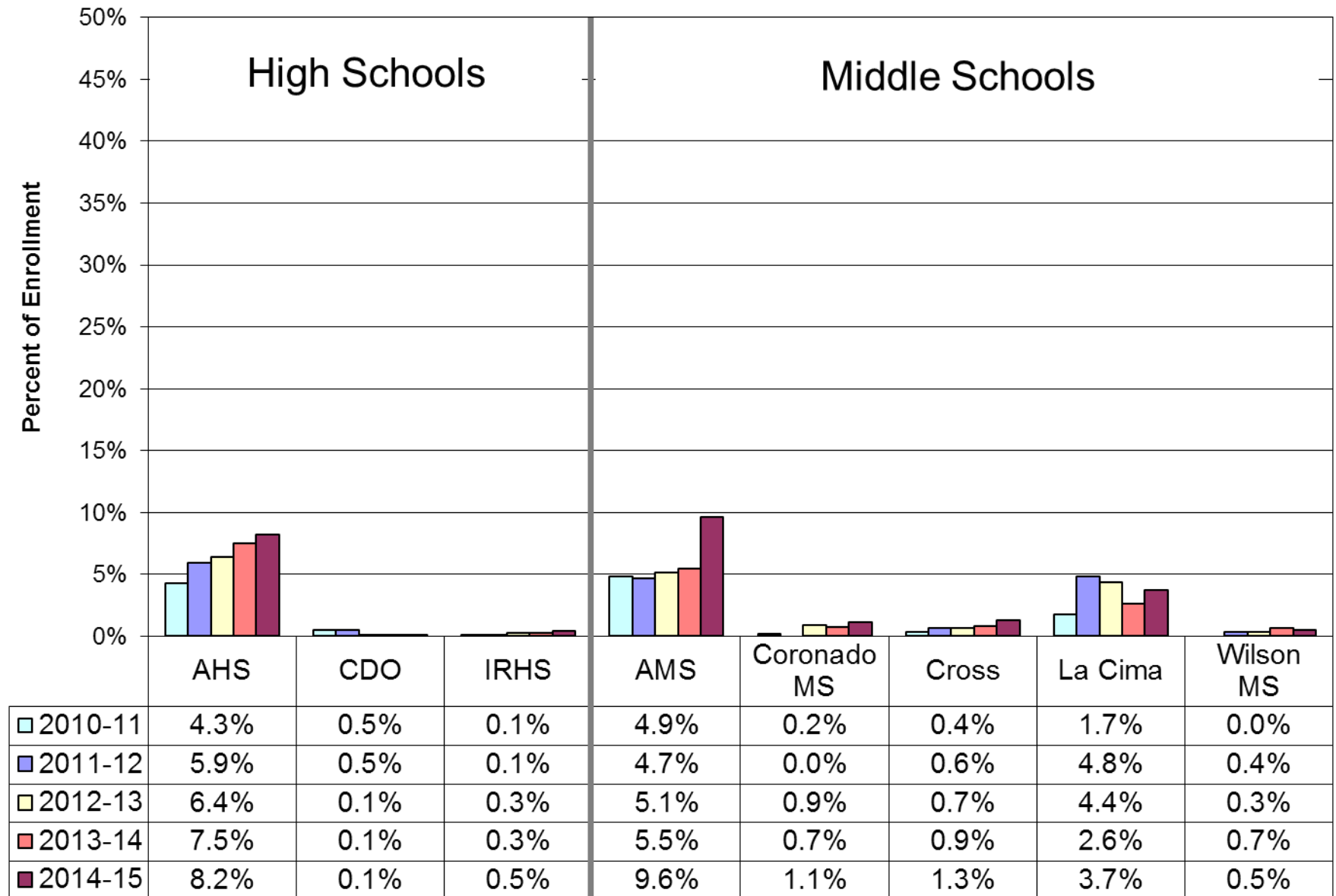

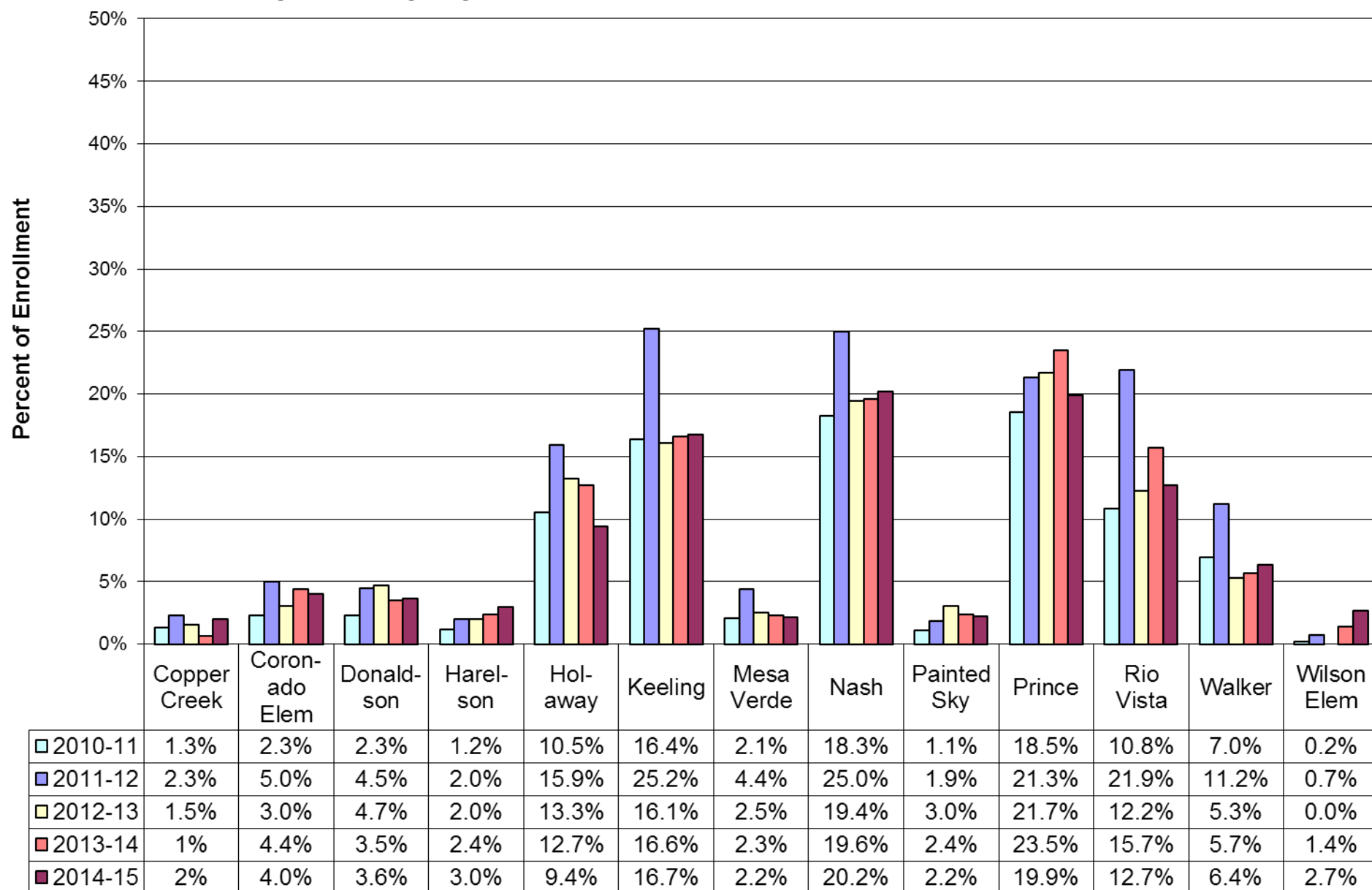

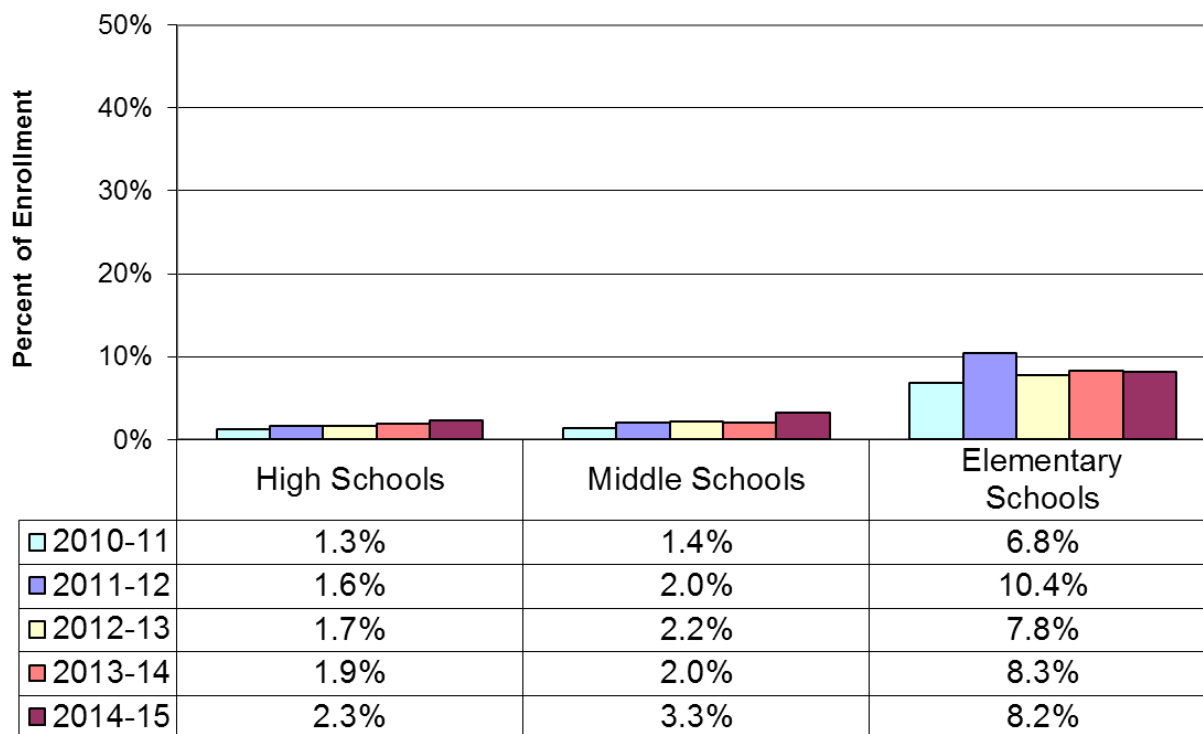
Distribution of English Language Learners



Distribution of English Language Learners (cont.)



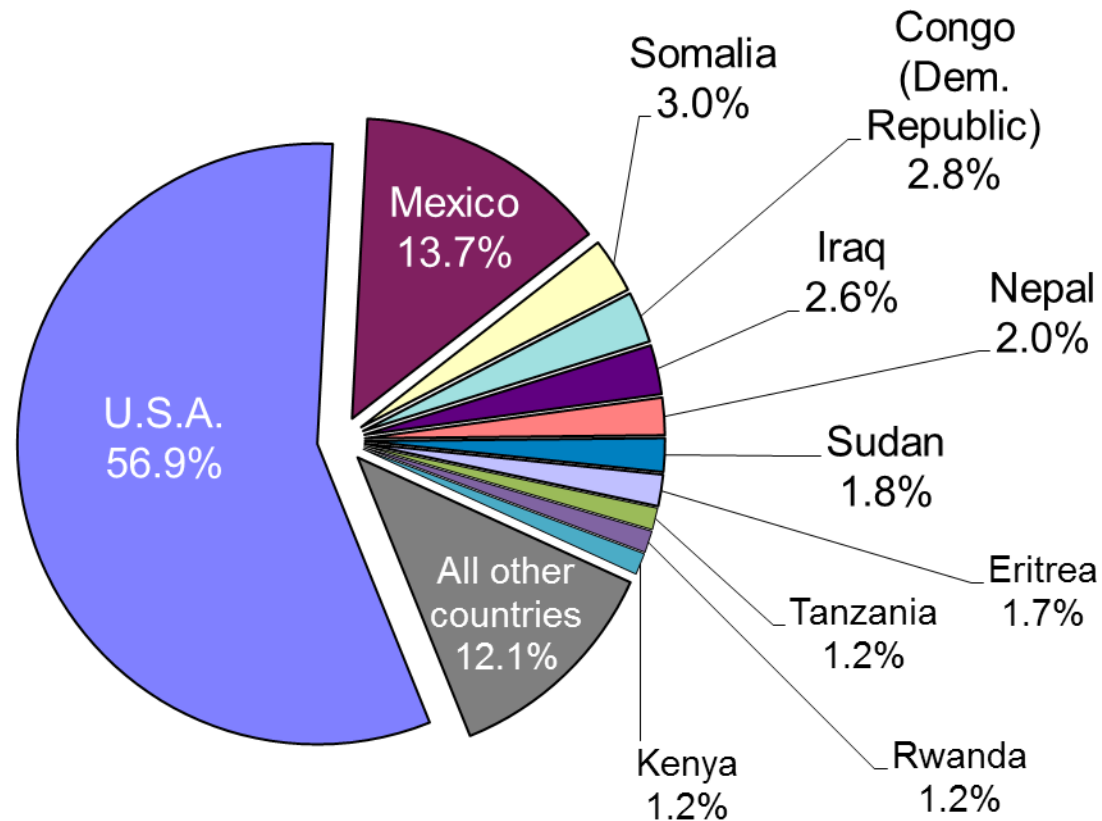
Distribution of English Language Learners: District

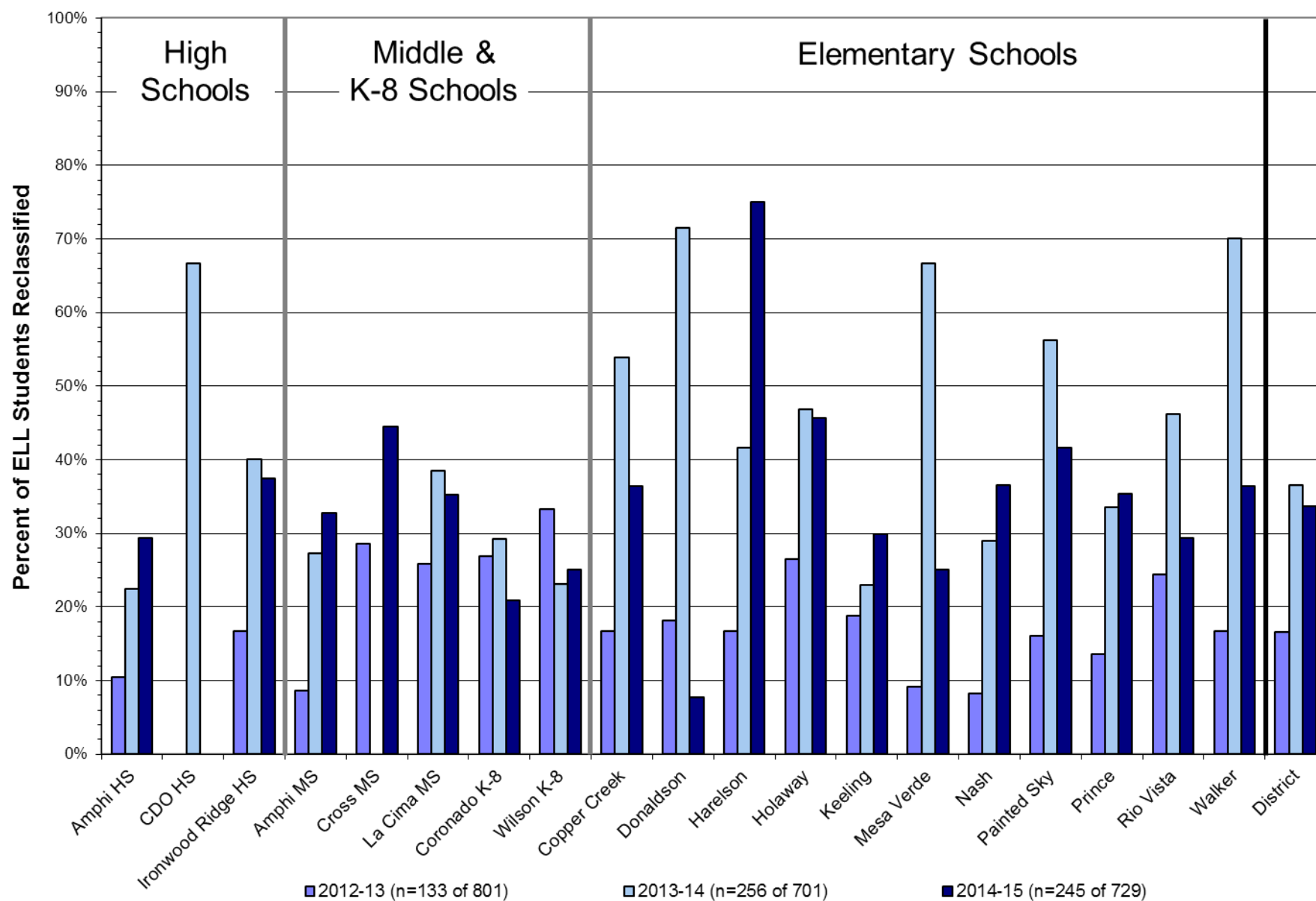

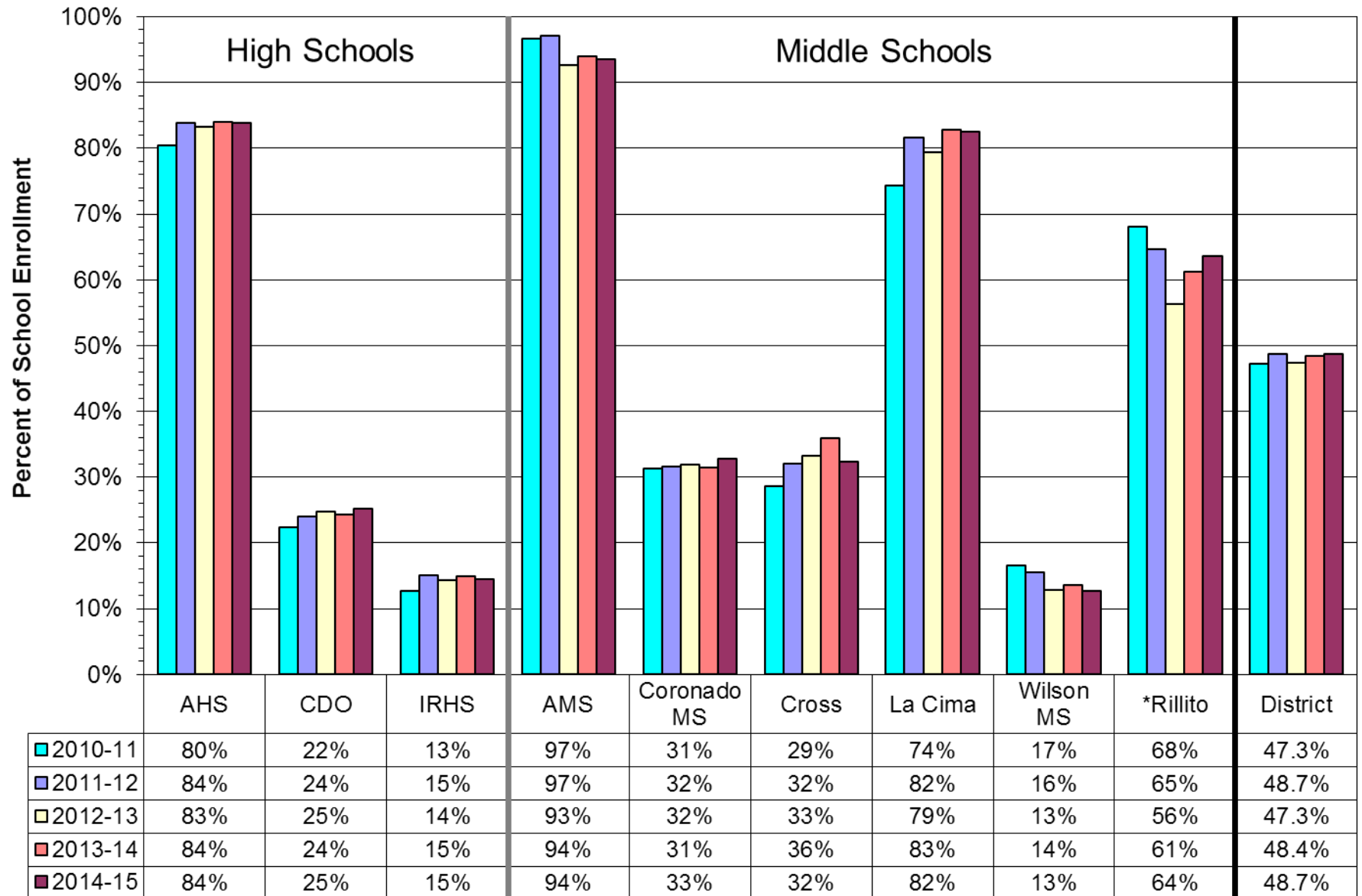
Distribution of Reclassified English Language Learners



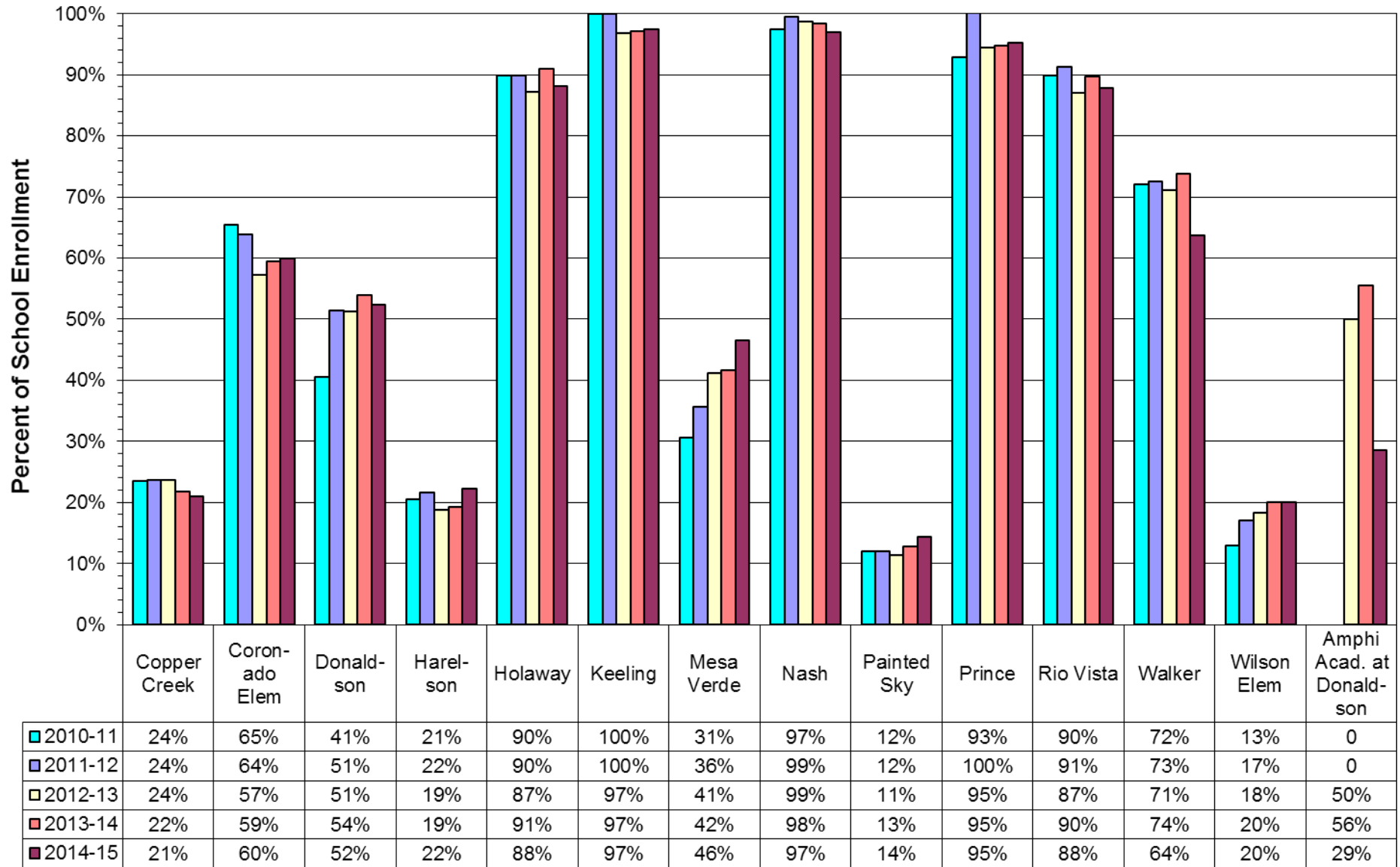

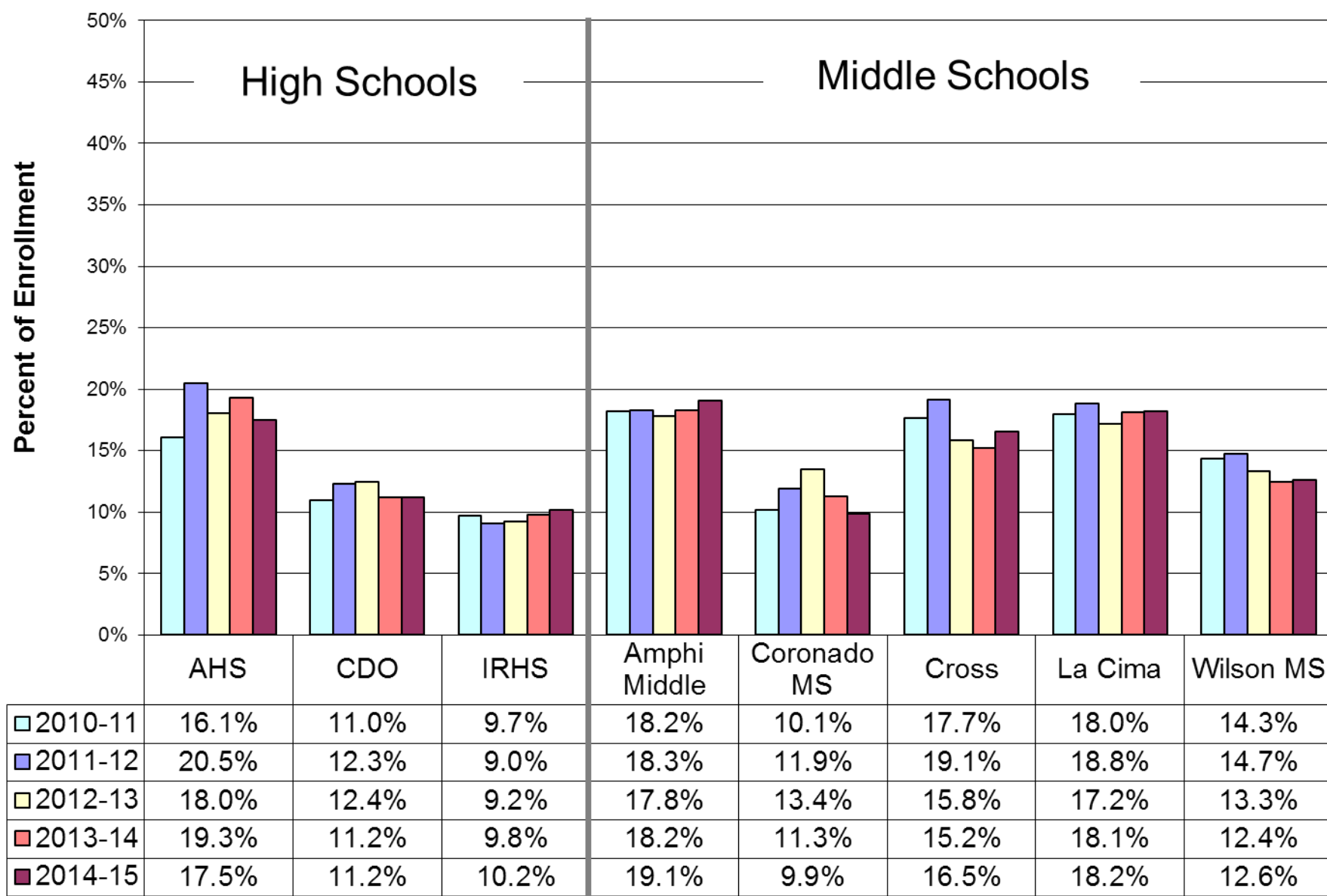

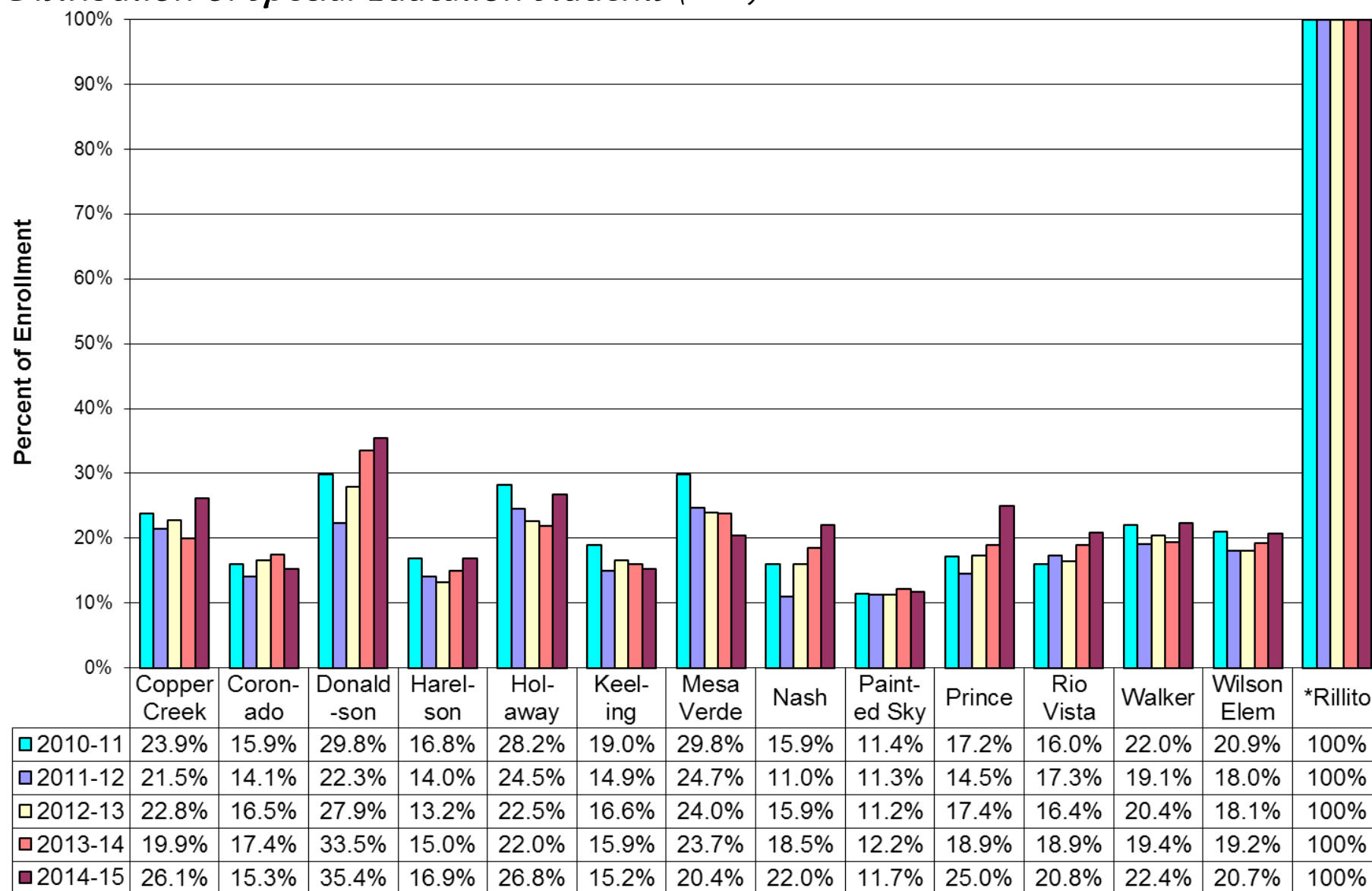

Distribution of Special Education Students

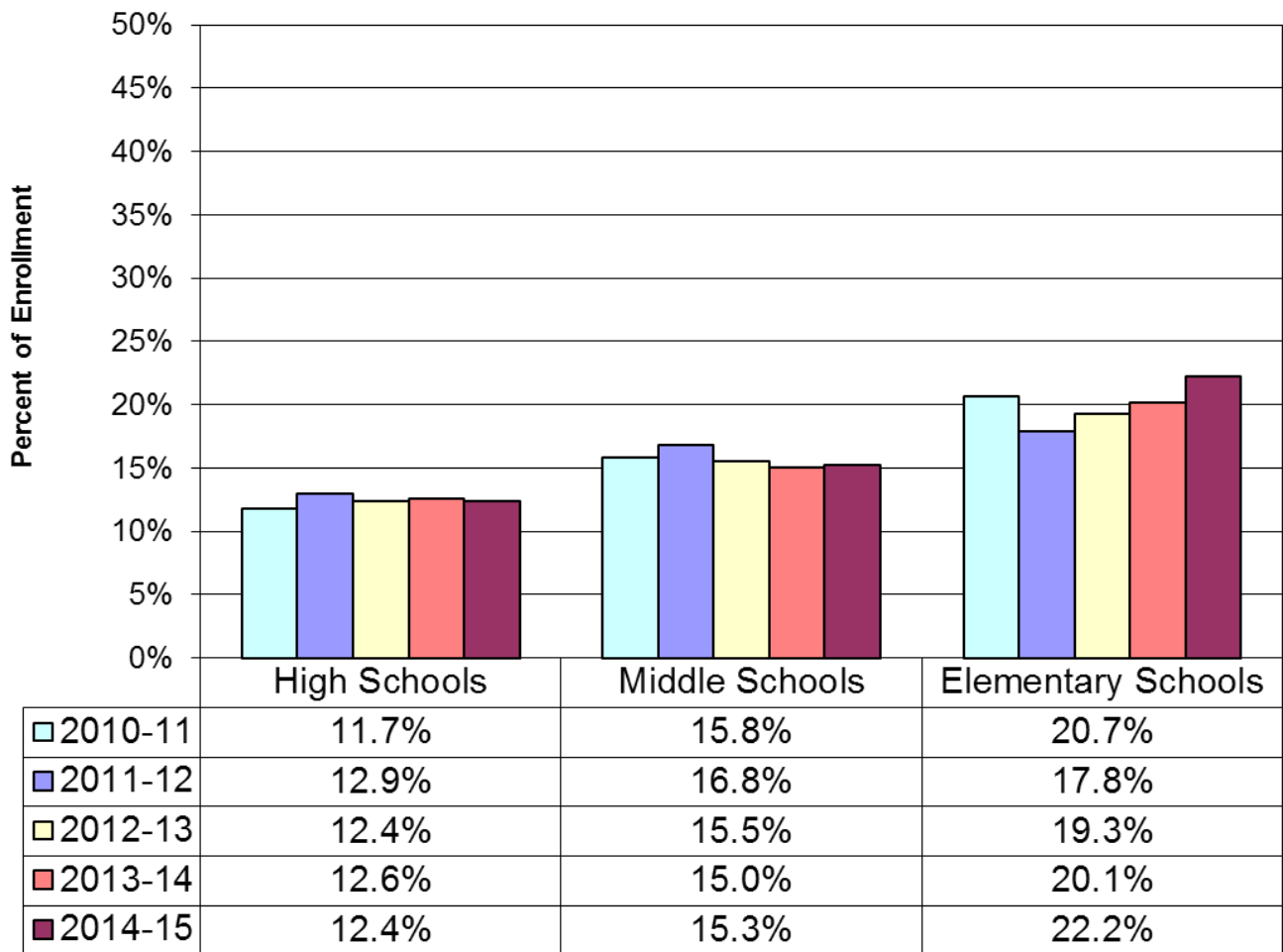

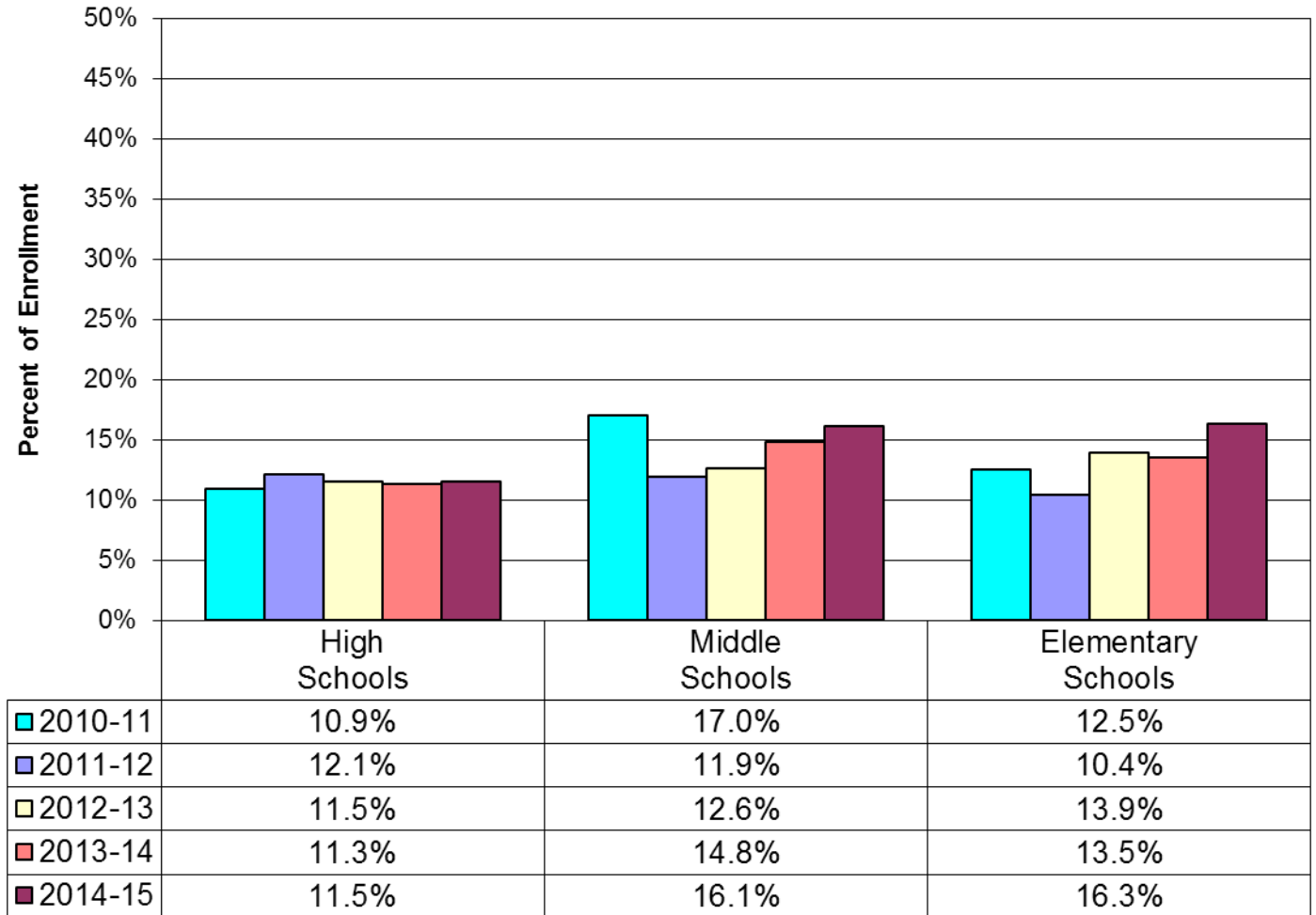
Distribution of REACH Students

Teacher Turnover Rate & Reason Given for Leaving



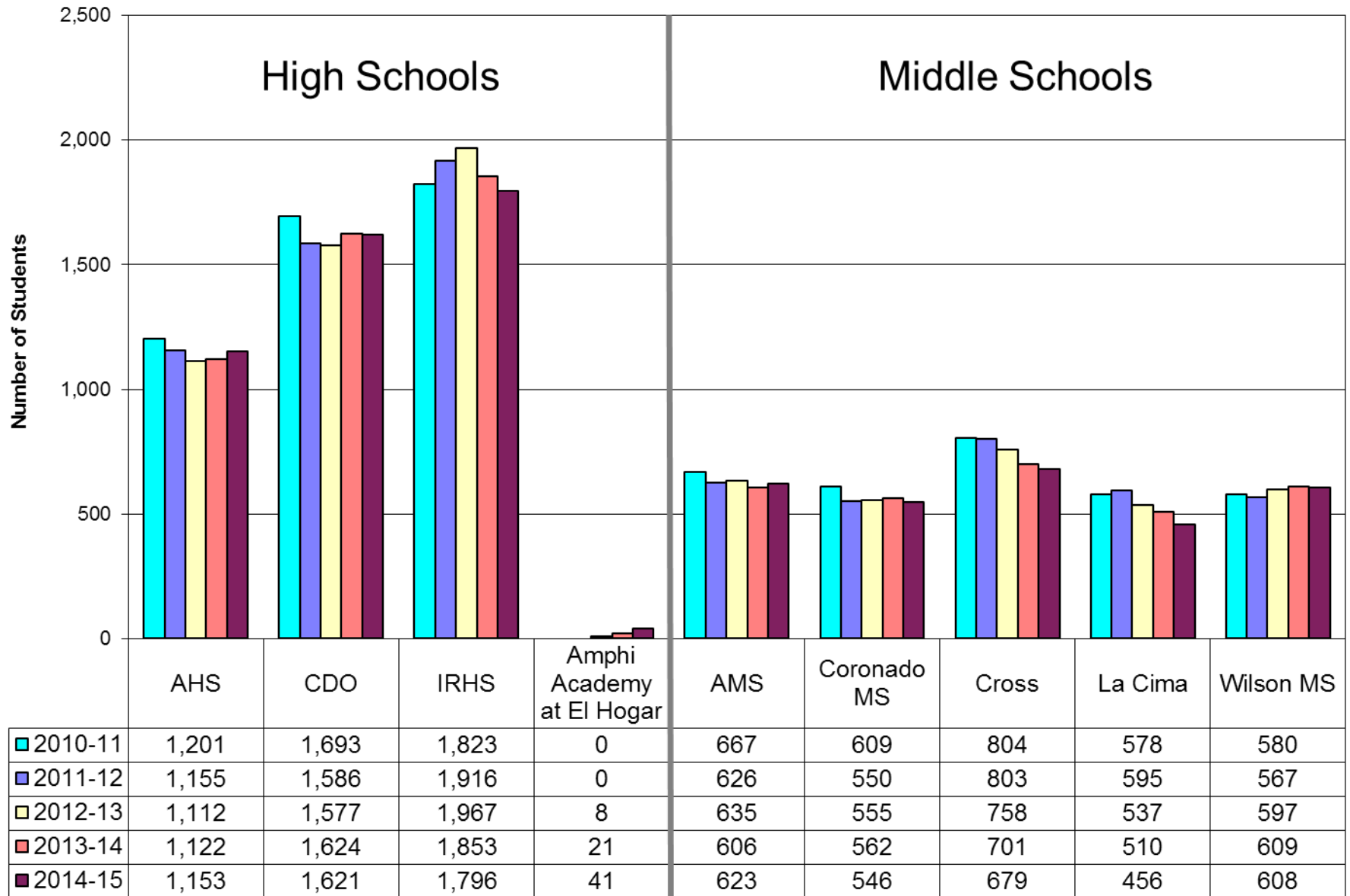

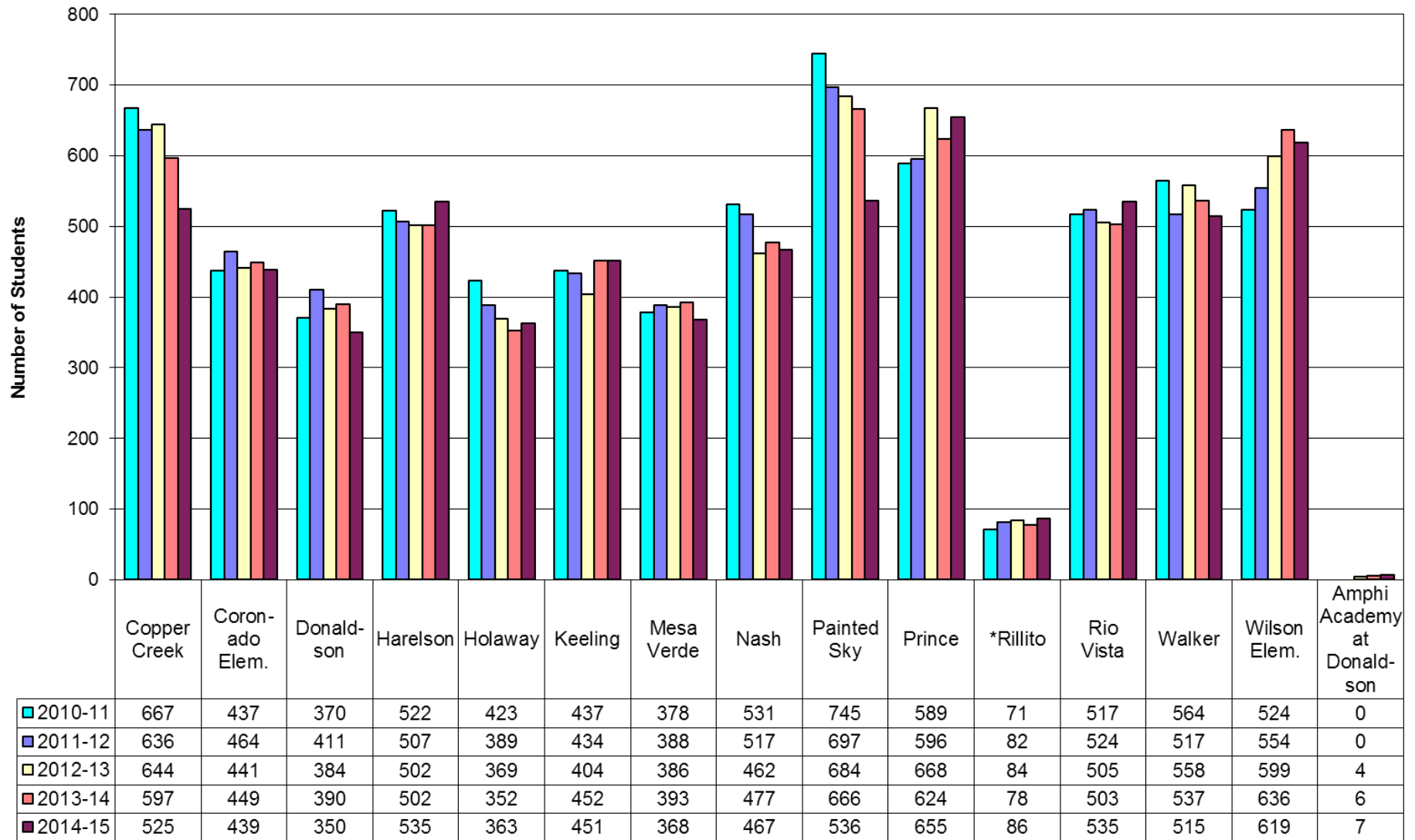
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Enrollment on the 100th Day

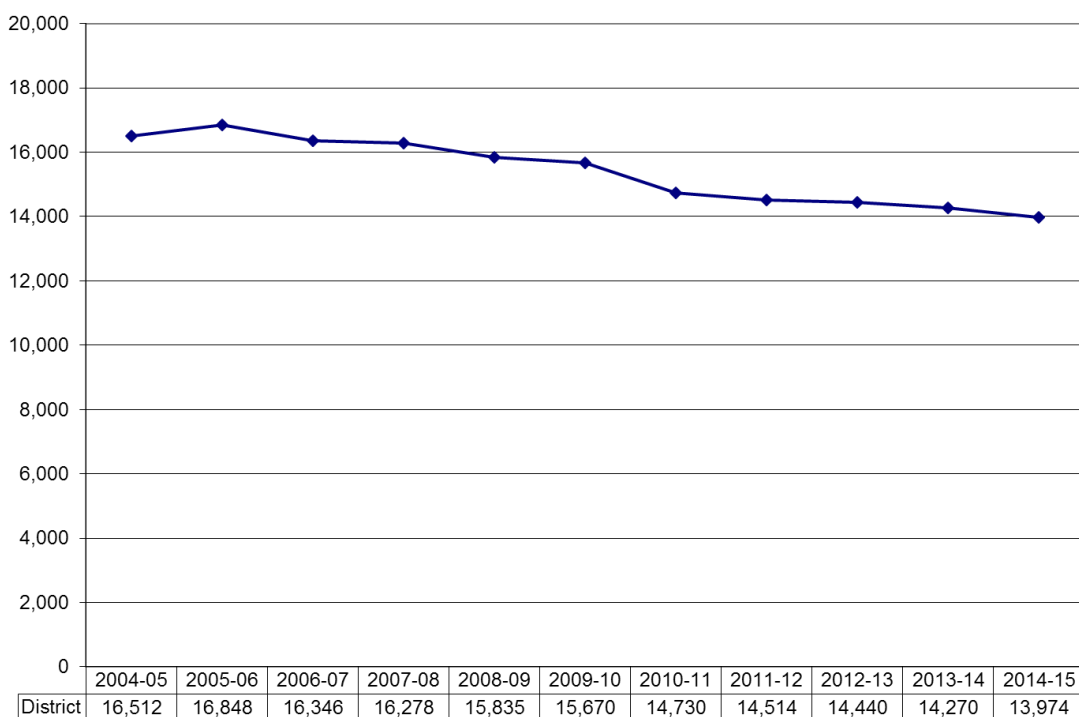
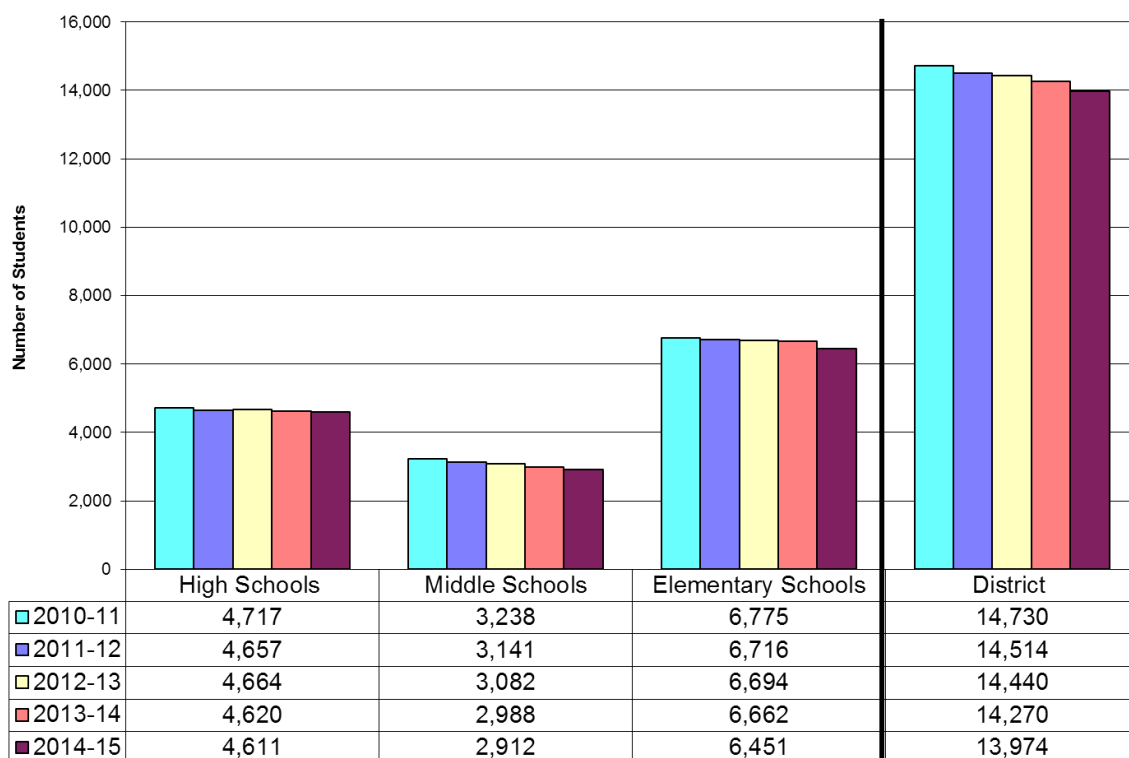

Enrollment on 100th Day & Historical Trend



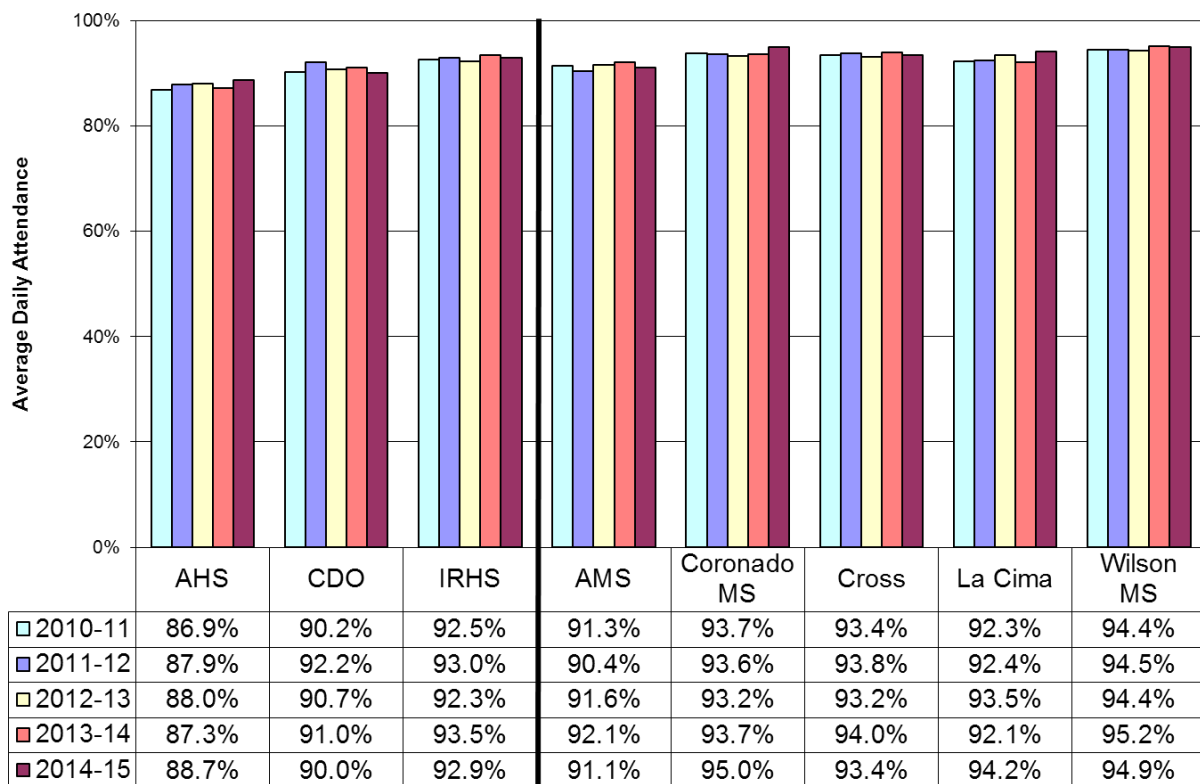
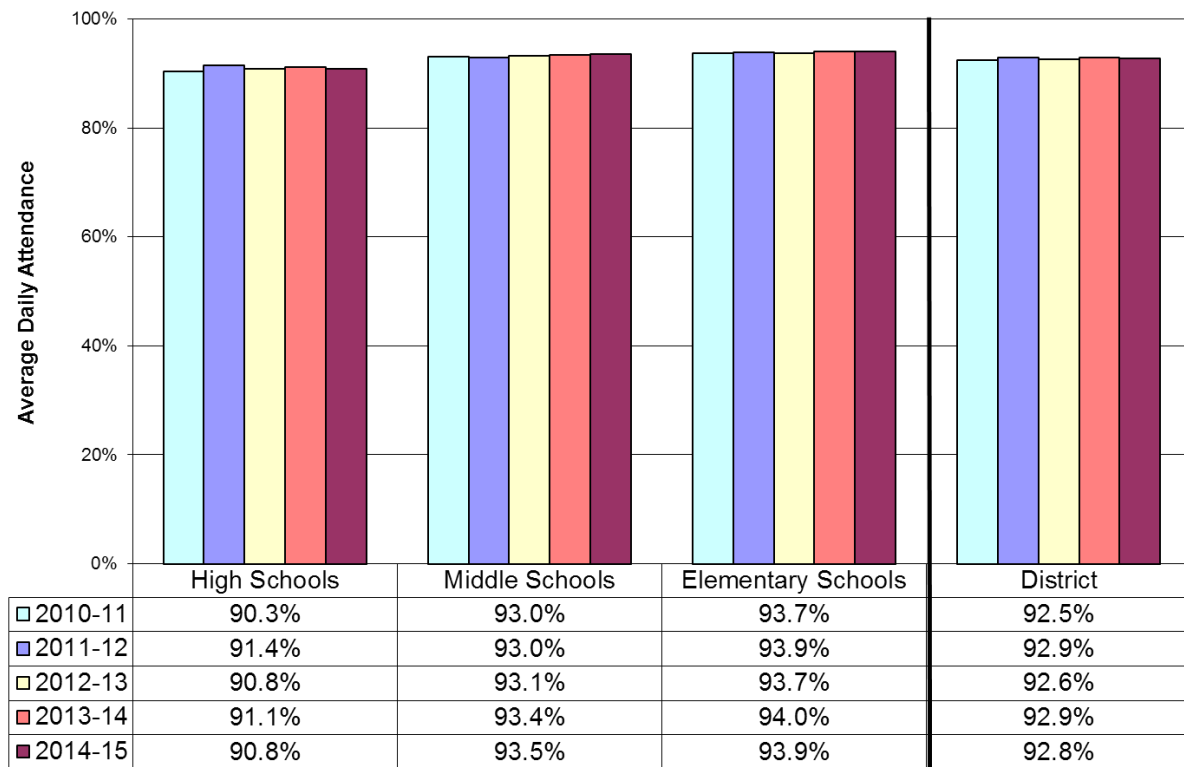

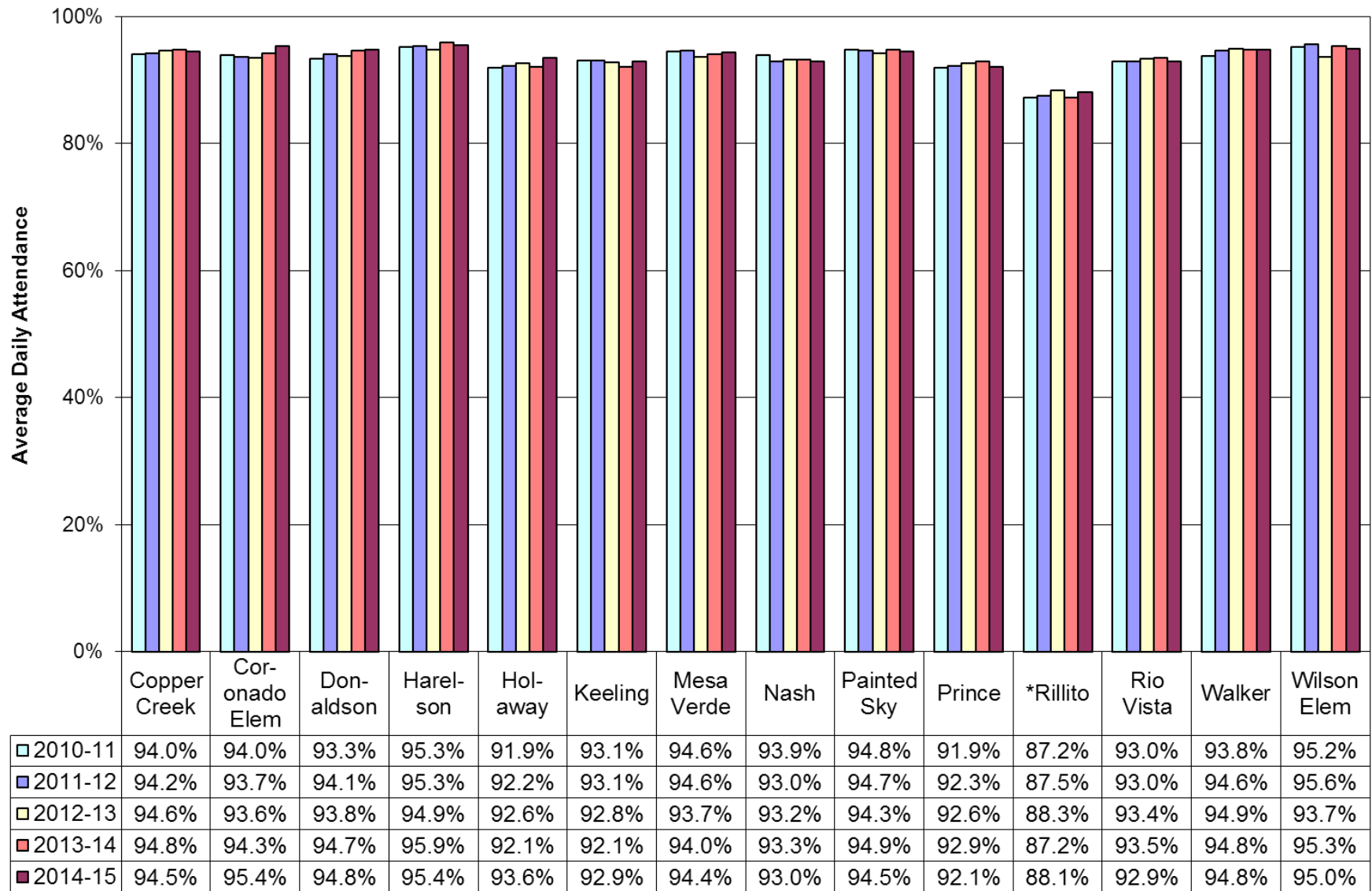
Average Daily Attendance – 1st through 100th Day

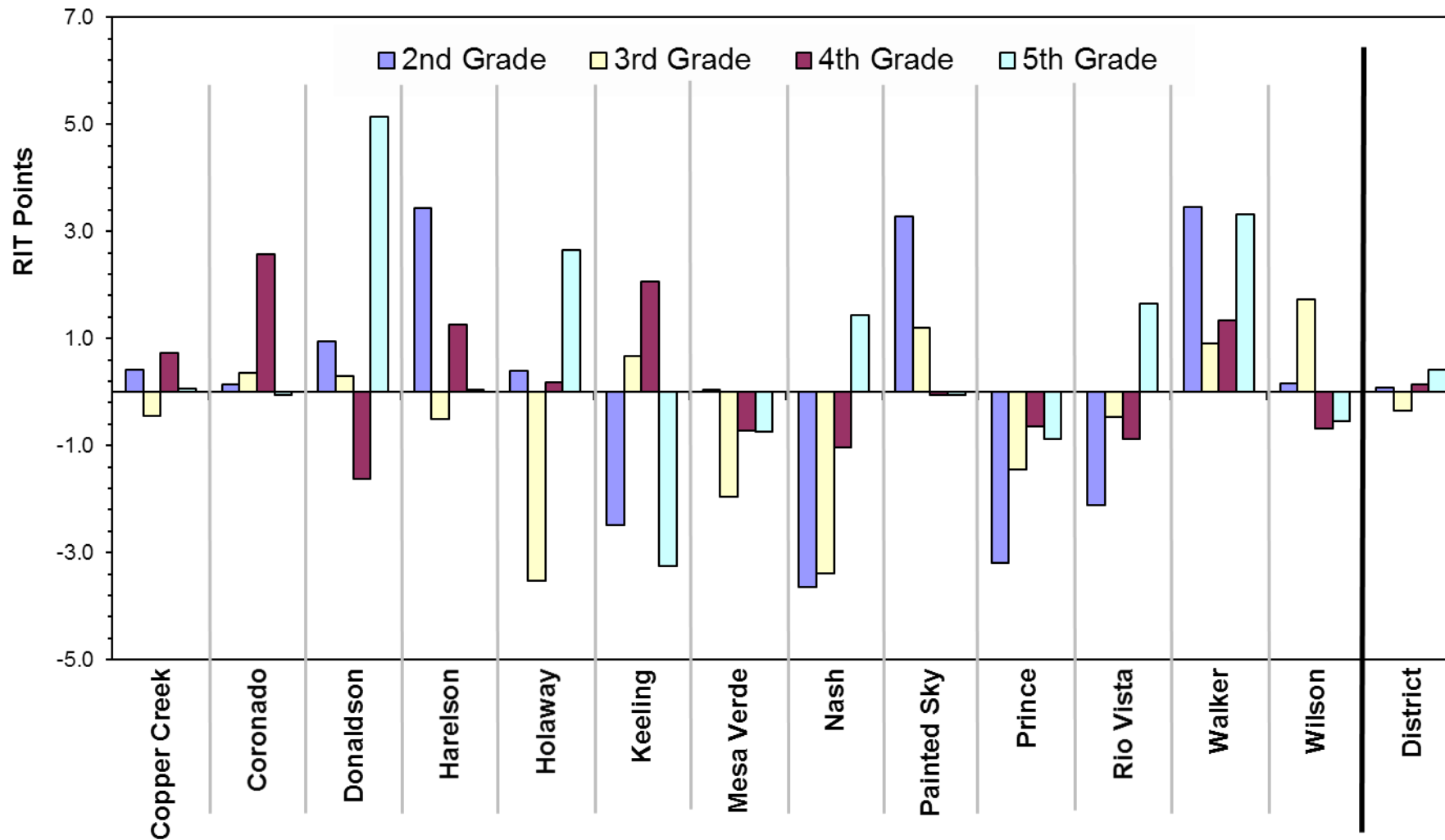


MAP Fall to Spring Growth: Elementary School

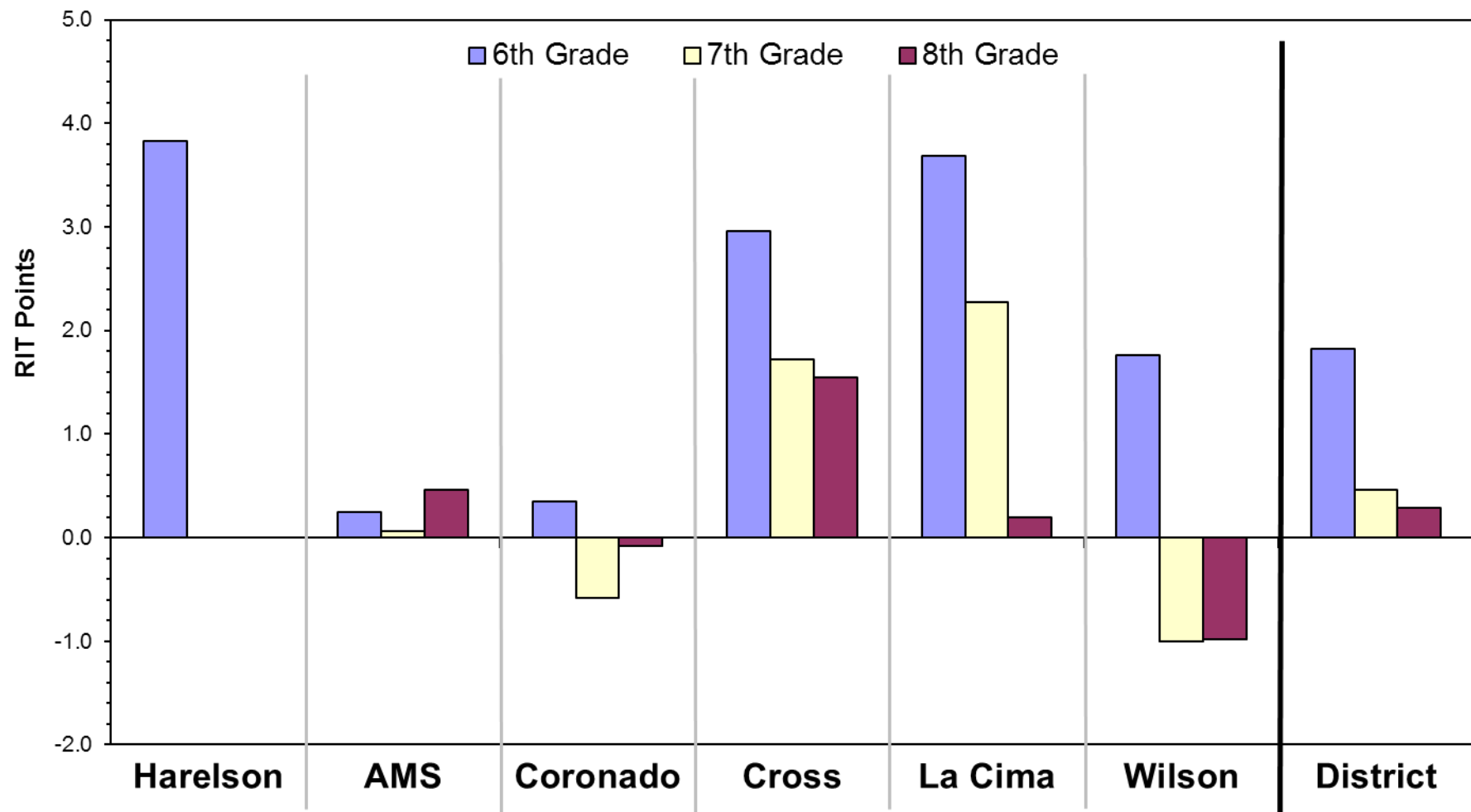

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Graduation Rate: By School and Special Program Membership

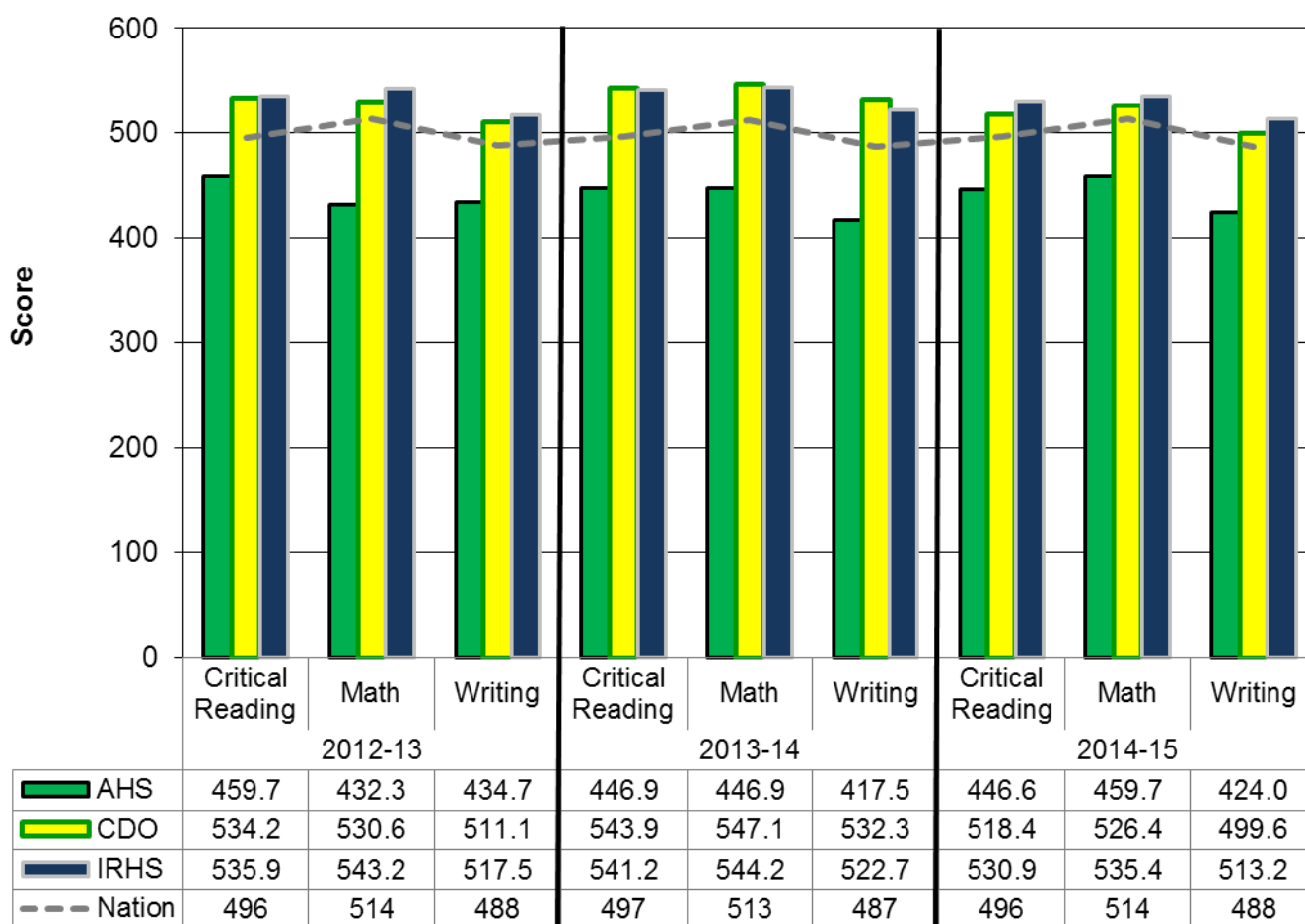

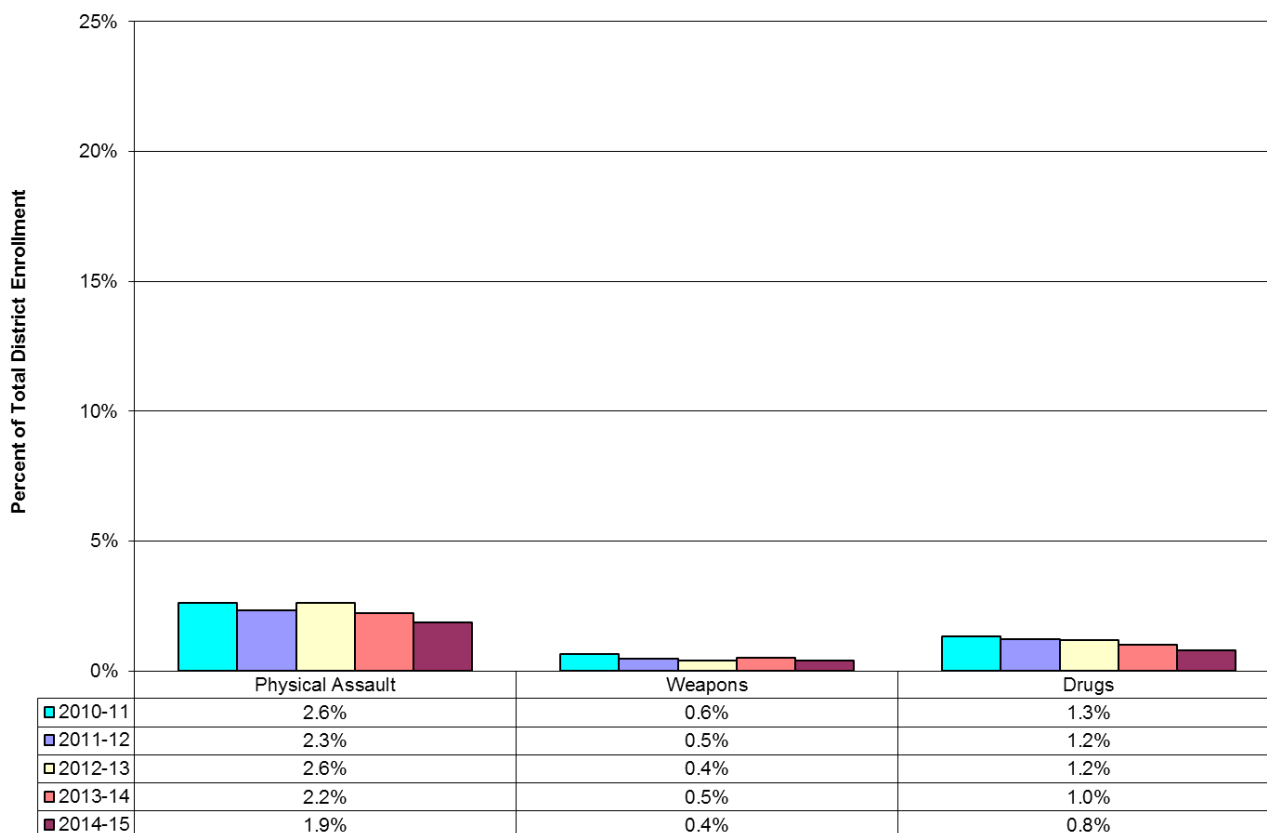
