Current Project Update:

I. HEALTH, SAFETY, AND SECURITY

A. <u>Holaway</u> bus bay expansion is in progress. Demolition is complete, new concrete curbs have been installed, and new electric has been run for light poles. Paving is still on schedule for the week of October 12th.



- B. <u>Land Lab / El Hogar</u> The bond department is currently working with the city of Tucson Planning Department and a licensed engineer to develop a plan to alleviate storm water issues in the parking lot so it can be resurfaced.
- C. <u>CDO.</u> A campus wide comprehensive design has been developed to update restrooms to ADA standards. This design will be moved forward and construction drawings will be prepared so an RFB can be drafted and work can start.
- D. <u>Coronado K-8</u> WSM Architecture has started on plans to expand the health office to meet school capacity. The goal is to perform this work during summer break to avoid campus disruption.

II. INSTRUCTIONAL SPACE / PORTABLE REPLACEMENT

A. <u>Prince Elementary Construction drawings</u> have been completed and submitted to the city for permitting. Demolition is complete and the playground has been relocated to its permanent home. The following pictures show the relocated playground. At the conclusion of my presentation, Mr. Richard Clutter of Emc2 Architecture will present the construction drawings and highlight some features and benefits of the design.





B. <u>La Cima</u> Emc2 Architecture is currently working on design and development plans.

III. NEW CLASSROOMS / INCREASED CAPACITY

A. <u>Amphi High School</u> Sealed bids for the renovation of a storage area in the 400 building to a computer lab and server room have been opened and a contractor has been recommended to the board for approval. Work will start as soon as a contractor has been designated by the board.
